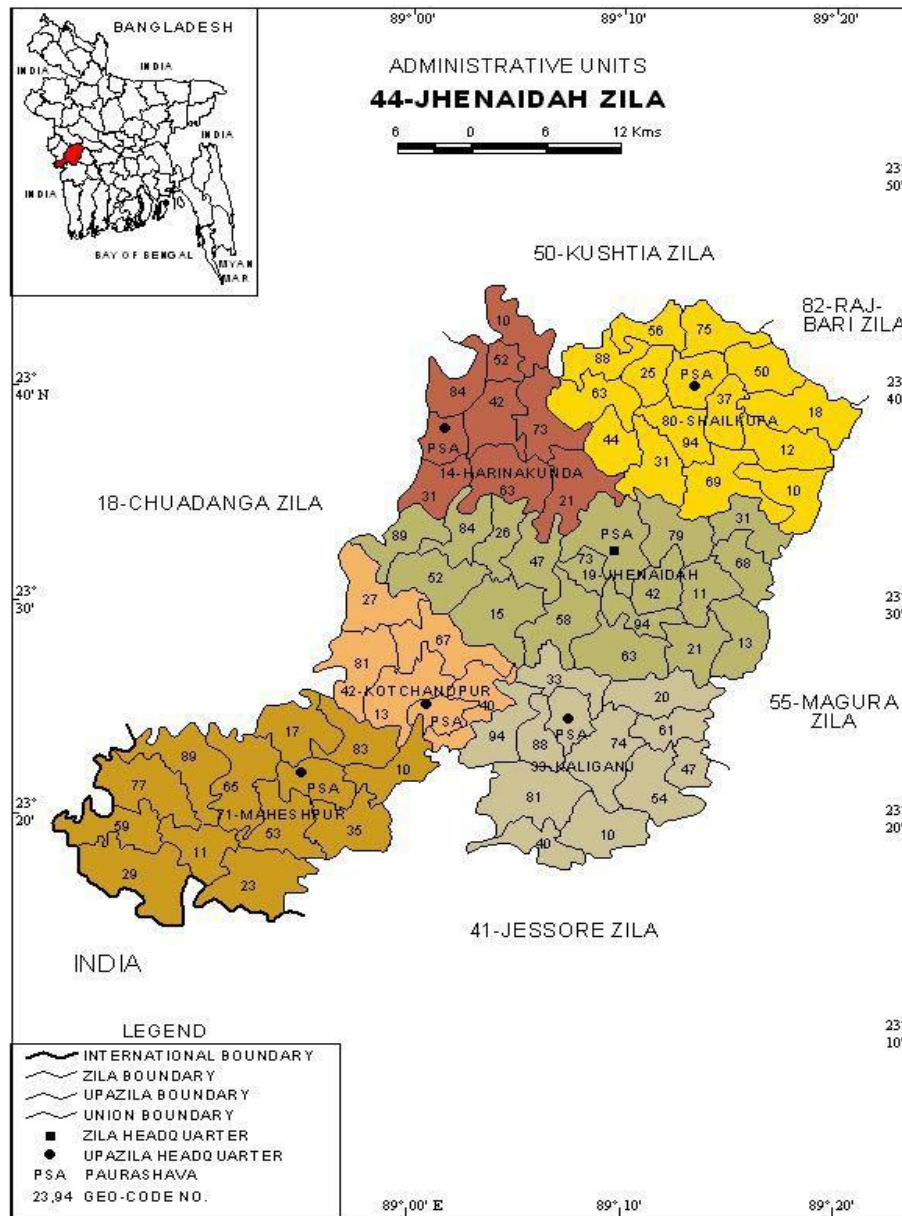

CHAPTER 1

Introduction

District at a Glance

Background: Jhenaidah was a former subdivision of Jessore district. It became a separate district in 1984. Nothing is definitely known about the district name. There is a hearsay that in the long past, the area became prominent for collection of Jhinuk from the river Nobagonga and burning (meaning Daha in Bengali) them for the production of calcium. The district might have derived its name as Jhinaidah from the above words. **Jhinuk** and **Daha**.

Geographic Area and Location: Jhenaidah is surrounded on the north by Kushtia and Rajbari districts, on the east by Magura district, on the south by Jessore district and on the west by Chuadanga district and India. The total area of the district is 1,964.77 sq.km (758.60 sq. miles). The district lies between 23°13` and 23°46` North latitudes and between 88°42` and 89°23` East longitudes.

