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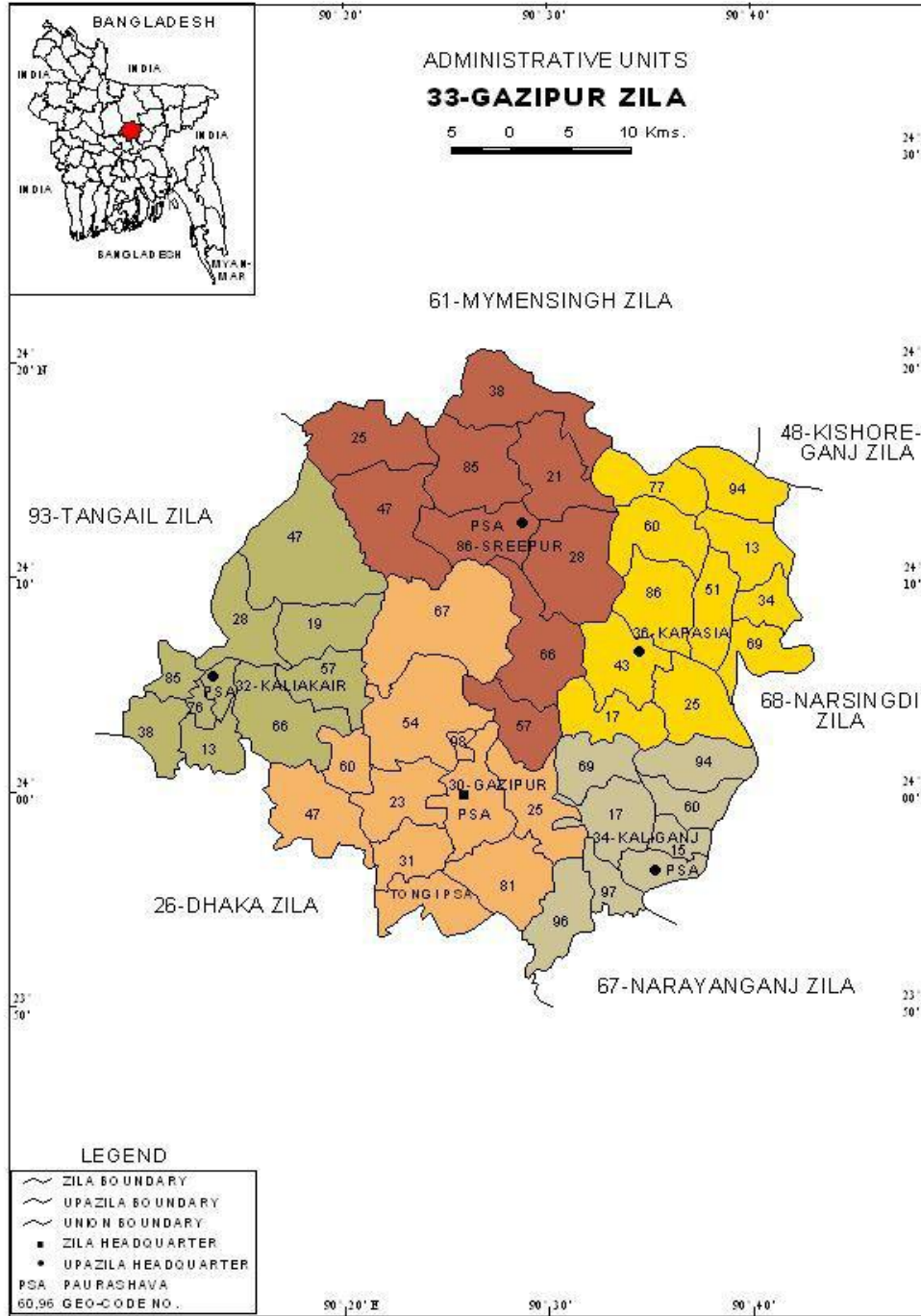
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District Map

CHAPTER 1

Introduction

District at a Glance

Background, Geographic Area and Location: Gazipur District is located at just north of capital city of Dhaka, Bangladesh. The previous name of the region is “**Joydebpur**”. Once, the region was under the deep jungle of Vowal Pargana (Sub- Division). Gazipur district is one of the ancient and historical regions with hundreds years old tradition. Gazipur district was previously a sub-division of Dhaka district. It was upgraded to a district in 1984 under Dhaka Division. It is bounded on the north by Mymensingh and Kishoreganj Districts, on the east by Narsingdi District, on the south by Narayanganj and Dhaka Districts and on the west by the Tangail District. The Geo position of Gazipur District is between 23°53’ to 24°20’ North latitudes and between 90°09’ to 90°42’ east longitude. The total area of the district is 1806.36 sq. km of which 17.53 sq. km was riverine and 273.42 sq.km. is forest area.

