In 2002, he was appointed as Chief Executive Officer of FINCA Uganda Ltd MDI, the very first licensed microfinance deposit taking institution in Uganda for eight years, until mid 2010 when he started working with Centenary Bank as its Managing Director, a microfinance bank currently serving close to one million clients with 52 branches countrywide.

Centenary bank has been operating in Uganda as a microfinance bank for the last 25 years, currently serving over one million clients as depositors and 115,000 creditors. The bank has an asset base of US\$400m, deposits of \$300m, loan portfolio of US\$200m. The bank has 40 networked branches with an ATM network of 80. It is the fourth biggest in the country and the only indigenously owned bank.
