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PROFILE OF DISTRICT PISHIN

Pishin was separated from Quetta in 1975 for administrative reasons. It derives its name from the locality Pishin. Pishin is a modernized form of 'Pushang', which is Old Persian for the Arabic Fushang. Myth attributes the origin of the name to a son of the Emperor Afrasiab and Fushing was the spelling used in the records of the Afghan government. The population of Pishin District was estimated to be over 500,000 in 2005, with 99.9% of the population being Pushtoons.

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4. Enrollment Walk/ Seminar at District Level

District Education Department in collaboration with NCHD conducted the enrollment campaign with the support of stakeholders at district Pishin. The Enrollment Walk and seminar took place on 26th March, 11 in which more than 300 students, school teachers, PTSMCs, Volunteers and parents participated. Firstly, Additional Deputy Commissioner Pishin Mr. Muzafar Lehri , Ex District Nazim Pishin Molvi Kamal Uddin, EDO-Pishin Mr. Abdul Rasheed Tareen, DGM-NCHD Pishin Mr. Ghulam Mohammad Mohammadi, District Coordinator-UNICEF Pishin Mr. Israr Ahmad Panizai and other Stakeholders addressed a press conference in DO (Female) office regarding this campaign. Deputy Commissioner Pishin Mr. Muzafar Zeshan Lehri- ADC-Gen Pishin was the chief guest.



After that Enrollment walk was started from DOE (female) office towards Bacha khan Chowk and Band Road Pishin.



The electronic and print media's Representatives were present for coverage of walk and seminar.



In the walk children were holding placards, Banners and posters regarding enrollment awareness



At the end of the walk the participants delivered their speeches on the important of the day

DGM-NCHD Mr. Ghulam Mohammad Mohammadi at the end said that the net primary enrolment in 1990-91 was 46 percent and it had increased to 52 percent by 2004-05. Similarly



100% target of universal net primary enrolment by 2015 seemed to be quite difficult. The target that survival ratio should rise from 50 to 100 percent was even more ambitious. In District Pishin the literacy rate in 2007-08 had been 47 percent and the target of MDG looked unachievable of 88 percent by 2015. Education is the right of children the parents must

enrolled their 5-7 years children in the School. Ghulam Mohammad Mohammadi further said that Nation Commission for Human Development is working with education department to ensure 100% enrollment rate, to decrease the Drop out rates less then 10% and to ensure Quality Education.



Additional Deputy Commissioner Pishin Mr. Muzafar Lehri said in his speech that it is the mission of the district government to ensure 100% enrollment at the district. He appreciated the role of NCHD, UNICEF, Edilinks and BRSP to support Education Department in their own activities; He said that all the teachers must play their roles in the side campaign.



District Coordinator UNICEF Mr. Israr Panizai said that in a dogmatic society like rural Pakistan, a girl's value was seen several paces behind a man, and not beside him. Change will not come with education, but it will begin with it and for that to happen, the Government had to stop dawdling and start acting. In the face of such adversity, an education gave women strength, resolution and self respect. It provided with them the capability to adapt to rapidly changing circumstances and take advantage when opportunity arises. The UN had told us that for every year a woman were educated; the chance of infant mortality reduces by 5-10%. Children of educated mothers study for two hours longer each night, than those of non-educated women. Society might be slow to change, but educating girls

is certainly the catalyst to begin it. A more educated mother had fewer and better educated children!"



Ex. District Nazim Pishin Molvi Kamal Uddin said that the providing of Education to child is our religious duty. Because Islam is a religion which considers learning a most important duty of human in this regard we must play our role for education providing in our community with out any greed.



At the last District Education Officer Mr. Abdul Rashid appreciated the work of NCHD Edlink and UNICEF at district. He thanked all the participants who participated in huge number.

At the end of the seminar refreshment were given to all participants.



TEHSIL LEVEL ACTIVITIES

Tehsil level enrollment campaign was celebrated at Tehsil Barshore and Tehsil Karezat. In these walks students, Parents, CCBs, PTSMC, Volunteers, Teachers and education department officers participated. Supports were given by NCHD and Primary Education Support program (UNICEF)

a. TEHSIL LEVEL WALK AT KAREZAT

At Tehsil Karezat awareness enrollment campaign walk was held on 30th March, 2011. The walk was started from DDOE Karezat, walk passed by the main road of the khanozai at ended at BHS Khanozai.



In this walk more then 200 participants participated. In the walk children were holding placards, Banners and posters regarding enrollment awareness. The participants were students, influential of the Tehsil, Volunteers, PTSMC, Teachers and education department officers.



At the end of the walk a seminar was held in Boys High School Khanozai and all the stakeholders delivered their speeches.



DDOE said that in a very low number of the children are in Tehsil who are not enrolled in school, we will ensure 100 % enrollment in this year, he discussed the problems of school and he demanded the feeder Teachers for Over Crowded Schools in Karezat. MC Mohammad Ali said in his speech that NCHD provided 54 feeder teachers to Karezat to help the teachers in school where there is over crowded school or single teacher based school. He briefed the mission of NCHD.



District coordinator Primary education support program Mr. Israr Panizai said that they will provide reading writing material to all schools in Karezat with in a few days as per demand of ED

b. TEHSIL LEVEL WALK AT BARSHORE

As per action plan the awareness campaign walk and seminar in Tehsil Barshore was held on 5th April, 201. Enrollment walk was organized by the Department of Education Tehsil Barshore. The walk was planned initially by the Head Teacher of Government High School Barshore.

The teachers of the GHS Barshore made all the arrangements of the “Walk”. UNICEF and NCHD Staff provided them support. The Banners and the Posters were provided by both organizations.

District coordinator primary Education support program Mr. Israr Ahmed Panizai said that quality education is the need of time, to enhance the quality education capacity trainings of PTSMCs and teachers will be held at district.



DPME-NCHD Mr. Abdullah Achakzai Said that NCHD is one organization who is running awareness campaign in whole District not only in few focused Schools. He further said that NCHD is supporting education technically and logistically.
