

If you've come to see whether this is the place to make your next film, you're at the right address. The Czech Republic is the land of film. The Czech film industry has the history of nearly 120 years, from the early steps of the cinema to the high-tech demands of these days.

BASIC INFORMATION

The Czech Republic lies in the centre of Europe. A land-locked country, the Czech Republic neighbours Germany, Poland, Austria, and Slovakia.

The official language is Czech, which is spoken with slightly different dialects in some regions. A large number of Czech citizens can speak other languages fluently, especially English and

German. In the film industry, everybody speaks English! The Czech Republic is a stable parliamentary

democracy, a member of the European Union (since 2004) and a member of NATO (since 1999). The Czech Republic was the first Central European country to be admitted into the OECD and is fully integrated into other international organizations

such as the WTO, IMF, and the EBRD. Since 2008, the Czech Republic is in the Schengen Area, the borderless zone of European countries. Most visitors to the Czech Republic do not need a visa, provided their stay does not last longer than 90 days. If a visitor intends to stay longer than 90 days or plans to pursue gainful employment, Czech law requires a visa.



NATURAL ENVIRONMENT AND CLIMATE

The Czech Republic has a temperate climate. The weather varies throughout the four seasons, typically characterized by mild springs, warm summers, cool autumns, and winters with moderate precipitation. The temperature difference between summer and winter is

relatively high, due to the landlocked geographical position (for average temperatures see the table on the next page). The Czech landscape is exceedingly varied: extensive forests and glacial lakes, many small ponds, moorlands, meadows and mixed

woodlands, mountains, deep valleys and river gorges, and limestone areas with stalactite caves (for Moravský Kras caves see page 11).

The abundance and quality of mineral springs in the Czech Republic makes it a world leader in this area.

Among the most fascinating
places are the inner
historical districts of
Prague Castle (Hradčany),
Lesser Town (Malá Strana),
and Old Town (Staré

Město). These areas have their own individual features. Prague Castle is a historically rich complex of large buildings that has also been the residence of many rulers and a symbol of Czech statehood for several centuries. The Charles Bridge (Karlův most), one of the oldest bridges in Central Europe, connects the two historic sides of the capital city. One of the locations most

favoured by filmmakers is the historic centre of Prague, where it is possible to shoot practically anywhere with permission from individual city district authorities. For shooting on a larger scale, special permission from Prague City Hall is required. Our team is ready to help you pages 16–21.



The Czech Republic offers a remarkable mix of various locations. The easy access to locations and their diversity is one of the main reasons for coming to our country and make your project with us.

Besides Prague, there are more than 40 historically recognized towns and cities in the Czech Republic. One city of particular note is Český Krumlov, which has been included in the UNESCO list of protected cities. A beautiful Renaissance castle, comparable in size to Hradčany in Prague, stands on the top of a sheer granite cliff, dominating all views of the city. Also of historical significance is the city of Telč, with its Renaissance chateau and houses from the Renaissance and Baroque Eras. The city of Olomouc has the second most important collection of historical monuments in the Czech Republic, with some of the oldest parts of the city dating back to the 11th century.

The Czech Republic is known as a country of castles and chateaus. Most of these structures have undergone reconstruction several times over the previous centuries. Many castles have fallen into ruins (Rabí, Trosky, Pernštejn, Házmburk), while others have been rebuilt into luxurious and comfortable chateaus (Orlík nad Vltavou, Kuks, Konopiště, Lednice). The Czech Republic is also home to hundreds of churches, cathedrals, and monasteries of all types, as well as folk architecture sanctuaries, open-air museums, and traditional villages in South Bohemia – their original appearance still preserved.

exceed 80% of a project's total budget. Eligible expenses are those associated exclusively with the project and do not include the purchase and depreciation of assets, any costs related to storyline development, intellectual property rights, financing, distribution and marketing, the per day expenses paid to a foreign crew, customs duties or VAT.

Eligible expenditure cannot

The rebate is available to all feature, TV, animation and documentary films with a runtime of at least 70 minutes and to all television series with a runtime of at least 40 minutes per episode.

Grants are awarded to qualifying projects on a first-come, first-served basis. There is no cap on the amount of the grant awarded to a single project. The rebates are paid in the form of cash grants after the end of production and upon the submission of audited statements of the costs

incurred and paid. The incentives are newly transferable from one year to another since January 2013.

To qualify for the rebate, projects must pass a cultural test for European cultural and production criteria, achieving at least 4 points for cultural criteria and 23 points overall out of a possible total of 46. All point allocations are reviewed by the Programme Council. Since January 2013, the incentives are administred by the newly established State Cinematography Fund.

