I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

"RUBY" exited the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) on the evening of 10 December 2014.

II. AFFECTED POPULATION (Tab A)

- A total of **944,249 families / 4,149,484 persons** were affected in Regions III, IV-A, IV-B, V, VI, VII, VIII, CARAGA and NCR
- A total of **18,938 families / 100,264 persons** are currently being served inside and outside **327 evacuation centers**

III. CASUALTIES (Tab B)

- **Eighteen (18) deaths** were reported in Regions IV-A, IV-B, VII, and VIII
- A total of **916 injured persons** were reported in Regions IV-A, IV-B, V, VI, VII, and VIII

IV. STATUS OF LIFELINES

Power

- Power are now restored except in the Provinces of Western Samar, Northern Samar, and Eastern Samar

Telecommunications

- **98.87%** of PLDT, DIGITEL, SMART and SUN cellsites were restored in affected areas in Regions IV-A, IV-B, V, VI, VII, and VIII
- Globe network is **88.01%** restored in the affected areas in Regions IV-A, IV-B, V, VI, VII, and VIII

V. ROADS AND BRIDGES

- All roads and bridges are now passable

VI. CLASS SUSPENSION

- Classes have resumed except in **13 schools** in Borongan City

VII. DAMAGED HOUSES (TAB C)

- A total of **290,670 damaged houses** were reported in Regions IV-A, IV-B, V, VI, VII, VIII, and CARAGA, in which **42,466 were totally damaged** and **248,204 were partially damaged**

VIII. COST OF DAMAGES (Tab D)

- A total of **₱5,090,265,426.00** worth of damages in infrastructure and agriculture was reported in Regions IV-A, IV-B, V, VI, VII, and VIII