Annual Average Temperature and Rainfall: Annual average temperature of this district varies from maximum 36°C to minimum 12.7°C. Annual rainfall is 2376 mm.

Administration: There is a city corporation; 04 Municipalities in Gazipur District named Tongi, Sreepur, Kaliganj and Kaliakuir. The number of Upazilla in Gazipur district is 05, named- Gazipur Sadar, Kalikair, Kaligonj Kapashia and Sreepur containing 44 Unions, 762 Mauzas and 1,114 Villages.

Gazipur Town: Gazipur town is a very busy town which consists of 9 wards and 31 mahallas. The area of the town is 49.32 sq. km with a population of 123531. Among them male are 52.52%, female 47.48%. The density of population is 2505 per sq. km. Many important establishments like Bangladesh Rice Research Institute (BRRI), Bangladesh Agricultural Research Institute (BARI), CERDI, Seed Certifying Agency, The Security Printing Corporation (Bangladesh) Ltd, Machine Tools Factory, Bangladesh Ordnance Factory, Diesel Plant, BRAC Dairy Farm, Nova Poultry Limited, Cremation Ghat etc. are located within the town. Dhaka University of Engineering and Technology (Previously known as BIT: Bangladesh Institute of Technology) is also located in the town.

Main Rivers: The Old Brahmaputra, Shitalakshya, Turag, Bangshi, Balu, Banar are main rivers of this district.

Population: The total population of Gazipur district is 34,03,912 (Male- 17,75,310 and Female- 16,28,602), sex ratio 109:100, population density 1884/Sq Km and annual growth rate is 5.21%.

Literacy: The Literacy Rate of Gazipur district is 62.60% (Male- 66.00% and Female- 58.90%), School attendance rate is 42.50% for 5 to 24 years age group.

Marks of the War of Liberation: Mass killing site and mass grave are in eastern side of the Joydebpur Rajbari, Sathkamair, Tongi Shaheed Smriti School compound and at Gachha. Memorial monuments are ‘Jagrata Chaurangi’ at Joydebpur Chowrasta and the premises of the Joydebpur Rajbari.

Manufactures: Garments industry, Aluminum factory, Textile mill, Pharmaceutical industry, Cosmetics industry, Machine tools factory, Diesel plant, Security printing press, Ordnance factory, Ceramics factory, Packaging industry, Brick field etc.

Main Crops: Paddy, jute, mustard seed, sugarcane, chilli, arum, turmeric, ginger etc are main crops of this district.

Main Fruits: Jackfruit, pineapple, litchi, black berry, guava, mango, papaya, kamranga, palm, boroi, karamcha, wood apple, tamarind etc. are main fruits of this district.

Main Exports: Vegetables, fruits, medicine, cosmetics, cigarettes, aluminum products, readymade garments, mosquito coil, beverage (soft drinks) etc are main exports items of this district.

Communication System: There is a good communication with the capital with Dhaka-Tongi diversion road. This district has good communication with rest of the country. There are also railway facilities. 5 railway stations Rajendropur, Sripur, Dhirasrom, Joydevpur and Tongi in Gazipur district.

Places to See: Dholsamundra-this was the capital of the local Pala kings and Jamindar Bari at Baliadi(Kaliakoir), Kalinarayana Temple (1900)-built by Maharaya Kalinarayana of Bhawal(Joydebpur), Bhawal Rajbari-was the home of Prince Ramendra Narayan of the Bhawal case(Joydebpur), Pubail Resort, National Park, Zinda Park, Vadun, Kudabo, Toke Badshahi Mosque, Dighi and Mazar at Chaura and Nuhash Palli-an artificial village designed by famous writer Humayan Ahmed.

