## Kristian Bush Steps Out Of The Shadows With Solo Effort



When **Sugarland** began its five-year run as the Country Music Association's vocal duo of the year from 2007-2011, **Jennifer Nettles** and **Kristian Bush** followed in the footsteps of two other duos — **Brooks & Dunn** and **The Judds** — who had won the same trophy 18 of the prior 19 years.

Each of those acts featured a powerhouse singer who dominated on lead vocal — Nettles, Ronnie Dunn, Wynonna Judd — while the partner provided much of the visual interest and energy onstage.

With the June 23 digital release of his single "Trailer Hitch" on Streamsound, Bush effectively launches his solo career in the United States with a rather unique conundrum: He's a familiar, recognizable piece of one of the most successful country acts of the last decade. But truth be told, you're not quite sure what the guy will sound like until the song begins.

It's not that you didn't have a vague idea — he very clearly brought harmonic depth when he backed Nettles, and he had occasional counter-melodies in the background that, if you were paying attention, provided a sense of his gritty vocal personality. But it was only a line here or there. He was, essentially, the sonic equivalent of a U.S. Marshal on a plane flight: He was there in clear view. You just didn't know what you were seeing.

"The nature of discovery is a real interesting conversation on this project for me," says Bush, loaded up with early-morning caffeine at Noteable Blends, a coffeehouse and performance space near downtown Nashville. "You're kind of discovering for the first time somebody you already know."

"Trailer Hitch" is a great step in the process. The grainy, gravelly voice that was sublimated in Sugarland is presented

with front-and-center clarity. The bubbly positivity that was always a hallmark of the duo is as obvious as ever. And the hook — "Never seen a hearse with a trailer hitch" — is a country take on the financial adage "You can't take it with you."

Compared with Nettles' artsy solo project, *That Girl* (which Mercury released Jan. 14), Bush shows himself to be the grounding partner in Sugarland. There's certainly some adventure in "Trailer Hitch" and four other songs Streamsound is presenting in a sampler, but there's a commercial quality about the music that suggests Bush was the

guy who always kept Sugarland's experimental nature in check.

"These projects that we put out are exactly what we do and where we are," he allows.

Bush is something of an experiment himself. The Tennessee native was enrolled before the age of 5 in an educational program known as the Suzuki method. Created by violinist **Shin'ichi Suzuki**, it teaches music and speech to impressionable youths simultaneously "with the premise that if they taught kids music at the time their brains are learning language, that





they'll learn music as a language," says Bush.

The most successful commercial music works as a shared audio language, and Sugarland was subsequently built around the idea of communicating emotions that Bush was feeling that were shared across American culture shortly after the dawn of the 21st century. His mother had died, and then 9/11 brought a similar sense of loss and grief to a national level.

"I wanted to make something that was a better place than the place I was in," he says. "That's when I named the band, it's when I wrote the first songs, even before Jennifer was in the picture. That was important, for it not to be about me or us. It was about you. And all of those stories were constructed that way, all those songs are meant to be your stories, not about heroics in our world. It's why we didn't have our faces on the cover of any album."

Sugarland has dominated his attention for more than a decade, so when he and Nettles decided to give the duo a rest, it created the opportunity to refocus his attention, and he tapped into a new volume of creativity. Where he would typically write one song a month, Bush was suddenly writing one every two days. He enlisted an Atlanta-based band and engineer Tom Tapley (Bruce Springsteen, Pearl Jam) for an intense series of sessions to get the songs recorded. One of them, "Love or Money," was released in Europe during 2013, and Bush employed Sugarland producer Byron Gallimore for a remix. Gallimore asked to hear more music and subsequently signed Bush to Streamsound, simply remixing some of the tracks that were already recorded.

Some of the sounds came about through unconventional methods. Steel guitarist **Justin Schipper**, for example, was recorded at half-speed during

Dierks Bentley's "Drunk on a Plane" is experiencing a strong growth trend at No. 4 this week, up from No. 6 last week and No. 10 two weeks ago. "Plane" also flies at No. 3 favorite. Males overall land at No. 1 favorite and No. 3 positive. Females 25-54 are at No. 3 and No. 5 favorite.

Lee Brice's "I Don't Dance" ranks at No. 5 overall with women and No. 10 favorite. It's a huge hit with the ladies. Females 25-54 mirror the No. 5 and No. 10 favorite scores, females 35-54 research at No. 8 positive and favorite, and core females 25-44 are at No. 10 positive and favorite.



**Tim McGraw** and **Faith Hill** are well in front of the radio spin charts as radio listeners rank "Meanwhile Back at Mama's" as their No. 7 favorite/passion song and make it No. 12 in total positive scoring. Females 25-54 grade it No. 1 favorite and No. 7 positive. Males 25-54 are at No. 9 and No. 8 favorite.

**Kacey Musgraves** is getting instant traction on "Keep It to Yourself." The song is strongest with females, who consider it the No. 7 song overall and the No. 8 favorite. Younger females 18-34 respond at No. 11 and No. 10 favorite; core females 25-44 are at No. 11 favorite and No. 16 total positive.

part of one track, "Make Another Memory," then the recording was played back at full speed, creating a sound that tests the range of his instrument.

"I'm interested in people using the instruments they have in new ways, like I'm interested in using my voice in new ways that you hadn't heard before," says Bush. "It's all a part of what I do anyway, but this album just happens to have that exploration on it."

When Sugarland regroups, Bush plans to continue his solo work, with both formats operating in a parallel fashion. In the meantime, his unusual mix of visual recognizability and vocal anonymity plays in his favor. He saw it unfold during a private show at the Country Music Hall of Fame as a roomful of executives went through that process of discovery at the heart of Bush's solo venture.

