The results presented below were obtained through automated telephone interviews conducted by the New England College Polling Center on October 31, and November 1, 2014. A total of 1,526 responses were obtained, 778 from registered likely NH voters in Congressional District 1 and 748 from registered likely NH voters in Congressional District 2. The margin of error for questions 1,2 and 4 is $+/-2.51 \%$. The margin of error for question $3-C D 1$ is $+/-3.51 \%$ and for question $3-C D 2$ is $+/-3.58 \%$. The margin of error for question 5 is $+/-3.66 \%$ and for question 6 is $+/-4.06$.