Educational Institutions: There are five universities, 2 technical institutions, 3 agricultural institutions, 3 Government colleges and many other institutions in Gazipur district. 5 universities are Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman Agricultural University (formerly the Institute of Postgraduate Studies on Agriculture), Dhaka University of Engineering and Technology, Bangladesh Open University, Bangladesh National University and the Islamic University of Technology(international University under OIC). There is also a lot of school, college, madra in this district. Beside these 1 primary training institute, 1 scout training centre (Mouchak), 1 madrasa teacher's training institute and 1 tele-communication staff college belong to this district.

Economic Situation: Agrarian economy prevails almost in all the corners of the district. Out of total 538,597 holdings, about 42.74% holdings are performing agricultural activities which produces varieties of crops, namely, local and HYV paddy, jute, pulses, vegetables, oilseeds and other minor crops, jackfruit, palm and wood trees adds a bumper earning to well-to-do farmers. Non-farm economic activities have also a substantial share in revenue earnings and livelihood of rural people of the district.

The only machine tools factory of the country, Bangladesh Rice Research Institute, Agricultural Research Institute for post graduate studies in Agriculture and the national park etc. create employment opportunities to the local people which ultimately helps economic development of the locality as well as of the country.

Non-Agricultural activities are still sparse and an impression about their extent can be obtained from the following table-1 based on the census of non-farm economic activities conducted by BBS in 2001-2003 showing the type and number of establishments together with persons engaged in those establishments:

It is reported that in all these economic sectors about 62.21% of all the establishments are located in urban areas and 37.79% of the total is located in rural areas.

Flora and Fauna

Flora: All the upazilas under Gazipur district fall within the physiographic unit known as Madhupur jungle tract (*Bhawal Garh*). In many parts of this tract, the terrace topography is not flat but consists of low rounded hills and ridges separated by a close pattern of shallow bides (*velleys*). Such areas occur extensively in Gazipur Sadar, Kaliakair, Shreepur, Kapasia and Kaliganj upazilas. Besides, few beels are situated in the periphery of some of the upazilas.

The soil conditions in the Bhawal Garh are varied and often complex. A surprising range of soils is found, from red laterite soils at the extreme to almost undeveloped soils of raw Pleistocene clay at the other, with numerous intermediate stages developed between them and also with several kinds of soils occurring in the associated valleys.

Various types of agricultural crops are grown in the district. Among cereal crops, boro covers the largest area followed by aman, aus and wheat mixed aus and aman are also grown. Other crops include jute, mesta, mustard, vegetables and spices, sesame, sugarcane, pineapple, (*Ananas comosus*), guava (*Psidium guajava*) etc. Jack- fruit (*Artocarpus heterophyllus*) is extensively grown and is an important cash crop.

A wide variety of trees, shrubs and thickets of bamboos and bananas and form the groves that surround the village homestead. Homestead agricultural plots and forests are closely interspersed

and it appears that the forest is rapidly disappearing because of lumber poaching and conversion of forest lands into agricultural plots.

The Madhupur tract (*Bhawal Garh*) is dominated by coppice sal (*shorea robusta*), *garjan*, (*Dipterocarpus turbinatus*) covering about 80% of the tree stands in association with sheel koroy (*Albizia procera*), kadam (*Anthocephalus cadamba*), ajuli (*Dillenia pentagyma*), jarul (*Legerstroemia speciosa*), banyan tree (*Ficus benghalensis*), ashwatha (*Ficus religiosa*), bahera (*Terminalia bellirica*), haritaki (*Terminalia chebula*), black berry (*Syzygium cumini*) etc. The middle canopy comprises of neem (*Azadirachta indica*), kanchan (*Bauhinia variegata*), sonalu (*Cassia fistula*), minjiri (*Cassia siamea*), kumbhi (*careya arborea*), mango (*Mangifera indica*), amra (*Spondias mangifera*).

Amloki (*Phyllanthus emblica*), bonboroi (*Zizyphus rugosa*), sinduri (*Mallotus philippensis*), ashoka (*Saraca indica*), sheora (*Streblus asper*), gab (*Diospyros precatorius*), mahaneem (*Garuga pinnata*), etc. The lower canopy and the climbers-cum-lianas are composed of spatholobus roxburghii, gila entada pursaetha, kul (*Zizyphus mauritiana*), kumarika (*Smilax aspera*), gach alu (*Dioscorea sp*), babul (*Acacia arabica*), wood (*Fordia fruticosa*), bamboo (*Bambusa sp.*), sotthi (*Curcuma zedoaria*) etc.

