The station is located on the summit of the hill known as Wilkie Sugar Loaf in Victoria County, Nova Scotia.

The station is on Crown Lands.

The station may be reached from Cape North by driving northeasterly along the Bay St. Lawrence road to the home of Mr. John Fitzgerald near the summit of the road between Aspy Bay and Bay St. Lawrence. From here a well blazed hikers' trail leads to the top of the hill and the station. In 1969 a wooden tower stood over the station but in subsequent years will require repairs or replacement for use.

The station is marked by a copper bolt sunk about 1 inch in the standard concrete monument.

An astronomic pier lies 10.96 feet on an azimuth of 39° from the station.
