

Remembering Veterans & Heroes

Dave and his wife Isabelle Martinez Hayer, during a recent visit to Europe, toured a number of historic Canadian war memorials commemorating the heroic contributions of brave Canadians during the two world wars and to pay their respects to the many who fought and died there.

They visited the Flanders Fields Museum from the Great War of 1914-18 created in honour of the Battle of Ieper (Ypres). During the tour they also paid homage at the grave of Canadian John McCrae who wrote the epic poem "In Flanders Fields".

Dave and Isabelle also went to the Battle of Vimy Ridge memorial of the First World War and visited the Juno Beach Museum commemorating Canada's actions in WW II and the landing at Juno Beach (June

Dave's father served in the Indian Army, while Isabelle's father was a World War II veteran and both of Dave's grandfathers-in-law served during the First World War.

Dave has also visited South Korea's Demilitarized Zone and visited its museum commemorating the Korean War (1950-1953) to pay his respects to the 26,000 Canadians who participated in that war, and especially to the 516 Canadians who died during that conflict.



Dave S. Hayer was an MLA for 12 years, from May 2001 to May 2013, the Parliamentary Secretary for Multiculturalism and Immigration from 2005 -2011. Over the past few years Dave had been approached many times, by many people, to seek a seat as a Member of Parliament. Dave considered those suggestions carefully and, after having discussed this with family, friends and community members, decided to pursue the nomination as an MP candidate in the new Cloverdale – Langley City riding for the Conservative Party of Canada in the next federal election.



Dave announced on July 7, 2012 that he would not be seeking re-election as a Surrey MLA in the May 2013 Provincial Election. "Part of that decision was that if re-elected as MLA in May 2013, and then leave to run as an MP in 2015, it would have triggered an expensive by-election which would be costly for my constituents & that would have been the wrong thing to do for my community," noted Dave.

Dave noted "I will continue to work to recognize in our justice system the rights of victims, their families and for the rights for all law-abiding Canadians; I will continue to support Seniors, Grandparents & Families; and will continue to advocate for small business and strong economic growth, job creation, healthcare, education, balanced budget and long-term prosperity for everyone. I will always be accessible to constituents to hear their concerns and suggestions."

He has a solid background of service, a tremendous record of accomplishments for Surrey as an MLA, and a very impressive record as a strong business and community worker. Dave was always accessible to constituents.

He was first elected the MLA for Surrey-Tynehead in May, 2001 following a candidate nomination win in 2000 over Surrey's then-Mayor Doug McCallum. Dave went on to success in subsequent provincial elections in 2005 and 2009. As an MLA, Dave was Parliamentary Secretary for Multiculturalism and Immigration from 2005 -2011, where he worked closely with the Attorney General of British Columbia and many other Ministers. Dave also served as Chair of the Surrey Caucus, Caucus Liaison with many Ministers, vice-chair of the Caucus Committee for Asian Economic Development, member of many Cabinet Committees.

Dave was voted 'Most Seen Around Town', Reader's Choice Award in November 2013 by the Leader Newspaper for Surrey – North Delta. Dave is recipient of the Rotary International's Paul Harris Fellow award in "recognition of exceptional service to the community and to the world". In 2002 Dave was a recipient of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II's Golden Jubilee medal, and on February 10th 2013 Dave was presented with a Diamond Jubilee Medal by the Canadian Coalition Against Terror (C-CAT) for his contribution to the advancement of sound public policy on terrorism issues in Canada. In 2008 Dave was selected by the Vancouver Sun as

one of the top 100 most influential Canadians of South Asian descent making a difference in BC.



In 2007, Dave received a prestigious award from the Government of India. The Pravasi Bharatia Samman Award is annually given to people of Indian heritage, no longer living in India, who have achieved excellence in their chosen fields of endeavor. Dave was presented with the award by the President of India, Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam, in New Delhi, India on January 9, 2007 for his active leadership in the community, his contributions to public service, for his achievements in government and for having been a strong voice in the Canadian community against terrorism and violence.
