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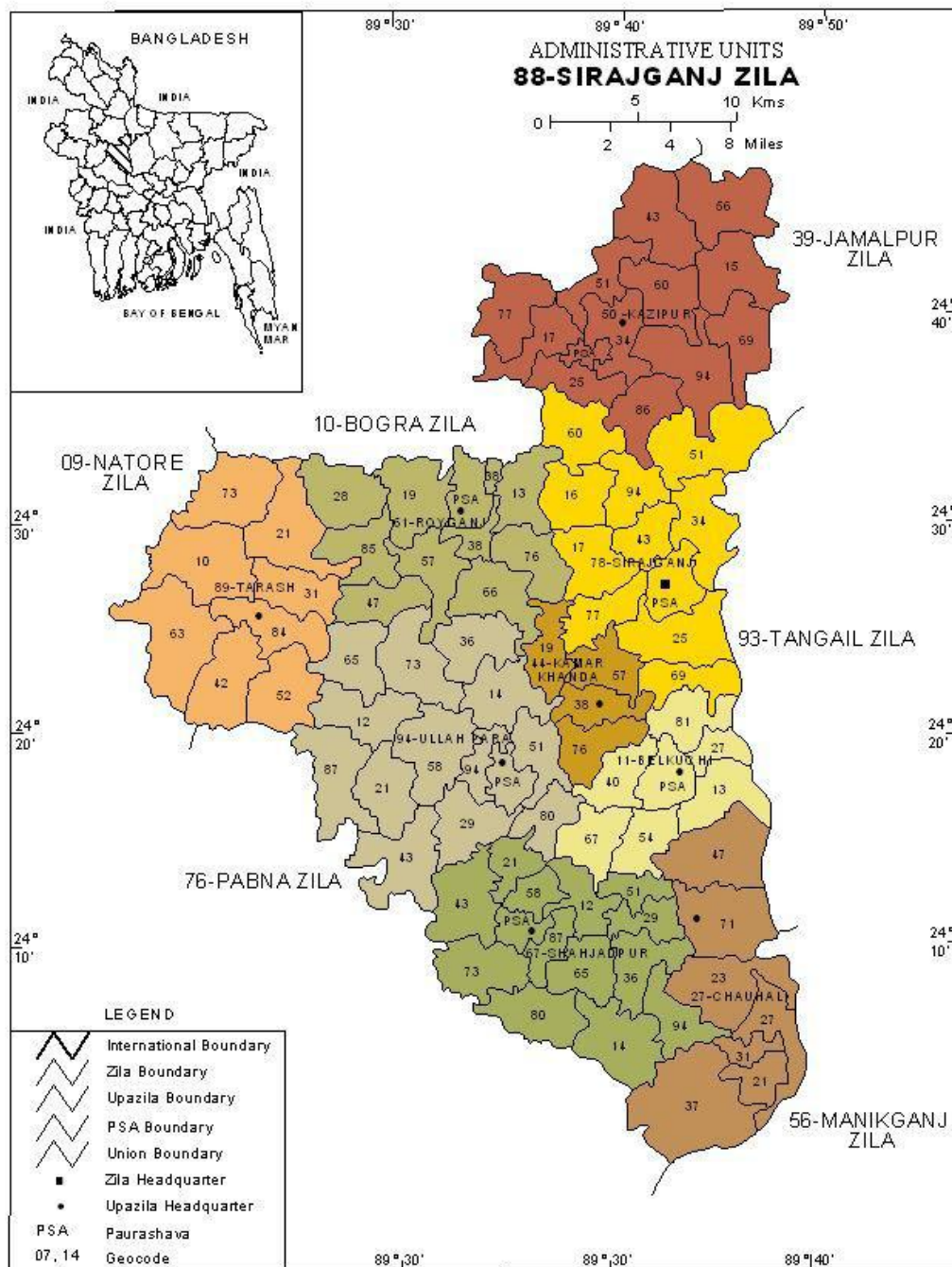

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CHAPTER 1

Introduction

District at a Glance

Background: Sirajganj district was formerly a sub-division of Pabna district. During the reign of Nawab Alivardi Khan, Sirajganj became the commercial centre of Bengal. He flourished this commercial centre further for steady supply of papers to different parts of the country by transferring a group of highly skilled people in making hand-made papers (generally known as Tulat kagas) from central Asia to this place. He also gave the name of this place as **Sirajganj** after the name of his beloved Grandson **Sirajuddowla**, the last independent Nawab of Bengal.

