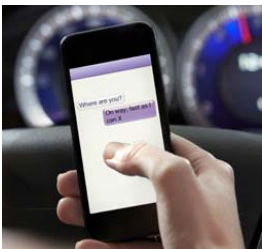

WHAT MAKES A CELL PHONE UNSAFE?



🚗 Driving Ground Service Equipment or any other vehicle while using a cellphone

📧 Texting, sending emails, and being distracted

Act safely...

🚗 No personal cell phone use while you are working

🚗 If you must make a call, pull over to a safe area and stop your vehicle

Don't let your personal cell phone use put everyone's safety at risk!

We are ALL part of the Safety Team by:

- ✘ Reporting safety hazards promptly
- ✘ Submitting safety suggestions
- ✘ Pointing out unsafe work practices to co-workers
- ✘ Knowing and following safety rules
- ✘ Demonstrating safe work habits
- ✘ Wearing personal protective equipment (PPE)

Safety begins with **TEAM** work!

In August, we handled:

- 10,171 flights
- 1,866,102 passengers (arriving - departing)
- 764,534 checked bags

In August, there were:

- 4 aircraft damaged
- 3 vehicle incidents
- 6 employees injured
- 28 infractions issued, 39% (11) for **SPEEDING**

Building a Safety Culture.....

As part of a continuing commitment to the safety of its 17 million annual passengers, Terminal 4 uses the acronym **C.U.L.T.U.R.E.** Communication, Urgency, Leadership, Teamwork, Understanding, Recognition, and Empowerment - to represent the continuous effort towards safety at the terminal.

Safety is fundamental to every aspect of the day-to-day occurrences at Terminal 4. To support its growth, we created and implemented a Safety Risk Management (SRM) system to identify potential hazards and mitigate risks prior to them occurring. All JFKIAT staff is required to receive the SRM training and may be asked to participate to an SRM session when new construction or operational change occurs that may affect the safe operation of the Terminal.

Terminal 4 has been able to increase safety by focusing on employee training and consequently more employees are participating and embracing the **C.U.L.T.U.R.E** principles.
