RIVALRY GAME AGAINST COWBOYS NEXT ON THE DOCKET

Lamar returns to action Saturday against rival McNeese State looking to put an end to an 11-game skid which includes the first three Southland Conference games of the season. The Cardinals pulled within two points against Nicholls State late in the contest Thursday but was unable to overcome the deficit. Lamar now turns its focus to McNeese State (4-11/2-1 SLC) who has dropped eight of their last 10 games, but had a small two-game win streak snapped at Sam Houston State Thursday. The Cowboys dropped a five-point decision to the Bearkats, 86-81, and enter Saturday's game in a two-way tie for fourth in the Southland standings.

LAMAR VS. THE COWBOYS

The rivalry between McNeese State and Lamar has been a close one with the Cardinals holding a slim six-game advantage, 50-44 (.532). The Cowboys have won seven of the last 10 meetings in the series, including a sweep of the series last year. The Cardinals are 34-12 (.739) all-time against their rivals in Beaumont.

HOME SWEET HOME

The Cardinals have made the Montagne Center one of the toughest venues for opponents to play over the course of its 28-year history. Now in its 29th season as the home to Lamar basketball, the Cardinals have posted a 282-137 (.673) record in the Montagne Center. LU recorded a program-best 15 home victories during the 1987-88 season.

LAMAR IN JANUARY

The Cardinals are 260-233 (.527) all-time in the month of January. Lamar has produced above .500 records in the month 30 times in program history, which includes three perfect records (1965-65, 1968-69 and 1987-88). The Cardinals have recorded a school record eight wins in the month on three separate seasons (1979-80, 1980-81 and 1987-88). That winning percentage jumps when looking at home games in the month of January. The Cards are 182-83 (.687) all-time in January home games.

ON THIS DATE IN HISTORY

The Cardinals have struggled in games played on Jan. 11th. Lamar is 6-11 (.353) in games played on the 11th day of the month. The Cards have dropped their last four games played on the date. Saturday's game against McNeese State will be the third time in program history that Lamar has faced McNeese State. LU is 0-2 in those two games.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Senior Amos Wilson became the third Cardinal player to record a double-double this season (Donovan Ross - 2, and Nimrod Hilliard). Wilson finished the game with 14 points and pulled down a career-high 10 rebounds. Both were team highs against Nicholls State. It was the first double-double of Wilson's career.

SPREADING THE WEALTH

Lamar's starting five all finished Thursday's game in double figures led by senior Amos Wilson's 14 points. Junior Nimrod Hilliard added 13, classmate Donovan Ross scored 12, sophomore Rhon Mitchell had 11 and junior Anthony Holliday scored 10. The last time Lamar had five players in double figures was the 2012-13 season finale against Southeastern Louisiana.

SEEING DOUBLE

Junior Nimrod Hilliard extended his streak of double-figure scoring games to 15 with his 13 points, on 4-of-8 shooting, against Nicholls State. The 6-0 junior from Madison, Wis., is the lone Cardinal to have scored in double-digits in every game this season. He currently leads the team, and is tied for fifth in the Southland averaging 16.1 points per game. He has hit the 20-point plateau three this season, and has one double-double to his credit.

IT'S THE HOLLIDAY SEASON

Junior Anthony Holliday's Lamar career didn't get out to the start he would have hoped, but he is starting to turn things around. He was slowed during the preseason due to an injury, but in the past four games he has provided the Cardinals with another option offensively. Holliday scored a career-high 10 points against Stephen F. Austin Thursday night, and equalled that with 10 points in each of the last two games. The 10-point games came after consecutive nine-point outings which was his previous season-high. After scoring a total of 13 points, pulling down four rebounds and dishing out seven assists in the first nine games he is averaging 9.6 points, 4.4 rebounds and 3.8 assists in the team's last five.

SHOOTING 50%

The Cardinals shot better than 50 percent (12-of-21/.571) from the field in the first half against Nicholls State. It was the ninth time this season Lamar has shot at least 50 percent in a half. The Cardinals hit at least 50 percent of their shots in a half 11 times all of last season. The Cards recorded a season-best 18-of-28

TOP HEAVY STATS

The Cardinals had an odd box score against Nicholls State, which included all five starters scoring in double figures, but the LU reserves were held scoreless. It is the first time this season that Lamar has had five players score in double figures.

ROSS' ROLLERCOASTER

Junior Donovan Ross' rollercoaster ride of a junior season continued Thursday against Nicholls State. After averaging 17.5 points through the team's first four games, Ross didn't score in double digits in the next five games. He followed that up by averaging 13.5 in his next two outings, but was held below six points per game in the team's last three. Against the Colonels, Ross scored 12 points on 4-of-9 (.444) shooting, including a 4-of-5 (.800) performance from the free throw line.