Geographic Area and Location: Sirajganj is surrounded on the north by Bogra district, on the east by Tangail and Manikganj districts, on the south by Manikganj and Pabna districts and on the west by Natore and Bogra districts. It lies between 24°01' and 24°47' north latitudes and between 89°15' and the area of the town is 28.49 sq km. As a jute-trading centre once it was considered next to Calcutta and Narayanganj. The total area of the district is 2,402.05 sq. km.

Annual Average Temperature and Rainfall: Annual average temperature varies from maximum 34.2°C, to minimum 8.4°C and annual rainfall is 1736 mm.

Main Rivers: Jamuna, Baral, Ichamati, Karatoa are main rivers of this district. About 10% area of the Chalan Beel is located in the Tarash Upazila of this district.

Administration: Sirajganj subdivision was established in 1845 and was included in Pabna district. It was turned into a separate district in 1984. The district consists of 9 upazilas, 82 unions, 1300 mauzas, 2016 villages, 6 paurashavas, 60 wards and 160 mahallas. The upazilas are Belkuchi, Chauhali, Kamarkhanda, Kazipur, Royganj, Shahjadpur, Sirajganj Sadar, Tarash and Ullahpara.

Archaeological Heritage and Relics: Among archaeological heritage and relics, the Tomb and Mosque of Khawja Pir Saheb of Enayetpur (Chauhali), Tomb of Hazrat Abdul Ali Baki Shah Sharif Jindani (R.) of Naogaon (Tarash), Homestead of Behula (Tarash), Shiva Mandir (Tarash), Rabindra Kuthi Bari (Shahjadpur), Akhra of Sri Sri Maha Pravu, Gopinath Bigraha, Kalika Devi Bigraha, Joysagar (Raiganj), Protap Dighee (Raiganj), Elliot Bridge or Lohar Poll (iron bridge, built in 1893) and Nabaratna Mandir (Ullahpara) are notable.

Historical Events: In 1922, as a part of the Khelafat and non cooperation movement led by Maulana Abdur Rashid Tarkabagish, many people were killed and wounded when police opened fire on an assemblage of people gathered at Salanga Hat. This is known as Salanga Movement or 'Salanga Genocide'. In 1942 Mohammad Ali Jinnah came to Sirajganj to attend the All India Muslim League Conference. Mahatma Gandhi and Subas Basu came to Sirajganj to attend the convention of the Brahma Samaj in 1928. The Hindu-Muslim Pact of the Swaraj Party, headed by Deshbandhu Chitta Ranjan Das, was adopted in the Conference of the All India Congress Party held in 1924 at Sirajganj. National Poet Kazi Nazrul Islam came to Sirajganj in 1932 to preside over the Conference of the Tarun Muslim. Sher-e-Bangla AK Fazlul Huq laid the foundation stone of Sirajganj Degree College in 1940. During the War of Liberation a battle was fought between the freedom fighters and the pak army at Naogaon of Tarash Upazila in which the pak army was defeated and about 150 members of the pak army were killed. During 11 to 14 December, a battle was fought between the pak army and the freedom fighters at Shailabari in which pak army was defeated. Sirajganj was liberated on 14 December 1971.

Marks of the War of Liberation: Mass graves at village Baroitala (Kazipur) and village Asbaria (Tarash); martyr memorials at Chandidasgati, Sirajganj Sadar (Durjay Bangla), Ghatina (Ullahpara) and at village Baroitala (Kazipur) are the testimony of the war of liberation.