Annual Average Temperature and Rainfall: The annual average temperature varies from maximum 37.1°C to minimum 11.2°C and the average annual rainfall 1467 mm.

Administration: Jhenaidah subdivision was established in 1862 and was turned into a district in 1984. The district consists of 6 upazilas, 67 unions, 945 mauzas, 1144 villages, 6 paurashavas, 54 wards and 136 mahallas. The upazilas are Jhenaidah Sadar, Shailkupa, Kaliganj, Harinakundu, Kotchandpur and Maheshpur.

Population: Total population of the district is 17, 71,304 (both male and female), among them total male is 8, 86,402 and female is 8, 84,902.

Literacy: Total literacy of this district is 48.4 % (both male and female), of them male is 50.5% female is 46.3.

Main Rivers: The Garai, Kumar, Nabaganga, Begabati, Chitra, Bairab, Kobadak, Kodla, Phatki, Kaliganga and Ichamati are the main rivers of this district.

Archaeological Heritage and Relics: Biswabat (Bethuli), Harihar Garh (Shailkupa), Shailkupa Jami Mosque, Ram Gopal Mandir (Shailkupa), Rani Mata Dighi, Sawdaghar Dighi and Mosque, Gorai Mosque, Jor Bangla Mosque, Galakata Dighi and Mosque, Cheragdani Dighi and Mosque, Dighi of Sree Ram Raja, Tombs of Ghazi, Dhol Samudra Dighi (Jhenaidah Sadar), Naldangha Rajbari and Mandir (Kaliganj), Manasa Mandir (Maheshpur), Sree Krishna Balaram Dev Bigraha Mandir (Kaliganj) are notable archaeological heritage and relics in this district.

Historical Events: Bara Bazar (ancient name Gangadighee) of Kaliganj upazila had been a famous port of India. It has been mentioned in the Greek history that in ancient time Prabal and Muslin used to be export from this port. In the 1860s, Indigo Resistance Movement spread all over this district. During the War of Liberation in 1971, some battles were confronted between Pak army and the freedom fighters at Mandartala (Kaliganj), Dulalmundia and Besaykhali (Jhenaidah Sadar) in which several members of the Pak army were killed. Jhenaidah was liberated on 6 December 1971.

Marks of War of Liberation: There are 7 mass graves, 3 mass killing sites in this district which is testimony of the war of liberation.

Main Crops: Paddy, jute, wheat, sugarcane and mustard seed, onion garlic and varieties of pulse and vegetables are the major crops of this district.

Main Fruits: Mango, jackfruit, banana, litchi, coconut, dates and palm are the main fruits of this district.

Main Export Items: Paddy, jute, banana, onion, garlic, betel leaf and date molasses are main export items of this district.

Economic Situation: The economy of Jhenaidah district is predominantly agricultural. Out of total 385,860 holdings of the district, 66.50 % holdings are farms that produce varieties of crops namely local and HYV paddy, jute, sugarcane, wheat, vegetables, spices, pulses, oilseeds and other minor crops. Various fruits like mango, banana, jackfruit, guava, coconut, etc are grown. Varieties of fish are caught from rivers, flowing channels and even from paddy fields during rainy seasons. Besides crops livestock and poultry, fishery and handloom spinning and weaving are the main sources of household income.

Non-agricultural activities play an important role in the economy of the district. The following table1: showing the type and number of establishments together with persons engaged in those establishments is given below:

Flora and Fauna

Flora:

Jhenaidah district lies in the highest and driest part of Moribund Delta with a high proportion of sandy ridges. The soil of this area is matial (clayey), stiff and hard loam.

Various kinds of agricultural crops are grown in the district. Rice is the dominant crop. Aman covers the largest area followed by boro and aus. Gur made date-palms is the main cash crop.

Gram, masur, jute, sugarcane and mango are the other main cash crops. Vegetables, spices, barley, mash, mustard, khesari, sesame, linseed etc. are also grown.

