FORMAT: POOL SYSTEM IN VARIOUS AGE AND WEIGHT CATERGORIES TO BE DETERMINED BY THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR TO OPTIMIZE COMPETITION AND SAFETY. ALL MATCHES, CLOCK STOPS ON MATTE. CONTESTANTS ARE ASKED TO BRING THEIR OWN BLUE AND WHITE OBI (BELTS).

CONTEST

RULES: CURRENT IJF CONTEST RULES MODIFIED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. *DOUBLE KNEE SEOINAGE* WILL **NOT** BE ALLOWED FOR CONTESTANTS 12 YEARS OLD AND UNDER.
- 2. **NO** SHIME WAZA (CHOKING TECHNIQUES) FOR CONTESTANTS 12 YEARS OLD AND UNDER. IF A 12 YEAR OLD OR YOUNGER CONTESTANT IS POOLED WITH CONTESTANT(S) 13 YEARS OLD OR OLDER, CHOKING TECNIQUES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED FOR ALL CONTESTANTS IN THAT POOL.
- 3. KANSETSU WAZA (JOINT LOCK TECHNIQUES) WILL BE ALLOWED IN **BLACK BELT DIVISIONS ONLY**. SANKYUS, NIKYUS AND IKKYUS MAY COMPETE IN THIS DIVISION IF THEIR BLACK BELT JUDO INSTRUCTOR SIGNS CERTIFICATE REGARDING NON-BLACK BELT CONTESTANTS.
- 4. WAKI GATAME WILL NOT BE ALLOWED FROM A STANDING POSITION.
- 5. INJURY RULE: PRE-2003 MEDICAL RULES.
- 6. GOLDEN SCORE WILL BE USED IN TIED MATCHES, GOLDEN SCORE TIME IS 1 MINUTE LESS THAN MATCH TIME.
- 7. **NO** KANI BASAMI.

SCORING SYSTEMS:

PLACES WILL BE DETERMINED ACCORDING TO THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA, IN THIS ORDER:

- 1. THE MOST POINTS;
- 2. IF THE NUMBER OF POINTS IS TIED, THE NUMBER OF WINS;
- 3. IF CONTESTANTS ARE TIED IN WINS AND POINTS THEN THE RESULTS OF THEIR HEAD TO HEAD MATCH WILL BE REVIEWED. WHOEVER WON THE MATCH BETWEEN THEM WILL BE GIVEN THE HIGHER PLACE OR IF THEY HAVE NOT COMPETED, THEY WILL BE GIVEN THE OPTION TO COMPETE IF IT MAY BE DONE SO SAFELY. IF A SITUTATION ARISES AND THERE IS A QUESTION ABOUT THIS OR ANY OTHER RELATED MATTER, CONSULT WITH THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR; 4. IN ALL OTHER CASES NOT COVERED BY THESE RULES, CONSULT WITH THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR.

AWARDS:

MEDALS WILL BE AWARDED TO 1ST, 2ND, AND 3RD PLACE WINNERS IN ALL DIVISIONS. AS THIS IS ADDITIONALLY A TEAM TOURNAMENT THE 1ST, 2ND, AND 3RD PLACE TEAM WINNERS IN THE COLLEGIATE/NON-COLLEGIATE WOMEN & MENS TEAM COMPETITION WILL HAVE THEIR TEAM NAMES ENGRAVED ON A PLAQUE TO BE DISPLAYED AT OUR TOURNAMENT ANNUALLY. WE WILL ALSO BE AWARDING RIBBONS TO ALL OTHER CONTESTANTS.

POINT SYSTEM: IPPON - 10 PTS. WAZA ARI - 5 PTS. YUKO - 3 PTS. DECISION - 1 PT.

SCORING REQUIREMENTS:

IPPON – Throws with the four elements, "CONTROL", "LARGELY ON THE BACK" with "FORCE" and "SPEED". Opponent gives up (taps twice or more or says "MAITTA") from OSAE, SHIME or KANSETSUWAZA or is incapacitated by said techniques. Uke "BRIDGING" score counts, penalty equivalent is, one competitor gets HANSOKUMAKE, other competitor gets an IPPON.

WAZA ARI AWASETE IPPON – Two WAZA-ARIS make one IPPON.

WAZA ARI - (Almost IPPON) Partially lacking 1 of the four elements. Penalty equivalent is, one competitor gets three SHIDOS, other competitor is immediately given a WAZA-ARI (Previously awarded YUKO is removed)

YUKO - (ALMOST WAZA ARI) Partially lacking 2 of the four elements, landing on the side. Penalty equivalent is, one competitor gets two SHIDOS, other competitor is immediately awarded a YUKO.

SHIDOS – 1^{st} SHIDO is a WARNING. 2^{nd} SHIDO is a YUKO for opponent. 3^{rd} SHIDO is a WAZA-ARI for opponent. 4^{th} SHIDO is HANSOKUMAKE, opponent is given an IPPON.

OSAEKOMI TIMES: IPPON - 20 SECONDS. WAZA ARI - 15-19.9 SECONDS. YUKO - 10-14.9 SECONDS. KINSA - 1-9.9 SECONDS.

CONTEST AREAS: 3, COMPETITION AREAS ARE "RESILITE" MATS
