## Invitation to provide public comment on the draft Plan of Study developed following flooding in the Richelieu River and Lake Champlain Watershed

In response to the Spring 2011 flooding, the governments of Canada and the United States have requested that the International Joint Commission (IJC) develop a study proposal which would examine the causes and impacts of flooding in the Richelieu River and Lake Champlain Watershed, as well as the full range of measures to prepare for, prevent and mitigate such impacts.

Over the last few months, the International Lake Champlain-Richelieu River (ILCRR) Workgroup has developed a draft Plan of Study that identifies both the studies necessary to allow an evaluation of the causes and impacts of the flooding that occurred during the spring of 2011 as well as the studies necessary to develop appropriate mitigation solutions and recommendations.
