⚠ WARNING: PHOTOSENSITIVITY/EPILEPSY/SEIZURES

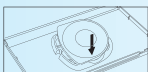
- Use in a well-lit area and keep a safe distance from the screen.
- Avoid prolonged use of the PSP® system. Take a 15-minute break during each hour of play.
- Avoid playing when you are tired or need sleep.

Stop using the system immediately if you experience any of the following symptoms: lightheadedness, nausea, or a sensation similar to motion sickness; discomfort or pain in the eyes, ears, hands, arms, or any other part of the body. If the condition persists, consult a doctor.

Do not use while driving or walking. Do not use in airplanes or medical facilities where use is prohibited or restricted. Set the PSP® system's wireless network feature to off when using the PSP® system on trains or in other crowded locations. If used near persons with pacemakers, the signal from the PSP® system's wireless network feature could interfere with the proper operation of the pacemaker.

Use and handling of UMD®

• This disc is PSP® (PlayStation®Portable) format software and is intended for use with the PSP® system only. If the disc is used with other devices, damage to the disc or to the device may result. • This disc is compatible for use with the PSP® system marked with FOR SALE AND USE IN U.S. AND CANADA ONLY. • Depending on the software, a Memory Stick Duo™ or Memory Stick PRO Duo™ (both sold separately) may be required. Refer to the software manual for full details. • If paused images are displayed on the screen for an extended period of time, a faint image may be left permanently on the screen. • Do not leave the disc in direct sunlight, near a heat source, in a car or other places subject to high heat and humidity. • Do not touch the opening on the rear of the disc (recording surface of the disc; see drawing). Also, do not allow dust, sand, foreign objects or other types of dirt to get on the disc. • Do not block the opening with paper or tape. Ejecting the disc

Press the right side of the disc until it is in the position shown in the drawing and then remove it. If excess force is applied this may result in damage to the disc.




Storing the disc

Insert the bottom side of the disc and then press on the top side until it clicks into place. If the disc is not stored properly, this may result in damage to the disc. Store the disc in its case when not in use and keep in a place out of the reach of children. If the disc is left out this may result in warping or other damage to the disc.

Getting Started

Set up your PSP® (PlayStation®Portable) system according to the instructions in the manual supplied with the system. Turn the system on. The power indicator lights up in green and the home menu is displayed. Press the OPEN latch to open the disc cover. INSERT Dead or Alive™ Paradise disc with the label facing away from the system, slide until fully inserted and close the disc cover. From the PSP® system's home menu, select the Game icon and then the UMD icon. A thumbnail for the software is displayed. Select the thumbnail and press the  button of the PSP® system to start the software. Follow the on-screen instructions and refer to this manual for information on using the software.

NOTICE: Do not eject a UMD® while it is playing.


Memory Stick Duo™

Warning! Keep Memory Stick Duo media out of reach of small children, as the media could be swallowed by accident.

To save game settings and progress, insert a Memory Stick Duo into the memory stick slot of your PSP® system. You can load saved game data from the same memory stick or any Memory Stick Duo containing previously saved games.




GO TO NEW ZACK ISLAND

Use the directional buttons to select "TRAVEL TO NEW ZACK ISLAND", then press  to start the game!





START THE GAME!!

Select A Character

Use the directional buttons to select the character you want to play, then press  to start!



Main Game Mode

Select a spot with the directional buttons and press  to display a menu of the things to do there. Use the directional buttons to select an activity, then press  to start!

Audio

Change the volume for music, sound effects and character voices.

Language

Change the language of character voices and message text.

Hey! Wanna Do Something?

When you see someone in a spot, press  to talk to them. Press the left or right button to select the person you want to interact with, and the up or down button to select what you want to say.

Guests on New Zack Island can go Pool Hopping or play Beach Volleyball.



You can only play Beach Volleyball when you have a partner!

Give goodies!

Giving presents will change how much the other person likes you. Doesn't it always? But everyone has her likes and dislikes, so make sure you give them what they really want.



Make sure you think hard about what she'll like before giving her a present!

Change into something a little more...

Give that special someone their favorite swimsuit, and maybe she won't wait to change into it.



Give a present to wrap your lady in your favorite color!

Get a partner

Invite someone to be your partner. If someone doesn't like you, though, they could turn you down.



Seeing you with a partner could make someone else jealous...

Kick Back and Chill! Collect "Venus Clips"!

The girls' intimate moments are captured in Venus Clips. The more of these moments you see, the more Venus Clips you get. You can't watch them at first, but once you spend 2 weeks on vacation, you can watch them by selecting PRIVATE PARADISE in the Main Menu. Try to collect all the Venus Clips in the game!

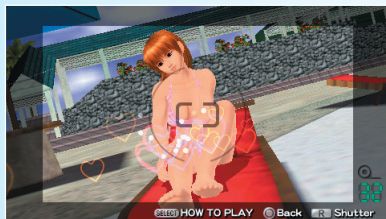
RADIO STATION

TAKE PICTURES!