"I'm watching them go, 'Kristian, I know you, I love what you do, I have no idea what you sound like,' "he says. "There's this kind of awkwardness for a minute, and then as soon as that's out on the table, we have a song and I'm seeing people discover me after they already know who I am. That's a unique experience."

## AMERICANS KEEP THE MUSIC PLAYING

A new <u>Edison Research</u> survey says Americans listen to four hours and five minutes of audio each day. Exactly how that listening breaks down might surprise you since no previous study has tracked all forms of audio consumption.

Broadcast radio accounted for 52% of all listening time, or just over two hours per day. That figure includes time spent listening to online simulcasts from AM or FM stations.

Owned music accounted for 20% of listening. Included in this category are CDs, digital downloads, vinyl LPs and, presumably, even cassette tapes.

Streaming services accounted for 12% of listening. No other category accounted for 10% or more of listening.

The study fills a gap in understanding about American's listening habits. No market research company had tracked the aggregate amount of audio consumers regularly consume.

The survey results demonstrate that audio is "the hottest space in the world

## Moore's 'Night' Rolls To No. 1; Chesney's 'Kids' Previews Album



**Justin Moore** snares his fourth No. 1 — and best weekly audience — on *Billboard*'s Country Airplay tally, as "Lettin' the Night Roll" (Valory) steps 2-1 in its 35th chart week. The Arkansas native previously led with "Til My

Last Day," which crowned the Jan. 5, 2013 Country Airplay chart (in its 41st week); "If Heaven Wasn't So Far Away" (July 23, 2011; 22 weeks); and "Small Town USA" (Oct. 3, 2009; 33 weeks). In between "Day" and "Night," Moore reached No. 2 last fall with "Point at You." "Point" and "Night" are from his third studio album, and second No. 1 on Top Country Albums, Off the Beaten Path. With his new No. 1, Moore logs his biggest weekly audience sum (46.9 million audience impressions, up 3 percent, according to Nielsen BDS), surpassing the 44.3 million impressions "Point" collected at its peak. Top local audience contributors for "Night" during the June 16-22 tracking week: KKBQ Houston (1.6 million impressions), WUSN Chicago (1.6 million), WNSH New York (1.2 million), KPLX Dallas (1.1 million) and KKGO Los Angeles (950,000).

With Hot Shot Debut honors, **Kenny Chesney** plants the lead single from his upcoming album

at No. 27, as "American Kids" (Blue Chair/Columbia Nashville) bows with 12.9 million audience impressions at 118 of the 145 stations monitored for the chart. Amid rampant speculation that the new album will be released before the end of the third quarter this year, no title or release date has been revealed. Although Chesney's debut with "Kids" is stellar, he has debuted higher nine times, starting highest at No. 13 two years ago with "Feel Like a Rock Star" (with **Tim McGraw**), which eventually peaked at No. 11. Dat-

ing to the Country Airplay chart's Jan. 20, 1990 launch, Chesney's 10 top 30 starts are the most of any artist; **Garth Brooks** ranks second, with seven. "Kids" adds Most Increased Audience, Breaker and Most Added stripes (at

least seven first-time spins, Monday-Sunday at 77 Country Airplay reporters).

Newcomer **Sam Hunt** posts a second-week surge with "Leave the Night On" (MCA Nashville), which rockets 53-33 on Country Airplay, aided by play at Clear Channel Media and Entertainment-owned stations that featured the song in the company's "On the Verge" spotlight during the tracking week. Its heaviest play came via the chain's **WSIX** Nashville (43 spins), while its top audience contributor was Clear Channel sister **KNIX** Phoenix (340,000 impressions). With spins at 72 of the 145 stations monitored for the chart, Hunt's single amassed 7.1 million impressions in the tracking week, up 524 percent from 1.1 million.

As noted last week in this space, Hunt co-wrote **Billy Currington**'s "We Are Tonight" (Mercury), which pushes 11-10 in its 31st chart week to become Currington's 12th top 10 on Country Air-

play. He most recently reached the upper tier with "Hey Girl," which led the Oct. 19, 2013 list.

**Luke Bryan** debuts at No. 60 with "Roller coaster" (Capitol Nashville), the fifth single from his *Crash My Party* album, as fourth single "Play It Again" dips 3-4 following a four-week stand at No. 1. All but one of the album's prior singles reached the Country Airplay summit; "That's My Kind of Night" rose to No. 2 (Nov. 2, 2013). A videoclip for the new track premiered June 20. ●

Brad Paisley joined Ludacris and Kesha as

celebrity observers in the game, which employs an app to gauge the viewing audience's reaction.

The Country Music Association's Songwriters Series is getting some TV love as PBS incorporates Lady Antebellum and Dierks Bentley into two episodes of its Front and Center concert property this fall. Both installments, which tape in Nashville this week, include songwriters and producers among the guests. PBS also has Tim Mc-Graw slated to kick off the new season of Live From the Artists Den, beginning July 4. Listen



for Bentley on July 1 as he provides the theme song to a new History Channel series, *Biker Battleground Phoenix*.

**Ray Stevens** has released his autobiography, *Ray Stevens' Nashville*, through Father & Son Publishing. Grand Ole Opry member **Jean Shepard** also issued her own memoir, *Down Through the Years*.

Local music fans in Winter Haven, Fla., have launched a campaign to restore the Derry Down, a club that played a role in the development of Americana figure **Gram Parsons**. **Jim Stafford**, **Flying Burrito Brothers** drummer **Jon Corneal** and **Allman Brothers** comrade **Les Dudek** are among the musicians playing a Parsons tribute show on June 28, according to *The Orlando Sentinel*.