The application process consists of three steps:

the project must pass the cultural test; all decisions will be issued within 30 days.

the applicant must submit audited

the applicant must submit the project budget and other financial information; all decisions, including the approved amount of the grant, will be issued within 30 days.

statements demonstrating the eligibility of the incurred costs; all decisions will be issued within 30 days and the grants will be paid within a further 14 days.

Only registered Czech income tax payers with a place of business in the Czech Republic may apply for the FISP during the final stage. International producers may therefore partner with a Czech production company which then becomes the applicant. *




HISTORY

Barrandov Studios is one of the oldest studio facilities in Europe. Inspired by the American film industry, Barrandov's founding fathers, the Havel brothers, built the now legendary studios in the 1930s. Since then, the company has held a national monopoly in the production of full-length feature films and has evolved into a modern dynamic company, specializing in a full range of services for the creation of films and other audiovisual works.

The Barrandov films The Shop on Main Street (1965, Jan Kadar and Elmar Klos) and Closely Watched Trains (1966, Jiri Menzel) received Oscars in the Best Foreign Language Film category. Forman's The Loves of a Blonde (1965) and The Firemen's Ball (1967) were both nominated for an Oscar. A number of European awards, presented in addition to those from the American Film Academy, increased the visibility of Barrandov Studios and started to lure international crews to Prague. Milos Forman's team for Amadeus is the leading example. Barbra Streisand also directed her film Yentl in Prague and Oscar winner Sergei Bondarchuk completed his megafilm Boris Godunov at Barrandov.

In the early 1990s, Barrandov Studios started focusing on the larger foreign market rather than exclusively on local film production in the Czech Republic. This strategic decision was the right move, and Barrandov Studios has since become one of the key players in the global film production market. Sony, Universal, Warner Bros., Paramount, Walt Disney Pictures, and Fox, as well as television companies such as Hallmark, CBS, ABC and the BBC, have all recently brought their projects to Barrandov Studios.





- Working hours are twelve hours a day (starting from the start time up to the end of shooting in Prague and including a 45-minute lunch break; if the shooting is located outside of Prague, the shift time includes the round-trip travel time between the border of Prague and the location; in the case of exterior shoots, the travel time from hotel to hotel is included in the shift).
- There is a 100% add-on fee for work on holidays and for seven-day workweeks.
- The minimum break between shifts is ten hours.
- All fees are final and do not include VAT. There are no additional amounts added for social security and health insurance.
- All crew members work on the basis of trade licences and their fees are paid on the basis of an invoice.

CO-PRODUCTION

Barrandov Studios is not a producer of international films but we are willing to bring the in-kind investment to your project as a co-producer.

Barrandov Studios has co-produced such renowned projects as the star-studded, European megahit The Barber of Siberia by Nikita Michalkov or Underground by Emir Kusturica. 



STAGES AND BACKLOT



The core of Barrandov Studios remains its fourteen soundstages. Ten of these are located on the company's premise in Barrandov, and the other four are situated in the nearby district of Hostivař. The exterior backlot (approximately 40 acres) with clear natural horizon is also part of Barrandov premises.

All stages are soundproof and are equipped with silent heating, an adequate power and water supply, compressed air outlets, smoke extractors and wooden floors. Stage rentals include the use of additional facilities, such as a production office, wardrobe, make-up room, props room and camera room.

DUBBING STUDIOS



Dubbing has a long history at Barrandov dating back to 1949. Specifically the high quality of the dubbing performed here led to the origin of the expression "Czech School of Dubbing". Barrandov Studios works in cooperation with leading Czech translators, editors, directors and actors.



At the present time, the Dubbing Department has seven dubbing studios, all using above-standard equipment (we use the ProTools system), as well as several transcription rooms. We offer comprehensive turnkey dubbing services for Czech versions of foreign feature films, documentaries and television series, including complete audio processing in either stereo or

surround sound (multichannel) format using the Dolby Digital 5.1 system.

Our department arranges and ensures the completion of the translation from the original language, the required dialogue editing, the directing of the Czech version, casting, transcription, technical checks, the production of distribution copies, the

recording of the control DVDs, and subtitling. The internet-based Digidelivery and Signiant systems are used for the transfer of input and output data. Lower volume data transfers are performed using FTP (File Transfer Protocol). Currently our dubbing studio completes orders for important Czech distributors and television stations as well as for our foreign partners.
