The FIM is an independent association formed by 108 National Federations throughout the world. Among its 50 FIM World Championships the main events are MotoGP, Superbike, Endurance, Motocross, Supercross, Trial, Enduro, Cross-Country Rallies and Speedway. The FIM was the first international sports federation to impose an Environmental Code in 1994.