Main Crops: Paddy, jute, wheat, mustard seed, sugarcane, onion, garlic, potato, sweet potato, chilly and ground nut are the main crops of the district. Extinct or nearly extinct crops are indigo, tobacco, local varieties of aus paddy, china, kaun etc.

Main Fruits: Mango, jackfruit, black berry, papaya, guava, coconut, palm, date, olive, bel, tetul and banana are main fruits of this district.

Traditional Transport: Palanquin, bullock cart and horse carriage are rural transport found of this district.

Economic Situation: The economy of Sirajganj is predominantly agricultural. Out of total 656,830 holdings of the district 52.11% holdings are farms which produce varieties of crops, namely, local and HYV rice, wheat, jute, sugarcane, pulses, spices, vegetables and other minor crops. Various fruits like mango, jackfruit, litchi, jam, palm, betelnut etc are the main fruits of the district. Varieties of fish are caught from rivers, beels and paddy fields during rainy season. The most common fishes are ruhi, katla, mrigel, magur, sing, koi, puti, shoil, gozar, boal etc. All these fishes are economically valuable. Besides these common varieties some other well known varieties of fish are pangas, airh, kholisha and chingri. Besides crops, livestock and poultry are the other sources of household income of the district.

According to above, table there are 84,049 establishments in the district in which 350,363 persons are engaged in different types of non-farm activities. Female participation in non-farm activities very poor (16.46%) in the district.

Flora and Fauna

Flora: Sirajganj district is located almost at the middle of Bangladesh. It is surrounded by Bogra district on the north, Natore district on the west, Pabna district on the south and the river Jamuna on the east. The level of land almost the entire district is appreciably low in comparison to the land of the adjacent districts. All these factors have got some influence over the growth of plants and trees in the district. A wide variety of natural vegetation grows in the district depending on the environmental conditions. In the vast char areas which are frequently eroded and rebuilt the variety.

Zhau (*Casuarina equisetifolia*) is a common plant of the uncultivable lands of the chars and is much needed for fuel and fodder during the rainy season. Besides, agricultural crops and plantations grow well in the chars. The marshes in the district yield reeds in large quantities, which are used for house building purpose and as well as for firewood. A small prickly fruit 'Senkhur' is also found in them and is highly esteemed by the people.

Uncultivated areas are covered by abundant natural vegetation. A abandoned river-beds, ponds and marshes as well as streams with a sluggish current have usually thick growth of herbaceous plants such as vallisneria (*syala*), potamogeton, enhygra and utricularia etc. Areas subject to inundation have generally a covering of tamarix, a shrub that grows generally on river banks of beds of northern part of the country (variously known as zhau, ban-zhau, lal-zhau etc.) and reedy grasses. Among other aquatic plants, the following are commonly found, two types of waterlily, namely, jati shaluk and sindhu shaluk, helancha, bagha-helancha (*Tilantha philoxroides*), checkra, deo-dhan, bhura-dhan, shonda etc. Most of these plants are the source of various edible products to the local people. The shonda, however is used for making mats.

The country side is wooded with bamboo (*Bambusa bambos*), clumps, peepal, banyan (*Ficus benghalensis*), babul (*Acacia arabica*), red cotton (*Salmalia malabarica*), jack-fruit (*Artocarpus heterophyllus*), bel (*Aegle marmelos*), tamarind (*Tamariandus indica*), coconut (*Cocos nucifera*) and date-palm (*Phoenix sylv estris*). The villages are generally surrounded by thickets and shrub berries of semi-spontaneous and more of less useful trees, while waste lands are, for the most part, covered with grasses such as Imperate cylindrical (*Ulu*) and chrysopogon aciculatus (*Charakanta*). Besides these, plants locally known as mashna, black pea, spices such as vandhun, gua-mauri, etc, are grown abound in the district.