In the poorer forested areas there are large tracts with koroy as the main species and an under growth of kurchi, akanda, mankata (*Randia dumetorum*), thatch grass (*Arundinacea cylindrica*) and mimosa pudica. Furthermore, some aqua plants like lotus (*Nelumbo nucifera*), few species of waterlily (*Nymphaea nouchalia*), various hydrophytes and the weed known as water hyacinth (*Telanthera philoxeroides*), etc. are commonly seen in different ponds, ditches and shallow water bodies of this area.

Fauna

Mammals: With the ruthless destruction of forests in the Modhupur tract (Bhawal Garh), most of the wild animals have disappeared from this area. However, some animals belonging to mammalian fauna are still found in the Gazipur district. They are rhesus monkey (*Macaca mullata*), wild boar (*Sus scrofa*), hispid hare (*Caprolagus hispidus*), jungle cat (*Felis chaus*), flying fox (*Pteropus giganteus*), shortnosed fruit bat (*Cynopterus spinx*), jackal (*Canis aureus*), common otter (*Lutra perspicillata*), common mongoose (*Herpestes edwardsi*), house mouse (*Mus musculus*), common house rat (*Bandicota bengalensis*), Indian porcupine (*Hystrix indica*), etc.

Birds: Different species of birds that are commonly found in this district are little cormorant (*Phalacrocorac niger*), pond heron (*Ardeola grayii*), white breasted water hen (*Amaurornis phoenicurus*), spotted dove (*Streptopelia chinensis*), redbreasted parakeet (*Psittacula alexandari*), roseringed parakeet (*Psittacula enpatria*), koel (*Eudynamis scolopacea*), spotted owlet (*Athene brama*), barn owl (*Tyto alba*), house swift (*Apus affinis*), whitebreasted kingfisher (*Helcyon smyrnensis*), green bee-eater (*Merops orientalis*), lesser golden backed wood pecker (*Picus myrmecophoneus*), black drongo (*Dicurus macrocercus*), greater racket-tailed drongo (*Dicrurus paradiseus*), common mayna (*Acridotheres tristis*), house crow (*Corvus splendens*), jungle mayna (*Acridotheres fuscus*), redvented bulbul (*Pycnotus cafer*), tailor bird (*Orthotomus sutorius*), magpie-robin (*Copsychus saularis*), shyama (*Copsychus malabaricus*), house sparrow (*Passer domesticus*), weaver bird (*Ploceus phillippinus*), spotted munia (*Lonchura punctulata*) etc.

Besides, different species of winter migrants that visit Bangladesh are also seen in the beel and char areas of the district. These include little ringed plover (*Charadrius hiaticus*), common sand piper (*Tringa hypoleucos*), common teal (*Anas crecca*), pintail (*Anas acuta*), common shelduck (*Tadorna tadorna*), grey leg goose (*Anser anser*), common swallow (*Hirundo rustica*), large pariah kite (*Milvus migrant lineatas*), brown shrike (*Lanius cristatus*), pied harrier (*Circus melenoleucos*), little stint (*Calidris minuta*), fantail snipe (*Gallinago gallinago*), pintailed snipe (*Gallinago stenura*), grey wagtail (*Motacilla cinerea*) etc.

Reptiles and Amphibians: Reptiles that are commonly found in this district are peacock soft shell (*Trionyx hurum*), roofed turtle (*Kachuga tecta*), house lizard (*Hemidactylus frenatus*), shundh (*Gekko gekko*), bengal grey lizard (*Varanus bengalensis*), yellow speckled wolf snake (*Lycodon jara*), checkered keelback (*Xenochrophis piscator*), rat snake (*Ptyas nigromarginatus*), common smooth water snake (*Enhydryis enhydryis*), common krait (*Bungarus cacruleus*), banded krait (*Bungarus fasciatus*) etc.

Amphibians are not rich in species but very much in numbers. Common amphibian includes Indian bull frog (*Rana trgerina*), skipper frog (*Rana cyanophlyctis*), cricket frog (*Rana limnocharis*), common toad (*Bufo melanostictus*), ballon frog (*Uperodon globulosus*).

