GAMEDAY INFORMATION

Facility:

FAU Stadium (29,419), Natural Grass, is located on FAU Boca Raton Campus, 777 Glades Road Boca Raton FL, 33431

Locker Rooms:

The visiting team locker room is located on the northwest end of the stadium. The team will enter gate 6.

The following will be provided in the locker room (C-USA Policy): Countdown Game Clock Game Programs (100) Garbage Cans Marker Boards Soap Towels (300)

Team Bus Parking:

Drop team off at Gate 6. Buses will stage during the game in lot 5 north of stadium at the north end. After game, buses will stage along curb adjacent to gate 6.

Practice (Day prior to game):

The field will be available for visiting teams to walk-through on the day prior to the game. The walk-through must take place between 2-4 pm or 5:30-8:30pm. Please indicate your preferred time on the information sheet provided in this packet.

If inclement weather prevails prior to or during the allotted practice time, the field manager will make the decision on whether the field will be available.

Note: Teams will not be allowed to wear cleats on field on the day prior to the game.

Visiting AD Box:

The Visiting Athletic Directors Box is located on the 6th floor room 615 in the tower at FAU Stadium. Please enter in the NW suite lobby at gate 6. You will receive six (6) tower passes, two (2) parking passes as well as twenty (20) game tickets. Directly communicate with Tracy DeJager of Chartwells at <u>fau.dejager@fau.edu</u> with catering concerns.

Spirit Information:

Upon approved request, at least two weeks prior to the contest, the visiting spirit group shall be admitted to the game at no cost and permitted to perform at the game. All participating spirit groups' members must be in uniform for complimentary entry. Any supervisory staff requiring access must be included in the credential request list. The visiting spirit group will be located on the northeast sideline, in front of the visiting team. Spirit group will enter at gate 6. Visiting Marching Band:

Upon approved request at least two weeks prior to the contest, the visiting band shall be admitted to the game at no cost and permitted to perform at the game. Performances on the playing field shall be determined by the home game management, which shall attempt to extend usual courtesies to the visiting institutions representatives. Bands performing at football games shall be prohibited from playing from the time the offensive team breaks the huddle until the completion of the play. All participating band members must be in uniform for complimentary entry. Any supervisory staff requiring access must be including in the credential request list. Band will enter through Gate 6. The visiting band will be seated in the northeast side of the stadium. Sideline:

The visiting team sideline is located on the east side of the field. Benches, two tables, an electrical outlet and a water source will be made available for use on the sideline. Staff will be able to access the sideline for set up four hours prior to kick off.

Coaches Booth:

The visiting coaches' booth is located in the press box, 6th floor, on the west side of the stadium. Coaches will access via north elevators 3 and 4. A CSC supervisor will escort you to your booth.

Athletic Training Staff:

In order to better assist you on game day the following items will be available on your sideline and in your locker room on game day.

- (2) 10 gallon coolers in you locker room
- 1 ice chest in locker room
- 1 biohazard container / 1 sharps container
- Portable hydro collator with covers in your training room
- Emergency supplies (spine board, splint bag, AED) on sidelines
- 3 taping tables / 2 evaluation tables in your training room

Emergency Services

- EMS will be on-site with an ambulance parked in the North-West End zone at Gate 6
- EMS will provide a cart with a gurney for emergencies on the field during the game in the northwest tunnel of the stadium.
- X-ray is available in the stadium in the visitor's tunnel and can be accessed through your host athletic trainer. We will have an X-ray tech on site during and after the game.

We will have a host athletic trainer on your sideline during the game to assist you with anything your staff should need. The Host AT will communicate with the home team sidelines if there is any need for EMS / X-ray services.

The Field will be available to warm up two (2) hours prior to kick-off Prior to forty (40) minutes before kick-off, the visiting team will have access to the east half of the field from the south 30 yard line to the North end zone.

Forty (40) minutes before kick-off the visiting team will have the north end of the field from the north 40 yard line through the end zone.

The field must be cleared at the twenty (20) minute mark on the pre-game clock