The village homesteads are usually covered by the dense and lush green foliage of a wide variety of trees, shrubs and thickets of bamboos and bananas. Fruit trees like mango, jack fruit, date-palm, coconut and betelnut are commonly found in the vicinity of the village dwellings. Mangoes grow abundantly throughout the greater Jessore district, but Maheshpur, Kaliganj and Kotchandpur upazilas of the Jhenaidah district produce better varieties. The western half of Jessore and Jhenaidah districts have numerous groves of date-palm. In the greater Jessore district, the cultivation of date-palm for production of gur is of special importance. In fact, date-palm is extensively cultivated particularly in the Kaliganj and Kotchandpur upazila of the Jhenaidah district and Keshabpur upazila of the Jessore district.

Fruit trees also include bel (*Aegle marmelos*), ataphal (*Anona squamosa*), palm (*Borassus flabellifer*), papaya (*Carica papaya*), jambura (*Citrus decumana*), guava (*Psidium guajava*), dalim (*Punica granatum*), black berry (*Syzygium cumini*), boroi (*Zizyphusa mauritiana*), jamrul (*Syzygium samarangense*), tamarind (*Tamarindus indica*), kadbel (*Limonia acidissima*), shafeda (*Manilkara achras*) etc. Other tree species are pitraj (*Aphanomixls polystachia*), sajna (*Maringa obeifera*), sonalu (*Cassia fistula*), barun (*Crataeva magna*), sheora (*Strbuls asper*) bokphul (*Sesbania grandiflora*), karoi (*Albizia procera*), raintree koroy (*Albizia saman*), bara mehogini (*Swietenia macrophylla*), debdaru (*Polyalthia logifolia*), babla (*Acacia nilotica*), nageshwar (*Mesua nagassarium*), shimul (*Bombax ceiba*), kadam (*Anthocephalus cadamba*), sissoo (*Dalbergia sisso*), desofysas (*Diospyros embryopteris*), mendi (*Lawsonia inermis*), baria bans (*Bambusa bambos*), barak bans (*Bambusa tulda*) etc.

Trees like mandar (*Erythrina variegata*), jarul (*Legerstroemia speciosa*), bhadi (*Garuga pinnata*) hijol (*Barringtonia acutangula*) etc. grow along water-edges.

Roadside trees comprise neem (*Azadirachta indica*), palash (*Butea monosperna*), krishnachura (*Delonix regia*), katbadam (*Terminalia catappa*), arjun (*Terminalia arjuna*) banyan (*Ficus benghalensis*), ashatha (*Ficus religiosa*), palm (*Borassus flabellifer*) etc.

Besides, the district is dotted with numerous ponds, beels and baors which are filled with submerged and floating water plants, These include kachuri pana (*Eichhornia crassioes*), topa pana (*Pistiastratiotes lemna*) khudi pana (*Lemna paucicos*), shui pana (*Wolffia arrhiza*). Paniphul (*Trapa bispinosa*); the floating ferns. Azolla pinnata, salvinia cucullata and the like. In older and shallower water bodies are found species of keshurdam (*Ludwigia adscendens*), padma (*Nelumbo nucifera*), shapla (*Nymphaea nouchali*) kalmi (*Ipomoea fistulosa*), helencha (*Tilanthera philoxcroides*) etc.

Moreover, some ornamental plants are also grown at the homesteads for aesthetic purposes, These are hasnahena, patabahar, gondhoraj, dolan champa, beli, jaba, kamini, shefali, halde karabi etc.

Fauna:

Mammals: The mammalian fauna that are usually observed in the country side of the Jhenaidah district are Indur (*Bandicota bengalensis*), Nengti Indur (*Mus musculus*), Metho Indur (*Mus mus*), Common House rat (*Rattus ruttus*), jackal (*Canis aureus*), jungle cat (*Felis chaus*), ud-biral (*Aonyx cinerea*), indian pipistrelle (*Pipistrellus coromandra*), kola badur (*Pteropus giganteus*), chika (*Suncus murinus*), dura kathbirali (*Funambulus pennanti*), common mongoose (*Herpestes auropunctatus*), big mongoose (*Herpestes edwardsi*), tickels (*Heseeroptenus tickelli*) etc.