Fishes: Various water bodies of the district constitute habitats for fish population. A large variety of fish that are found here are ruhi (*Labeo rohita*), katla (*Catla catla*), mrigel (*Cirrhinus mrigala*), kalibaush (*Labeo calbasu*), magur (*Clarias batrachus*), shing (*Heteropneustes fossilis*), shoil (*Channa striatus*), airh (*Mystus aor*), bele (*Glossogobius giuris*), boal (*Wallago attu*), phalli (*Notopterus notopterus*), koi (*Anabas testudineus*), datina (*Acanthopagrus latus*), tengra (*Mystus vittatus*), chanda (*Mene mukulata*), bain (*Mastacembelus armatus*), gozar (*Channa marulius*), kholisha (*Colisa fasciatus*), mola (*Amblypharyngodon mola*), pabda (*Ompok pabda*), sharputi (*Puntius sarana*), pangas (*Pangasius pangasius*) chingri (*Palaemon malcolmsonic*) etc.

In addition, some exotic varieties of fish like tilapia (*Oreochromis mossambicus*), nailotica (*Oreochromis niloticus*), silvercarp (*Hypophthalmicthys molitrix*), grasscarp (*Cteopharyngodon idella*) etc are also cultivated.

Concepts and Definitions

1. Population and Housing Census 2011

The population and housing census is the unique source of reliable and comprehensive data about the size of the population of the country, major socio-economic and socio-demographic characteristics.

It is the total process of collecting, compiling, evaluating, analyzing and publishing or otherwise disseminating demographic, economic and social data pertaining, at a specified time, to all persons in a country. The essential features of a population census are individual enumeration, universality within a defined territory, simultaneity and defined periodicity.

The population and housing census provides information on the geographic and administrative distribution of the population and household in addition to the demographic and socioeconomic characteristics of all the people in the country. The data from the census are classified, tabulated and disseminated so that political leaders, election officials, planners, national organizations including NGOs and civil society, regional and international organizations can use the data in decision-making.

The purpose of community report is to disseminate census data by communities (ward/mahalla in urban area and union/mauza/village in rural area). Data on all key variables namely area, household, population by sex and age group, ethnic population, literacy rate, marital status, school attendance, employment status and religion as well as physical facilities such as source of drinking water, sanitation, electricity and dwelling units have been presented in this report. The planners, researchers and policy makers as well as development partners and community administrators will find this report as a valuable reference for use in advising plans and programs for advancing welfare and well-being of the common people, in particular and the community in general.

Household

Persons, either related or unrelated, living together and taking food from the same kitchen constitute a household. A single person living and eating alone forms one-person household.

Literacy

It denotes ability to write a letter in any language. Literacy status assessment is made for population 7 years and over.

Community

It refers to the following five lower geographic, administrative or revenue units:

- i) **Union:** Smallest administrative rural geographic unit comprising of mauzas and villages and having union parishad institution.
- ii) **Mauza :** Mauza is the lowest administrative unit having a separate jurisdiction list number (J.L. No.) in revenue records. Every mauza has its well-demarcated cadastral map. Mauza should be distinguished from local village since a mauza may consist of one or more villages.
- iii) **Village:** Lowest rural geographic unit either equivalent to a mauza or part of a mauza.
- iv) **Ward:** Smallest administrative urban geographic unit comprising of mahallas and having ward council institution.
- v) **Mahalla:** Lowest urban geographic unit having identifiable boundaries.

Urban Area

It corresponds with area developed around a central place having such amenities as metalled roads, improved communication, electricity, gas, water supply, sewerage, sanitation and also having comparatively higher density of population with majority population in non-agricultural occupations.

- i) **City Corporation:** It includes city corporation area declared by the Ministry of Local Government.
- ii) **Paurashava/Municipality Area:** It includes paurashavas incorporated and administered by local government under paurashava Ordinance, 1977.

2. Agriculture Census year and reference period

The census year extends over twelve consecutive months having for different census items the different reference periods or days of data collections. Some items have a year or week reference period. Some others have a specific reference day. The different census items by their reference periods or days are shown below:

Agriculture holding

An agriculture holding is a techno-economic unit of agricultural production under single management comprising all livestock kept and all land used wholly or partly for agricultural production purposes without regard to title, legal form or size. Single management may be exercised by either an individual holder or jointly by two or more individuals or holders or by a judicial person such as a corporation, co-operative or government agency. A holding may consist of one or more parcels (fragments of land) located in one or more areas or mauzas or in more than one administrative unit or division provided that all separate parcels of fragments form parts of same technical unit under operational control of same management.

The definition covers practically all holdings/households engaged in agricultural production of both crops and livestock. Some agriculture holdings may have no significant agricultural land, e.g. holdings keeping livestock, poultry and hatcheries for which land is not an indispensable input for production.

