Railway Police, Range, Chennai comprises of one Inspector General of Police and a Deputy Inspector General of Police with head quarters at Chennai. This Range comprises of two Railway Police Districts one at Chennai and other at Trichy as head quarters and both headed by each one Superintendent of Police. In Chennai Railway Police District there are three Deputy Superintendents of Police Category-1, 14 Inspectors of Police and Category-3, 50 Sub Inspectors of Police both men and women and 769 other ranks both men and women.

The Chennai Railway Police is having jurisdiction over 17 police stations at Chenglepet, Tambaram, Chennai Egmore, Chennai Central, Korukkupet, Avadi, Arakkonam, Perambur , Jolarpet, Katpadi, Salem, Dharmapuri, Coimbatore, Podanur, Thirupur, Ooty, and Erode besides outposts at Basin bridge, Rayapuram, Thiruvallur, Thondaiyarpet, Vellore, Thirupathur, walajah, Mettupalayam, Coonur and Pollachi. Apart from that a Mobile Police Station at Trivandram mail is functioning.

In respect of Trichy Railway Police district apart from one Superintendent of Police, 3 Dy. Superintendents of Police in Category -1, and an Inspector in category -2, 13 Inspectors of Police and Category-3, 41 Sub Inspectors of Police both men and women and 690 other ranks both men and women.

The Trichy Railway Police District is having jurisidiction over the 16 police stations at Villupuram, Vridhachalam, Mayiladuthurai, Chidambaram, Trichy, Thiruvarur, Thanjavur, Madurai, Dindigul, Palani, Karaikkudi, Rameswaram, Thirunelveli, Tuticorin, Virudhunagar and Nagercoil besides 14 outposts at Cuddalore, Ariyalur, Goldenrock, Karur, Pattukkottai, Pudukkottai, Nagapattinam, Kumbakonam, Kodairoad. Maniyachi. Manamadurai. Srivilliputhur, Tenkasi. Apart from that two mobile police stations are functioning one at Nellai Exp. and other at Rameswaram Exp.

The responsibility of the Railway Police is to maintain Law and Order prevention and detection of crime, enforcement of Special and Local Laws such as enforcement of prohibition Act etc., and the main passenger/Public related duty.