Birds: Few birds are commonly seen in both rural and urban areas. These are charui (*Passer domesticus*), crow (*Corvus splendens*), bhat salik (*Acridotheres tristis*), kali pencha (*Glaucidium radiatum*) and bulbuli (*Picnonotus cafer*). Other common birds include machranga (*Alcedo atthis*), kaththokra (*Picus myrmecophoneus*), tila ghughu (*Streptopelia chinensis*), botkol (*Treron phoenicoptera*), babui (*Ploceus philippinus*), tuntuni (*Orthotomus sutorius*), robin (*Coppychus saularis*), lalchil (*Haliaster indus*), choto fingeey (*Dicurus macrocercus*), holdey pakhi (*Oriolus xanthornus*), dahuk (*Amaurornis hoenicurus*), kalo kokil (*Cuculus micropterus*), laxmi pencha (*Tyto alba*), khuruley pencha (*Athene brama*), pond heron (*Ardeola grayii*), tota (*Psittacula alexanderi*), pankowri (*Phalacrocorac niger*) etc.

Moreover, a large number of migrant birds such as badami bashai pakhi (*Lanius cristatus*), choto jiria (*Charadrius alenasdrinus*), chaga (*Gallinago stenura*), kada khucha (*Gallinago gallinago*), khonjon (*Motacilla cinerea*), Sada khonjani (*Motacilla alba*), rakhalbhulani (*Circus melanolencos*), bamunia hans (*Aythya fuligula*), bhuti hans (*Aythya nyroca*), kalo hans (*Aythya ferina*), giria hans (*Anas querquedula*), lenja hans (*Anas acuta*), chokachoki (*Tadorna ferruginea*), shachka (*Tadorna tadorna*), raj hans (*Anser indicus*), booted warbler (*Hippolais caligata*), common tern (*Sterna hirusdo*), marsh harrier (*Circus aeruginosus*) etc. enter into Bangladesh during winter. These are observed in different beels and baors of the district.

Reptiles and Amphibians: Among snakes, dhora snake (*Xenocrophis piscator*) is the commonest species. The most poisonous ones are the kal keotey (*Bungarus fasciatus*) and gokhra (*Naja naja*). Other common snakes include daraj snake (*Ptyas mucosus*), maitay snake (*Micropisthodon plumbicalor*), ghargini snake (*Lycodon jara*), shankhini shap (*Bungarus fasciatus*) etc.

Besides, few species from gekkondae familuy such as tiktki (*Hemidactylus frenatus*), house lizard (*Hemidactylus brooki*) and tokkhak (*Gekko gekko*) are found here. Of the varanidae family, guishap (*Varanus salvator*) and hungui shap (*Varanus flaviscens*) are the common ones. Of Emydidae family, korikaitta (*Kachuga tecta*), kali kaitta (*Hardella thurjii*), holdey kaitta (*Morenia petersi*), and dhum kasim (*Trionyx hurum*) are commonly found.

The most common amphibians like kotkoti bang (*Rana cyanophlyctis*), kuno bang (*Bufo melanostictus*), jhijhi bang (*Rana limnocharis*) and bhawa bang (*Rana tigerina*) are also found in the district.

Fishes : Ponds, beels, baors and rivers of district are the natural habitat for various species of fish. The common species of fish that are abundantly available in those water bodies are ruhi (*Labeo rohita*), catla (*Catla catla*), kalbaush (*Labeo calbasu*), mrigel (*Cirrhinus mrigala*), koi (*Anabas testudineus*), shing (*Heteropneustes fossilis*), magur (*Clarias batrachus*), airh (*Mystus aor*), boal (*Wallago attu*), pangas (*Pangasius Pangasius*), shoil (*Channa striatus*), bele (*Awaous gutum*), chital (*Notopterus chitala*), pabda (*Ompok pabda*), tengra (*Mystus vittatus*), phali (*Notopterus notopterus*), sarpunti (*Puntius sarana*), gazar (*Channa marulius*) etc.

Exotic fishes like grass carp (*Cteopharyngodon idella*), silver carp (*Hypophthalmicthys molitrix*), telapia (*Oreochromis mossambicus*), nilotica (*Oreochromis niloticus*), etc. have also been introduced for commercial pisciculture in ponds and tanks,

Concepts and Definitions

1. Population and Housing Census 2011

The population and housing census is the unique source of reliable and comprehensive data about the size of the population of the country, major socio-economic and socio-demographic characteristics.