Farm holding

A farm holding is defined as being an agricultural production unit having cultivated land equal to or more than 0.05 acres. Farm holdings are classified into following three broad groups:

- (a) **small:** Farm holdings having minimum cultivated land 0.05 acre but operated land more than this minimum but upto 2.49 acres.
- (b) **medium:** Farm holdings having operated land in between 2.50 to 7.49 acres.
- (c) **large:** Farm holdings having operated land 7.50 acres and above.

Small cultivated land 0.04 acre or less is generally used for kitchen garden growing mainly vegetables. Often seeds of white gourd, water gourd, pumpkin and other strains are sown on households; but these creepers spread out around house roofs and other structures. As such, the minimum cultivated land considered for qualifying to be a farm holding is 0.05 acres.

Non-farm holdings

A non-farm holding is defined as being the one which has neither cultivated nor operated land or has cultivated land less than 0.05 acre.

Tenancy

Owner holdings are those having and operating their owned land and who may or may not be leasing out land.

Tenant holdings are those having no owned land but operating land taken from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Owner-cum-tenant holdings are those having owned land and who may or may not be leasing out their own land to others and who may be taking land from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Agriculture work

Agriculture work signifies all activities of holder and his/her labour force doing planning, management, and operation of a holding. It includes land preparation, sowing, weeding, harvesting, feeding and tending livestock & poultry, kitchen gardening, supervising agricultural workers, keeping farm records & accounts, preparing agriculture products for marketing (including packaging), repairing farm equipment, constructing farm buildings & fences, and engaging in land reclamation and improvement and other related activities. It excludes home and other family domestic chores.

Area under pond

The pond area remains under water almost through out the year. Normally, households use pond water for various domestic and sometimes agriculture purposes. Ponds are also generally used for fish culture.

In the census the pond area data were collected separately for both single ownership and joint ownership of households.

Area under permanent crops

It is the land area planted to crops which remain standing for a long period of time and do not need to be replanted after a seasonal harvest. Mango, jackfruit, coconut, guava, lemon, and other fruit varieties are all permanent crops.

Current fallow

It is land brought into cultivation but left out uncultivated in census year for fertility regaining and improvement or for other reasons.

Net cultivated area

This is land area actually cropped during the census year regardless of number of crops grown plus current fallow. It includes areas under temporary and permanent crops and also current fallow.

Permanent fallow

It is land not available for cultivation due to coming into residence and commercial & other uses. Play ground, graveyard, wild shrubs and jungles, marshy land, and the like fall in this category.

Irrigated area

This is area of total land brought under irrigation coverage for growing crops with irrigations done through mechanical or manual means. Irrigated area classifications fall into two categories: (1) surface water irrigation with main water sources being rivers, canals, beels, ponds, and other water bodies; and (2) underground water irrigation with water lifted by shallow tube-wells, deep tube-wells, and country traditional devices. The irrigation equipments are run by electricity, diesel or petrol, or manual labour.

Temporary crops gross area

Areas aggregated for all temporary crops grown in the census year have made **temporary crops gross area** greater than **temporary crops net area** since the latter has within it the same land cropped more than once in different seasons of a year.

Intensity of cropping

It is percentage of temporary crops gross area in comparison with temporary crops net area. It is expressed as follows:

$$\text{Intensity of cropping} = \frac{\text{Temporary crops gross area}}{\text{Temporary crops net area}} \times 100$$

Cereals

Main cereals are rice and then wheat. Other cereals are jab, barley, cheena, maize, kaun, bajra and joar.

Pulses

Main and common pulses are gram, mung, lentil, arhar, gari kalai, khesari and pea.

Oil seeds

Main oil seeds are rape and mustard, sesamum, linseed, groundnut, soybean, sunflower and castor.

Vegetables

Farmers grow both summer and winter vegetables. Main vegetables are potato, brinjal, raddish, arum, lady's finger, cauliflower, cabbage, bean, tomato, patal, gourd, cucumber, pumpkin, knoll-kal-turnip, dhundal, barbati, khirai, chichinga, carrot, kakrol and sak.

Cash crop

Main cash crops are jute, mesta, sunhemp, cotton, sugarcane and tobacco.

Spices

The main spices include turmeric, ginger, chilies, onion, garlic, coriander, black cumin and ani seed.

Fuel crops

Dhaincha and other smaller plants used as cooking-fuel.
