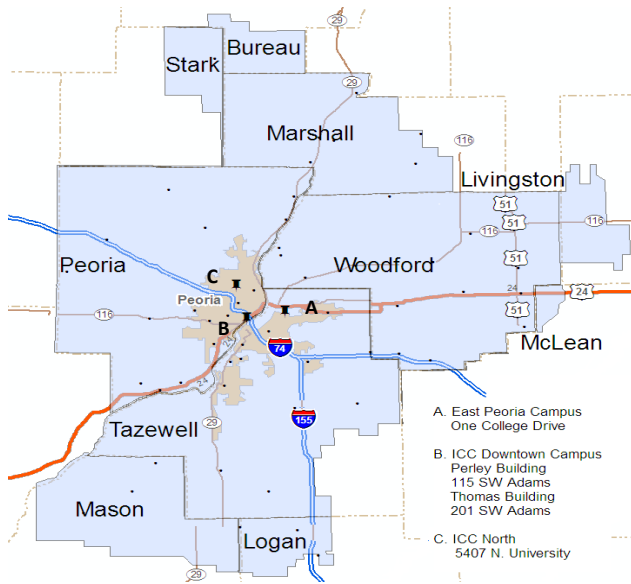


Illinois Central College Essentials, Fall 2009

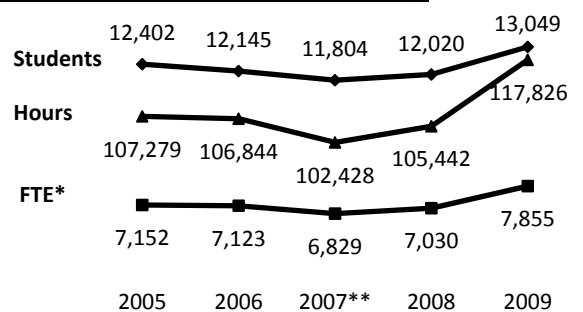
Associate, Arts & Science: *69 programs of study*

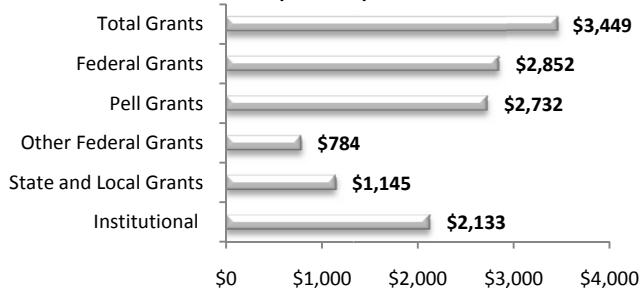

Annual Enrollment (Unduplicated)

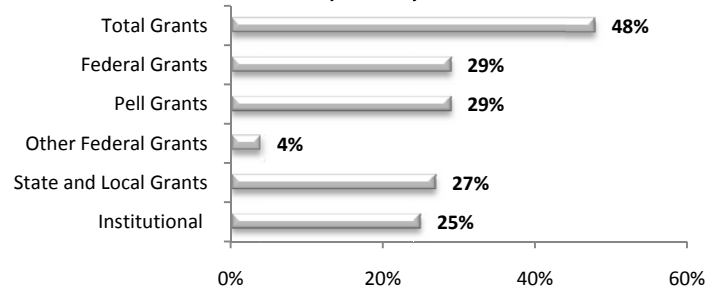