It is the total process of collecting, compiling, evaluating, analyzing and publishing or otherwise disseminating demographic, economic and social data pertaining, at a specified time, to all persons in a country. The essential features of a population census are individual enumeration, universality within a defined territory, simultaneity and defined periodicity.

The population and housing census provides information on the geographic and administrative distribution of the population and household in addition to the demographic and socioeconomic characteristics of all the people in the country. The data from the census are classified, tabulated and disseminated so that political leaders, election officials, planners, national organizations including NGOs and civil society, regional and international organizations can use the data in decision-making.

The purpose of community report is to disseminate census data by communities (ward/mahalla in urban area and union/mauza/village in rural area). Data on all key variables namely area, household, population by sex and age group, ethnic population, literacy rate, marital status, school attendance, employment status and religion as well as physical facilities such as source of drinking water, sanitation, electricity and dwelling units have been presented in this report. The planners, researchers and policy makers as well as development partners and community administrators will find this report as a valuable reference for use in advising plans and programs for advancing welfare and well-being of the common people, in particular and the community in general.

Household

Persons, either related or unrelated, living together and taking food from the same kitchen constitute a household. A single person living and eating alone forms one-person household.

Literacy

It denotes ability to write a letter in any language. Literacy status assessment is made for population 7 years and over.

Community

It refers to the following five lower geographic, administrative or revenue units:

- i) **Union:** Smallest administrative rural geographic unit comprising of mauzas and villages and having union parishad institution.
- ii) **Mauza :** Mauza is the lowest administrative unit having a separate jurisdiction list number (J.L. No.) in revenue records. Every mauza has its well-demarcated cadastral map. Mauza should be distinguished from local village since a mauza may consist of one or more villages.
- iii) **Village:** Lowest rural geographic unit either equivalent to a mauza or part of a mauza.
- iv) **Ward:** Smallest administrative urban geographic unit comprising of mahallas and having ward council institution.
- v) **Mahalla:** Lowest urban geographic unit having identifiable boundaries.

Urban Area

It corresponds with area developed around a central place having such amenities as metalled roads, improved communication, electricity, gas, water supply, sewerage, sanitation and also having comparatively higher density of population with majority population in non-agricultural occupations.

i) City Corporation: It includes city corporation area declared by the Ministry of Local Government.

ii) Paurashava/Municipality Area: It includes paurashavas incorporated and administered by local government under Paurashava Ordinance, 1977.

2. Agriculture Census year and reference period

The census year extends over twelve consecutive months having for different census items the different reference periods or days of data collections. Some items have a year or week reference period. Some others have a specific reference day.

The census year covered twelve months from 1 Baishak to 30 Choitra, 1414 Bangla Shal (BS). This year was the reference period for such census items as operated land use, crops, agriculture employment, livestock & poultry deaths and agriculture loan. A single reference day was used for items like holdings, farm size, land tenure, farm population, livestock & poultry inventories and agriculture implements.

The different census items by their reference periods or days are shown below:

Agriculture holding

An agriculture holding is a techno-economic unit of agricultural production under single management comprising all livestock kept and all land used wholly or partly for agricultural production purposes without regard to title, legal form or size. Single management may be exercised by either an individual holder or jointly by two or more individuals or holders or by a judicial person such as a corporation, co-operative or government agency. A holding may consist of one or more parcels (fragments of land) located in one or more areas or mauzas or in more than one administrative unit or division provided that all separate parcels of fragments form parts of same technical unit under operational control of same management.

The definition covers practically all holdings/households engaged in agricultural production of both crops and livestock. Some agriculture holdings may have no significant agricultural land, e.g. holdings keeping livestock, poultry and hatcheries for which land is not an indispensable input for production.

Farm holding

A farm holding is defined as being an agricultural production unit having cultivated land equal to or more than 0.05 acres. Farm holdings are classified into following three broad groups:

- (a) **small:** Farm holdings having minimum cultivated land 0.05 acre but operated land more than this minimum but upto 2.49 acres.
- (b) **medium:** Farm holdings having operated land in between 2.50 to 7.49 acres.
- (c) **large:** Farm holdings having operated land 7.50 acres and above.

Small cultivated land 0.04 acre or less is generally used for kitchen garden growing mainly vegetables. Often seeds of white gourd, water gourd, pumpkin and other strains are sown on households; but these creepers spread out around house roofs and other structures. As such, the minimum cultivated land considered for qualifying to be a farm holding is 0.05 acres.

