Kingston Road Reconstruction Queen Street East to Victoria Park Avenue

June to December, 2013*

The City of Toronto and TTC are replacing streetcar tracks on Kingston Road as part of TTC's commitment to infrastructure renewal and maintenance.

The project will be divided into two segments to accelerate the construction schedule so work can proceed simultaneously (See map below):

- Work Area "A" – just north of Queen Street East to Waverley Road
- Work Area "B" – Waverley Road to Victoria Park Avenue

Construction Work includes:

- Installing new streetcar tracks
- Modifying curbs for compatibility with new accessible streetcars
- Reconstructing deteriorated sections of Kingston Road
- Installing streetscape improvements, such as new trees, curbs and sidewalks
- Updating traffic signals

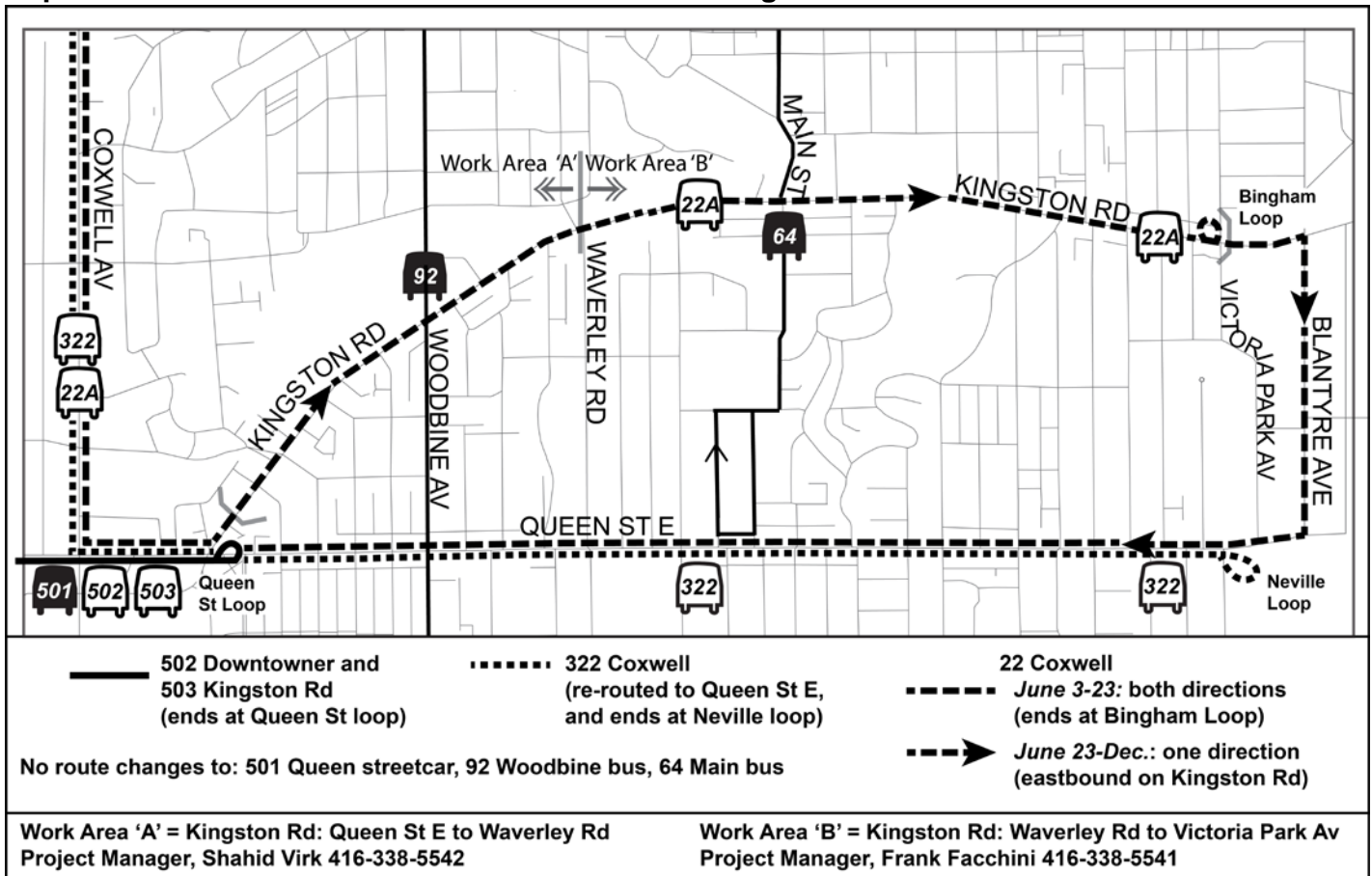

TTC Service Changes and Preliminary Set up Work - June 3 to 23, 2013* (approximately)

Two rail storage areas will be set up on Kingston Road from Queen Street East to Dundas Street East, and from Waverley Road to Lee Avenue. This work is required for heavier construction activities and will take place during day time, and will reduce traffic to one lane in those areas. TTC service will be impacted during this period:

- 502 Downtowner and 503 Kingston Road streetcar routes will end at Queen Street East
- The 22A Coxwell bus will replace streetcar service on Kingston road (both directions) between Queen Street East and Victoria Park Avenue/Bingham Loop

TTC Service Changes – June 23 to December, 2013* (approximately)

From June 23 to December, buses will replace streetcar service on Kingston Road. See map on reverse.

- 502 Downtowner and 503 Kingston Road streetcar routes will end at Queen Street East
- 22A Coxwell bus will run eastbound only on Kingston Road, south on Blantyre Avenue, west on Queen Street East, and north on Coxwell Avenue
- 322 Coxwell bus will not run on Kingston Road, and will be moved to Queen Street East to Neville Loop
- 92 Woodbine and 64 Main bus routes service levels will be increased

Disruptions

As with all construction projects, there will be noise, dust and other inconveniences. Noise will be kept to a minimum. Parking, traffic lanes and turning restrictions will be imposed. We are working hard to ensure that residential/local roads are minimally impacted and that pedestrians can access businesses on Kingston Road.

Work Hours

Construction work hours will typically take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, and from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. on weekends. To meet project timelines and the return of streetcars, periods of late evening and overnight work will be conducted during phases of rail installation.