You have a camera with you when you first arrive on New Zack Island, and you can take all the intimate shots of the ladies that you want-- whenever, wherever, doing whatever. It's easy! The camera automatically focuses, so you'll never miss a shot! You can't take any pictures if you run out of film, though, so make sure to stock up at the Sports Shop. (Rumors have it that Hitomi has a camera that doesn't need any film...)

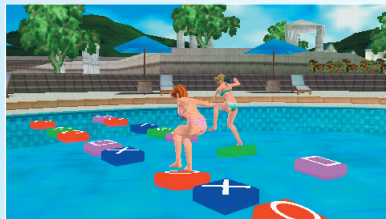


Make sure you buy a lot of film!

Pause

- * Rally Point System, so points are awarded regardless of who is serving.
- * The first to 7 points wins. Deuces are possible. However, when the score is 9-9, the first team to get 10 points wins.
- * There are no sidelines or endlines.

Advice

If you have a lot of stuff...

There's a limit to how much stuff you can carry, and you might run into problems if you're always walking around full. Go to the hotel and select VIEW BELONGINGS and PUT AWAY to store the items in your closet. Select CLOSET and TAKE OUT to get your item back.

If you get a present...

All kinds of people will send you special presents, which will be waiting for you at the hotel. You'll see them in the present list in your BELONGINGS. Select OPEN to unwrap the goodie. Hey...! Did she send that thing you gave her back?!

Save Vacation Data

Vacation data is saved automatically in the course of normal gameplay. Turning the PSP®(PlayStation®Portable) off or removing the Memory Stick™ while saving could corrupt your vacation data. When you want to quit the game, select QUIT GAME at the Pool Side or Hotel. It is safe to shut down your PSP once you have returned to the Title Screen.

- * Please be sure the battery of your PSP®(PlayStation®Portable) has been charged before playing.
- * Please do not remove the Memory Stick™ or slide the POWER/HOLD switch while playing.
- * This game automatically saves game progress. You need at least 416 KB of free space on your storage media in order to save the game.

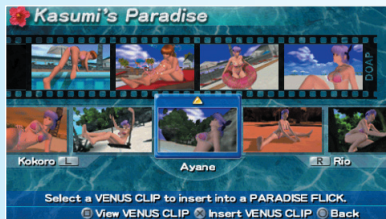
How to watch the 10th lady...? How to complete the set of Venus Clips...? Guess you'll just have to work those out yourself.

Swimsuit Selection Mode

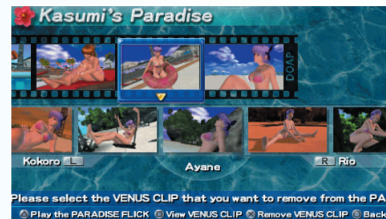
WHEN SWIMSUITS ARE DISPLAYED ON-SCREEN

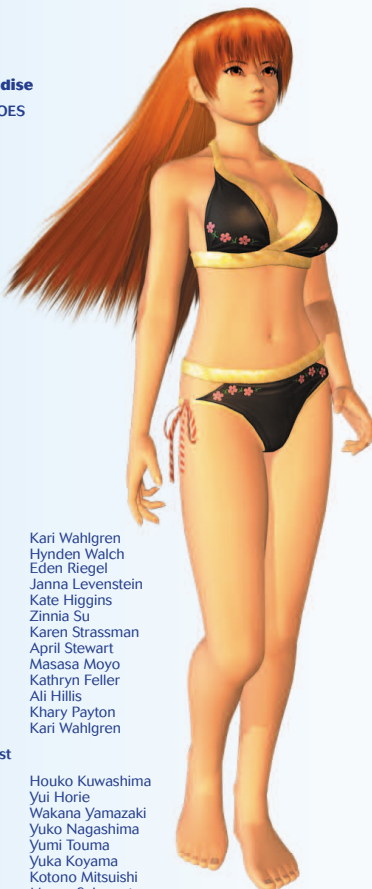

TO RECEIVE THIS WARRANTY SERVICE:

Updating the PSP® (PlayStation®Portable) system

Updating the PSP® system software

This UMD® includes the latest update data for the PSP® system. If a screen prompting you to update the system software is displayed when you start the UMD®, you must perform an update to start the software title contained on the UMD®.

Performing the update

When you insert the UMD®, an icon (as shown on the right) is displayed under **[Game]** in the home menu. Select the icon, and then follow the on-screen instructions to perform the update.

Before starting the update:

- Fully charge the PSP® system battery.
- Connect the AC adaptor to the system and plug it into an electrical outlet.

During an update:

- Do not remove the AC adaptor, turn off the system or remove the UMD®.

If an update is canceled before completion, the system software may become damaged, and the system may require servicing to repair or exchange.

Checking that the update was successful

After the update has been completed, select **[System Settings]** under **[Settings]** from the home menu, and then select **[System Information]**. If the System Software field displays the version number of the update, the update was successful.