Non-farm holdings

A non-farm holding is defined as being the one which has neither cultivated nor operated land or has cultivated land less than 0.05 acre.

Tenancy

Owner holdings are those having and operating their owned land and who may or may not be leasing out land.

Tenant holdings are those having no owned land but operating land taken from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Owner-cum-tenant holdings are those having owned land and who may or may not be leasing out their own land to others and who may be taking land from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Agriculture work

Agriculture work signifies all activities of holder and his/her labour force doing planning, management, and operation of a holding. It includes land preparation, sowing, weeding, harvesting, feeding and tending livestock & poultry, kitchen gardening, supervising agricultural workers, keeping farm records & accounts, preparing agriculture products for marketing (including packaging), repairing farm equipment, constructing farm buildings & fences, and engaging in land reclamation and improvement and other related activities. It excludes home and other family domestic chores.

Area under pond

The pond area remains under water almost through out the year. Normally, households use pond water for various domestic and sometimes agriculture purposes. Ponds are also generally used for fish culture.

In the census the pond area data were collected separately for both single ownership and joint ownership of households.

Area under temporary crops

It is the land area planted to crops having growing cycle or length of life less than one year. These are the temporary crops such as paddy, wheat, jute, cotton, tobacco, sugarcane, pulses, oil seeds, potato, vegetables and other seasonal crops. A list of temporary crops for which data were collected separately was given in back page of "Tally Sheet". The minimum area recorded for a temporary crop was 0.01 acre. Area under temporary crops and temporary-crops net area are equivalents.

Area under permanent crops

It is the land area planted to crops which remain standing for a long period of time and do not need to be replanted after a seasonal harvest. Mango, jackfruit, coconut, guava, lemon, and other fruit varieties are all permanent crops.

Current fallow

It is land brought into cultivation but left out uncultivated in census year for fertility regaining and improvement or for other reasons.

Net cultivated area

This is land area actually cropped during the census year regardless of number of crops grown plus current fallow. It includes areas under temporary and permanent crops and also current fallow.

Permanent fallow

It is land not available for cultivation due to coming into residence and commercial & other uses. Play ground, graveyard, wild shrubs and jungles, marshy land, and the like fall in this category.

Irrigated area

This is area of total land brought under irrigation coverage for growing crops with irrigations done through mechanical or manual means. Irrigated area classifications fall into two categories: (1) surface water irrigation with main water sources being rivers, canals, beels, ponds, and other water bodies; and (2) underground water irrigation with water lifted by shallow tube-wells, deep tube-wells, and country traditional devices. The irrigation equipments are run by electricity, diesel or petrol, or manual labour.

Cattle and Buffalo

Cattle and buffalo heads owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Goats and Sheep

Goats and sheep owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Fowls, Ducks and Pigeons

Fowls, ducks and pigeons owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Temporary crops gross area

Areas aggregated for all temporary crops grown in the census year have made **temporary crops gross area** greater than **temporary crops net area** since the latter has within it the same land cropped more than once in different seasons of a year.

Intensity of cropping

It is percentage of temporary crops gross area in comparison with temporary crops net area. It is expressed as follows:

$$\text{Intensity of cropping} = \frac{\text{Temporary crops gross area}}{\text{Temporary crops net area}} \times 100$$

Cereals

Main cereals are rice and then wheat. Other cereals are jab, barley, cheena, maize, kaun, bajra and joar.

Pulses

Main and common pulses are gram, mung, lentil, arhar, gari kalai, khesari and pea.

Oil seeds

Main oil seeds are rape and mustard, sesamum, linseed, groundnut, soybean, sunflower and castor.

Vegetables

Farmers grow both summer and winter vegetables. Main vegetables are potato, brinjal, raddish, arum, lady's finger, cauliflower, cabbage, bean, tomato, patal, gourd, cucumber, pumpkin, knoll-kal-turnip, dhundal, barbati, khirai, chichinga, carrot, kakrol and sak.

Cash crop

Main cash crops are jute, mesta, sunhemp, cotton, sugarcane and tobacco.

Spices

The main spices include turmeric, ginger, chillies, onion, garlic, corriander, black cumin and ani seed.

Fuel crops

Dhaincha and other smaller plants used as cooking-fue
