Quota places and entries for the ISU World Sprint Speed Skating Championships 2015 Astana, KAZ

Ladies and Gentlemen,

The qualification system for the ISU World Sprint Speed Skating Championships 2015 is defined in the 2014 ISU Special Regulations for Speed Skating, Rule 208, paragraph 6. Further details on the qualification process, including qualifying time limits, have been specified in ISU Communication No. 1897. Pre-allocated entry quotas based on the results from the ISU World Sprint Speed Skating Championships 2014 have been communicated through ISU Communication No. 1891, paragraph 1 d).

In accordance with the above regulations the qualification process for quota places was concluded with the ISU World Cup Speed Skating Competition in Heerenveen, NED, on February 7-8, 2015. The special ranking lists (SQRL) which is the main basis for allocation of quota places are attached, with an indication of how the rankings influence the allocation. For the sake of completeness and transparency, these lists include all Skaters that were entered for both distances (500m and 1000m, one result per distance) counting in the qualification process.

Also attached is a summary table of allocated quota places. This table includes information on the reserve list of quota places for each gender. ISU Members concerned are requested to take note of this information, and to submit their entries for the Championships through the ISU Online Entry System in accordance with the following instructions and guidelines:

- 1) The maximum number of entries from an ISU Member is restricted by its allocated quota (the number indicated in the summary table).
- 2) In addition, maximum one substitute may be entered.
- 3) If a Member has not been allocated a quota place, but is included in the reserve list of quota places, <u>one Skater</u> may be entered with the status of <u>substitute</u>.

- 4) The ISU Members may use their quota places to enter Skater(s) who have achieved the qualifying time requirements specified in ISU Communication No. 1897. Entries are <u>not</u> restricted to the Skaters included in the published ranking lists determining the allocation of quota places.
- 5) If an ISU Member intends not to make use of some or all of its allocated quota place(s), the Member is obliged to inform the ISU Secretariat as soon as possible, but preferably not later than February 13, 2015, so that the rejected quota place(s) may be transferred to other ISU Members in a timely manner.
- 6) Rejected quota places will be reallocated according to the ranking order in the reserve list of quota places, but with priority for ISU Members that have not yet been allocated a quota place.