The main timber trees are the mango (*Mangifera indica*), jack-fruit (*Artocarpus heterophyllus*), jam (*syzygium cumini*), cotton tree (*Bombam ceoba*), neem (*Azadirachta indica*) and pitraj (*Aphanamixls polystachia*). Their wood is used for making doors, windows and household furniture. The wood of the Babul is largely used for cart wheels. Bamboos are abundant and furnish the most common materials for house building. The patipata (*Clinogyne dichotoma*) is cultivated in the neighborhood Sirajganj for the manufacture of mats, while calamus which abounds in swampy

areas, is used for making baskets.

In addition to these, a jungle plant called zhau, extensively used as fuel grows in several parts of the district and is a source of income to some. There is no forest but there are extensive patches of jungles in some parts of the district.

Fauna

In the 19th century deer (*Muntiacus muntjak*), wild buffaloes (*Babalus bubalis*), wild pigs, leopards (*Panthera pardus*) and wild boars (*Sus scrofa*) were plentiful in the district. But along with the passage of time deer (*Muntiacus muntjak*), wild buffaloes (*Babalus bubalis*) have disappeared with the advancement of cultivation while leopards (*Panthera pardus*) and wild boars (*Sus scrofa*) have vanished into the village jungles. They are still found in the river chars. Jackals (*Canis aureus*), the jungle cats (*Felis chaus*), foxes (*Vulpes bengalensis*), hares (*Orvctulagus cuniculus*) and squirrels (*Callosciurus pygeryphrus*) are some of the common mammals.

There is an abundance of aquatic birds in the district. During the winter several kinds of geese and ducks (*Cairina sentulata*) visit the district. Among them, the grey-leg goose (*Anser Spp.*), bare headed goose, black-backed goose, the pintail, sheldrake, shoveller, gad wall, pochard, mallard and spotted billed duck (*Cairina sentulata*) and the familiar brahmini duck (*Cairina sentulata*) are ordinarily seen in the chars of the Padma and the Jamuna. Teals of various types and snipes are also found. Other waterbirds like herons (*Mycticarax*), storks (*Ephippias hynchus*), coots, moorhens snippets, kingfishers (*Alcedo atthis*), dabchiks are numerous. Of other game birds, those that are found only on land are many in number. Plover and green pigeon (*Columba spp.*) are frequent and the common gray quail and button quail are occasionally shot. Black partridges are also seen. Besides these common birds, the different species of kites (*Milvus migrans*), vultures (*Gyps bengalensis*), eagles (*Accipiter badius*), buzzards, doves (*Streptopelia tranquebarica*), cuckoos (*Cuculus micropterus*) as well as mynas (*Gracula religiosa austra*), bayas, king-crows, Crows (*Corvus splendens*), fly-catchers including the paradise fly-catchers, shrikes, swallows, swifts, bee-eaters, flower-peckers and many other small resident and migratory birds are will represented in the district.

Concepts and Definitions

1. Population and Housing Census 2011

The population and housing census is the unique source of reliable and comprehensive data about the size of the population of the country, major socio-economic and socio-demographic characteristics.

It is the total process of collecting, compiling, evaluating, analyzing and publishing or otherwise disseminating demographic, economic and social data pertaining, at a specified time, to all persons in a country. The essential features of a population census are individual enumeration, universality within a defined territory, simultaneity and defined periodicity.

The population and housing census provides information on the geographic and administrative distribution of the population and household in addition to the demographic and socioeconomic characteristics of all the people in the country. The data from the census are classified, tabulated and disseminated so that political leaders, election officials, planners, national organizations including NGOs and civil society, regional and international organizations can use the data in decision-making.

The purpose of community report is to disseminate census data by communities (ward/mahalla in urban area and union/mauza/village in rural area). Data on all key variables namely area, household, population by sex and age group, ethnic population, literacy rate, marital status, school attendance, employment status and religion as well as physical facilities such as source of drinking water, sanitation, electricity and dwelling units have been presented in this report. The planners, researchers and policy makers as well as development partners and community administrators will find this report as a valuable reference for use in advising plans and programs for advancing welfare and well-being of the common people, in particular and the community in general.