FREQUENT FLYER MILES

The Cardinals will be racking up the frequent-flyer miles this season. Lamar's 2013-14 schedule consists of games on both coasts, and in each time zone. So far, Lamar has traveled 15,498.05 miles.

INTERNATIONAL LOOK

The Lamar roster consists of players from four countries, and seven different states. Among the 13 players, only one hails from the Lone Star State. The lone Texan is senior Amos Wilson.

CHASING HISTORY

A milestone for the longterm success of the Lamar men's basketball program is on the horizon. The Cardinals have recorded 919 all time victories, only 81 wins shy of 1,000. The Cardinals have recorded 12 20-win seasons during their history, won nine Southland Conference regular-season titles, made six NCAA Championship appearances, four post-season NIT appearances and had three All-Americans. In addition to program victories, Lamar is close to reaching other win milestones as well. LU is only 18 wins shy of 300 victories in the Montagne Center, and 35 wins shy of 300 Southland Conference victories.

A LOOK AHEAD

After a short two-game homestand, the Cardinals will open a four-game road trip beginning Thursday when they travel to New Orleans, La., to face the Privateers. The game against New Orleans is slated to tip off at 7:45 p.m. from Lakefront Arena. LU will be in Hammond two days later to face Southeastern Louisiana. The game against the Lions is slated to tip off at 4:30 p.m. from the University Center.

PAT KNIGHT
Third Season
77-115 (.403)/Seventh Season
27-54 (.338)/Third Season at Lamar

Pat Knight was named the university's 10th head coach, since Lamar became a four-year institution, prior to the 2011-12 season. The Pat Knight era got started in thrilling fashion as Knight guided the Cardinals to a

six-game win streak to close out the season taking the 2012 Southland Conference tournament title, and advance to the NCAA Championships. It was Lamar's sixth NCAA Tournament appearance and first since the 1999-2000 season.

Knight, who became the third Lamar coach to take the team to the NCAA Tournament in his first season, also led the Cardinals to their first 20-win season since 1987-88. Lamar's 23 wins tied for the third highest single season total in school history.

Thanks to the outstanding season, Lamar had three players recognized as All-Southland Conference. Mike James was a first-team all-conference selection, while Devon Lamb and Anthony Miles were both named to the second-team. Brandon Davis was also honored by the league as he was named to the all-academic first-team.

Knight came to Lamar after 10 seasons at Texas Tech, including the final three-plus years as head coach. Named head coach designate at Tech prior to the 2005-06 season, Knight took over for his Hall-of-Fame father Bob Knight toward the end of the 2007-08 season.

In three-plus seasons as head coach of the Red Raiders, Knight compiled a 50-61 record. His 2009-10 squad posted a 19-16 overall record and advanced to the quarterfinals of the postseason National Invitation Tournament before falling at Mississippi in double overtime.

Knight, who is the 10th person to coach Lamar since the university became a four-year institution in 1951, guided the Red Raiders to an 83-80 win over fifth-ranked Texas in just his eighth game as a head coach, while his first victory on the college level came against No. 18 Kansas State five games earlier. The Red Raiders were a solid 40-20 (.667) at United Spirit Arena under Knight.

Knight served for nearly seven years as an assistant at Tech under his father which included four trips to the NCAA Tournament and a run to the Sweet 16 in 2005. Texas Tech enjoyed five 20-win seasons during Knight's tenure as an assistant.

Knight's professional career began as a scout and administrative assistant with the NBA's Phoenix Suns after his four-year playing career at Indiana. In 1997, Knight became an assistant coach with the Connecticut Pride of the Continental Basketball Association.

In 1998, Knight became a head coach for the first time, guiding the Wisconsin Blast of the International Basketball Association to a 19-15 record.

Knight began his college coaching career at his alma mater as an assistant for two seasons from 1998-2000. The Hoosiers were 43-20 during that time and played in the NCAA Tournament both years. In his second season at Indiana, senior guard A.J. Guyton earned AP First-Team All-America honors before becoming a second-round draft choice of the Chicago Bulls.

Knight then spent one season as an assistant at Akron before moving to Texas Tech.

A four-year letterwinner for the Hoosiers from 1991-95, Knight graduated in 1995 with a degree in sports management. During his playing days, Indiana appeared in the NCAA Tournament every season and advanced to the "Elite Eight" in 1993.

Knight and the former Amanda Shaw were married on May 10, 2002.
