Dear Collectors
Welcome to the July edition of the Stamp Bulletin and a range of very different stamp issues.

Extreme sports are a popular pastime for many people around the world - Australians among them. Highlighted in this issue are four of the better-known Extreme Sports - snowboarding, surfing, skateboarding and freestyle motoX. Vibrant colours and the designs of the stamps help to project the "no boundaries" attitude to many of these sports. Our next issue will be of interest to many who collect on the theme of marine life. The beautifully detailed Fish of the Australian Antarctic Territory features the well-known Patagonian Toothfish and other species found in these waters.

We take a nostalgic look at a favourite pastime, or perhaps necessity, of many Australians in Driving through the Years. This stamp issue takes us through different driving eras over the past 100 years, and features popular cars of the time. I'm sure many of you will recognise a pre-loved or favourite motor vehicle among those featured. We continue our journey with Australian Rock Posters, which may revive memories of moments shared. Some of the most famous Australian rock music poster designs are presented here, and they highlight the impact that graphic design has had on this art. The posters were used to promote rock music concerts and events around the country and have since earned high acclaim for their designs.

Dangerous Australians is this year's Stamp Collecting Month stamp issue. Six of the world's most feared animals make up the issue, with a special product featuring a seventh creature - one of the deadliest spiders in the world, the Redback. This is the first issue for the month of October and due to the excitement that this special product may bring, it was decided to include the details of this stamp issue earlier than we normally would. Stamp Collecting Month is designed to instill an interest in stamp collecting among children.

This stamp issue on extreme sports adopts a visual style that reflects the aesthetics and energy of these activities. Extreme sports are often a lifestyle choice, and so the apparent countercultural links to alternative music, aesthetics and styles are hardly surprising.

Three of the four activities featured in the issue - snowboarding, skateboarding and freestyle motoX are showcased at the Australian biannual Planet X Games. The fourth sport - surfing - is iconic to a nation of coast dwellers. Some of the other activities listed as extreme sports are ice and rock climbing, bungy jumping, skydiving, In-line skating and street luge.

The term "extreme sports"dates to 1995, and many of the sports have their origins in activities that have long been around.

For example, snowboarding owes something to surfing, and both In-line skating and street luge are related to skateboarding. The evolution and technology developments of the established sports aid the proliferation of extreme activities.

TECHNICAL DETAILS


The style of the drawing used in the design of this issue is intended to be reminiscent of 19th-century scientific specimen sketches.

Australia's involvement in the Antarctic dates back to the late-19th century, when politicians and members of Melbourne's learned societies began campaigning for an Australian Antarctic expedition. Our understanding of the region has come a long way since the Mawson expedition of 1911 .

The Convention for the Conservation of Antarctic Marine Living Resources (CCAMLR) has used results of scientific study and research in Antarctica to regulate fishing and to decide on necessary conservation measures since 1980.

Other products with this issue include a set of maxi cards, a first day cover and a stamp pack.

## celebrates the centenary of the first issue of an Australian driving licence.

The Model TT Truck (1917) was an affordable vehicle for ordinary people, and so popular with Australian farmers, it was dubbed the "squatter's joy". Holden's FE model car (1956), with its modern lines, was selected as the official car for the Melbourne Olympic Games in 1956. It was also the first Australian motor vehicle to offer a station wagon as part of the range.

The 1960s saw the advent of the very popular Morris 850 (1961), which was more commonly known as the Mini Minor. The Holden Sandman panel van (1976) was used as a recreational vehicle with special appeal for the surfing sub-culture. The 1980s saw the four-wheel drive vehicle (4WD) used for recreational use rather than just work. It is interesting to note that most of the 4WDs used today are owned by city-dwellers.

Along with a prestige booklet and an attractive gutter design, there are five individual booklets of $10 \times 50 \mathrm{c}$ stamps, one for each of the stamp designs, as well as a mixed booklet, which includes all five stamp designs.

The history of Australian rock posters is also the story of the relationship between graphic design and Australian popular music. Rock posters as an art form really evolved during the 1960s. The earliest poster featured on these stamps, Masters Apprentices from 1969, is in the "psychedelic" style popular at the time. Several iconic posters are featured in the issue, including Sunbury Rock Festival (1972), Rolling Stones Australian Tour (1973), Midnight Oil and the Angels/Sports/Paul Kelly (c.1979), Goanna's Spirit of Place (1983), Mental as Anything (1990), Apollo Bay Music Festival (1999) and Magic Dirt (2002). Most of the recent poster art has been digitally produced, represented here by the Big Day Out (2003) tour poster.

}October is traditionally celebrated as Stamp Collecting Month in Australia. The stamp issue chosen for this year will stir excitement among children and adult collectors. The stamps are also a great introduction to the hobby of stamp collecting. A featured product of this stamp issue is a special edition stamp pack.

Australia is home to some of the world's most dangerous and venomous creatures. Six of these inhabitants have been selected to appear in our Stamp Collecting Month stamp issue. The stamps feature reptiles and sea creatures, regarded as potentially deadly to humans. The White Shark, also known as the Great White Shark, can grow to around nine metres in length. The Eastern Brown Snake has the second most potent land-snake venom in the world and is surpassed only by the Inland Taipan.

The sometimes tranquil appearance of the Box Jellyfish, Blue Ringed Octopus and the Yellowbellied Sea Snake have caught many swimmers around Australia unawares. However, the sight of a Saltwater (or Estuarine) Crocodile, is enough to prevent most of us from venturing into the water.