Household

Persons, either related or unrelated, living together and taking food from the same kitchen constitute a household. A single person living and eating alone forms one-person household.

Literacy

It denotes ability to write a letter in any language. Literacy status assessment is made for population 7 years and over.

Community

It refers to the following five lower geographic, administrative or revenue units:

- i) **Union:** Smallest administrative rural geographic unit comprising of mauzas and villages and having union parishad institution.
- ii) **Mauza :** Mauza is the lowest administrative unit having a separate jurisdiction list number (J.L. No.) in revenue records. Every mauza has its well-demarcated cadastral map. Mauza should be distinguished from local village since a mauza may consist of one or more villages.

- iii) **Village:** Lowest rural geographic unit either equivalent to a mauza or part of a mauza.
- iv) **Ward:** Smallest administrative urban geographic unit comprising of mahallas and having ward council institution.
- v) **Mahalla:** Lowest urban geographic unit having identifiable boundaries.

Urban Area

It corresponds with area developed around a central place having such amenities as metalled roads, improved communication, electricity, gas, water supply, sewerage, sanitation and also having comparatively higher density of population with majority population in non-agricultural occupations.

i) City Corporation: It includes city corporation area declared by the Ministry of Local Government.

ii) Paurashava/Municipality Area: It includes paurashavas incorporated and administered by local government under Paurashava Ordinance, 1977.

2. Agriculture Census year and reference period

The census year extends over twelve consecutive months having for different census items the different reference periods or days of data collections. Some items have a year or week reference period. Some others have a specific reference day.

The census year covered twelve months from 1 Baishak to 30 Choitra, 1414 Bangla Shal (BS). This year was the reference period for such census items as operated land use, crops, agriculture employment, livestock & poultry deaths and agriculture loan. A single reference day was used for items like holdings, farm size, land tenure, farm population, livestock & poultry inventories and agriculture implements.

The different census items by their reference periods or days are shown below:

Agriculture holding

An agriculture holding is a techno-economic unit of agricultural production under single management comprising all livestock kept and all land used wholly or partly for agricultural production purposes without regard to title, legal form or size. Single management may be exercised by either an individual holder or jointly by two or more individuals or holders or by a judicial person such as a corporation, co-operative or government agency. A holding may consist of one or more parcels (fragments of land) located in one or more areas or mauzas or in more than one administrative unit or division provided that all separate parcels of fragments form parts of same technical unit under operational control of same management.

The definition covers practically all holdings/households engaged in agricultural production of both crops and livestock. Some agriculture holdings may have no significant agricultural land, e.g. holdings keeping livestock, poultry and hatcheries for which land is not an indispensable input for production.

Farm holding

A farm holding is defined as being an agricultural production unit having cultivated land equal to or more than 0.05 acres. Farm holdings are classified into following three broad groups:

- (a) **small:** Farm holdings having minimum cultivated land 0.05 acre but operated land more than this minimum but upto 2.49 acres.
- (b) **medium:** Farm holdings having operated land in between 2.50 to 7.49 acres.
- (c) **large:** Farm holdings having operated land 7.50 acres and above.

Small cultivated land 0.04 acre or less is generally used for kitchen garden growing mainly vegetables. Often seeds of white gourd, water gourd, pumpkin and other strains are sown on households; but these creepers spread out around house roofs and other structures. As such, the minimum cultivated land considered for qualifying to be a farm holding is 0.05 acres.

Non-farm holdings

A non-farm holding is defined as being the one which has neither cultivated nor operated land or has cultivated land less than 0.05 acre.

Tenancy

Owner holdings are those having and operating their owned land and who may or may not be leasing out land.

