The overall planning policies for nature conservation in County Cork are set out in Chapter 7 (Environment & Heritage) of Volume 1. The key objectives for protected sites are stated as follows:

ENV 1-5 (a): It is an objective to provide protection to all natural heritage sites designated or proposed for designation in accordance with National and European legislation. This includes Special Areas of Conservation, Special Protection Areas, Natural Heritage Areas, Statutory Nature Reserves and Ramsar sites.

ENV 1-11(b): It is a particular objective to maintain the conservation value of those features or areas of geological interest that are listed in Chapter 3 of Volume 2 of this plan and protect them from inappropriate development.
