Along with its more than 5,000 licensed and member clubs and its affiliated organizations – AKC Humane Fund Inc., AKC Companion Animal Recovery Corporation, AKC Canine Health Foundation Inc. and AKC Museum of the Dog – the AKC advocates for the purebred dog as a family companion, advances canine health and well-being, works to protect the rights of all dog owners and promotes responsible dog ownership.
