



Interpreting CEPA Scores: FAQ

What do the scores mean?

As with many popular commercial exams, CEPA multiple choice (MCQ) scores are not simple percentages, but rather a scaled score. Two students may get the same number of questions right, but have different CEPA scores because one student's answers were based on random guessing of multiple-choice questions (MCQs). Essays are banded, using a rubric, from 0-6, including half bands. They correlate highly with the MCQ portion of the exam. CEPA scores have been shown to be a very good predictor of student success at UAE institutions of higher education.

How do institutions use CEPA Scores?

Institutions of higher education in the UAE have complete autonomy in how they use the CEPA scores. Cut scores used by UAE University, Zayed University, the Higher Colleges of Technology, and Emirates College for Advanced Education are summarized below. How much can a student expect to improve in a semester?

Based on studies conducted at two of the institutions' foundation programs, it was found that the average student will gain around 4 points on a CEPA-English MCQ section, given around 20 contact hours per week. A very highly-motivated student may gain as many as 10 points.





How has the student population performed over the years?

The average CEPA-English MCQ score has increased steadily over the years. Note the jump between 2005 and 2007 when the stakes increased as the test was introduced as a cut score for admission into higher education.

Is that because the test has gotten easier?

No. The CEPA MCQ section is scored using an IRT model. Each test is linked to those of previous years. A given student could take any other version of the test and would likely get within 2 points of his or her original score.

How has the student population performed on the CEPA writing test over the years?

The average writing score has changed little over the years.

How do CEPA-English scores compare to scores on other exams?

These tests are not the same, and it is difficult to make an exact equivalency. Tests discriminate differently at different levels. However, an empirical study involving 1280 UAE-based students found the following relationship:
