




# Barack Obama's Presidential Approval Rating


If the Presidential Election were held today, would you vote for Republican Mitt Romney or Democrat Barack Obama?

## US Senate Race: Ballot Test


If the 2012 election for US Senate were held today, would you vote for Republican Tom Smith or Democrat Bob Casey?









#### Survey Details and Question Wording

The survey of **I,000 likely voters in Pennsylvania** was conducted by Pulse Opinion Research on October 30, 2012. Pulse Opinion Research, LLC is an independent public opinion research firm using automated polling methodology and procedures licensed from Rasmussen Reports, LLC.

- 1. **Presidential Approval:** How would you rate the job Barack Obama has been doing as President ... do you strongly approve, somewhat approve, somewhat disapprove, or strongly disapprove of the job he's been doing?
- 2. **Ballot Test President:** If the Presidential Election were held today, would you vote for Republican Mitt Romney or Democrat Barack Obama?
- 3. **Ballot Test US Senate:** If the 2012 election for US Senate were held today, would you vote for Republican Tom Smith or Democrat Bob Casey?
- 4. **Ist Most Important Issue:** What is the most important issue for you in the upcoming national election? Are you primarily interested in National Security issues such as the War in Afghanistan and the War on Terror, Economic and fiscal issues such as jobs, economic growth, government spending and our national debt, Domestic Issues like Education, Health Care and Immigration, or Cultural issues such as same-sex marriage and abortion?