Tenant holdings are those having no owned land but operating land taken from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Owner-cum-tenant holdings are those having owned land and who may or may not be leasing out their own land to others and who may be taking land from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Agriculture work

Agriculture work signifies all activities of holder and his/her labour force doing planning, management, and operation of a holding. It includes land preparation, sowing, weeding, harvesting, feeding and tending livestock & poultry, kitchen gardening, supervising agricultural workers, keeping farm records & accounts, preparing agriculture products for marketing (including packaging), repairing farm equipment, constructing farm buildings & fences, and engaging in land reclamation and improvement and other related activities. It excludes home and other family domestic chores.

Area under pond

The pond area remains under water almost through out the year. Normally, households use pond water for various domestic and sometimes agriculture purposes. Ponds are also generally used for fish culture.

In the census the pond area data were collected separately for both single ownership and joint ownership of households.

Area under temporary crops

It is the land area planted to crops having growing cycle or length of life less than one year. These are the temporary crops such as paddy, wheat, jute, cotton, tobacco, sugarcane, pulses, oil seeds, potato, vegetables and other seasonal crops. A list of temporary crops for which data were collected separately was given in back page of “Tally Sheet”. The minimum area recorded for a temporary crop was 0.01 acre. Area under temporary crops and temporary-crops net area are equivalents.

Area under permanent crops

It is the land area planted to crops which remain standing for a long period of time and do not need to be replanted after a seasonal harvest. Mango, jackfruit, coconut, guava, lemon, and other fruit varieties are all permanent crops.

Current fallow

It is land brought into cultivation but left out uncultivated in census year for fertility regaining and improvement or for other reasons.

Net cultivated area

This is land area actually cropped during the census year regardless of number of crops grown plus current fallow. It includes areas under temporary and permanent crops and also current fallow.

Permanent fallow

It is land not available for cultivation due to coming into residence and commercial & other uses. Play ground, graveyard, wild shrubs and jungles, marshy land, and the like fall in this category.

Irrigated area

This is area of total land brought under irrigation coverage for growing crops with irrigations done through mechanical or manual means. Irrigated area classifications fall into two categories: (1) surface water irrigation with main water sources being rivers, canals, beels, ponds, and other water bodies; and (2) underground water irrigation with water lifted by shallow tube-wells, deep tube-wells, and country traditional devices. The irrigation equipments are run by electricity, diesel or petrol, or manual labour.

Cattle and Buffalo

Cattle and buffalo heads owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Goats and Sheep

Goats and sheep owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Fowls, Ducks and Pigeons

Fowls, ducks and pigeons owned by households on day of enumeration were counted.

Temporary crops gross area

Areas aggregated for all temporary crops grown in the census year have made **temporary crops gross area** greater than **temporary crops net area** since the latter has within it the same land cropped more than once in different seasons of a year.

Intensity of cropping

It is percentage of temporary crops gross area in comparison with temporary crops net area. It is expressed as follows:

$$\text{Intensity of cropping} = \frac{\text{Temporary crops gross area}}{\text{Temporary crops net area}} \times 100$$

Cereals

Main cereals are rice and then wheat. Other cereals are jab, barley, cheena, maize, kaun, bajra and joar.

Pulses

Main and common pulses are gram, mung, lentil, arhar, gari kalai, khesari and pea.

Oil seeds

Main oil seeds are rape and mustard, sesamum, linseed, groundnut, soybean, sunflower and castor.

Vegetables

Farmers grow both summer and winter vegetables. Main vegetables are potato, brinjal, raddish, arum, lady's finger, cauliflower, cabbage, bean, tomato, patal, gourd, cucumber, pumpkin, knoll-kal-turnip, dhundal, barbati, khirai, chichinga, carrot, kakrol and sak.

Cash crop

Main cash crops are jute, mesta, sunhemp, cotton, sugarcane and tobacco.

Spices

The main spices include turmeric, ginger, chillies, onion, garlic, corriander, black cumin and ani seed.

Fuel crops

Dhaincha and other smaller plants used as cooking-fuel are included in the group.
