Efflorescence is a temporary surface condition which is common to all concrete products. The process is caused by the chemical nature of cement. This reaction can appear as an overall chalky white bloom (a softening of color) or in more concentrated patches. It is difficult to predict how long the effects of efflorescence will last. It depends on the type and amount of deposit as well as local weather conditions. The action of carbon dioxide and rainwater will gradually remove the deposit, in most cases, leaving the original color of the roof intact without further efflorescence occurring. It is superficial and in no way affects the quality or functional properties of the tile.

Choose from one of our many cool roof rated tiles that will improve the energy efficiency by reflecting sunlight and heat away from your roof. When these are combined with our Elevated Batten System, they will provide reduced cooling costs and they may even qualify for local rebates. The Cool Roof Rating Council (CRRC) measures the “coolness” of a roof by determining a roof’s solar reflectance (SR) and thermal emittance (TE). Both properties are rated on a scale from 0 to 1, where 1 is the most reflective or emissive. The CRRC measures these two properties for roofing products, both for the product’s initial values and after three years of weather exposure. Boral Roofing manufactures some products that meet CRRC guidelines, allowing homeowners in some regions to receive utility rebates. Boral Roofing’s CRRC rated products help reduce the heat island effect found in urban areas and in general, increases the overall energy efficiency of the building. Flashing

Proper flashings prevent water, snow and debris from entering joints where the walls meet the roof deck. Boral's Wakaflex® flashing material is the top choice for these critical areas of the roof.

Underlayments

Underlayments provide a secondary level of protection directly on top of the roof deck. Boral offers a range of high quality underlayments for better protection and peace of mind.

Eaves

Boral's eave products create a finished look for the roof and enhance its overall functionality. Elevating the first course of tiles to the proper height completes the overall aesthetic of the roof and helps protect against infestation.

Oxides

Oxides are pigments used to color the mortar sometimes used to seal tiles along the hip and the ridge. The oxides that Boral Roofing provides are specific to the tile colors offered and are the same pigments used in the manufacture of the tiles.

Battens

Our Elevated Battens are a crucial part of the Boral Cool Roof System and improve the performance of any tile installation. They provide positive anchoring for each tile and raise the tiles off the roof deck to provide ventilation and the unrestricted drainage of any moisture on the underlayment.

Rake & Gable End

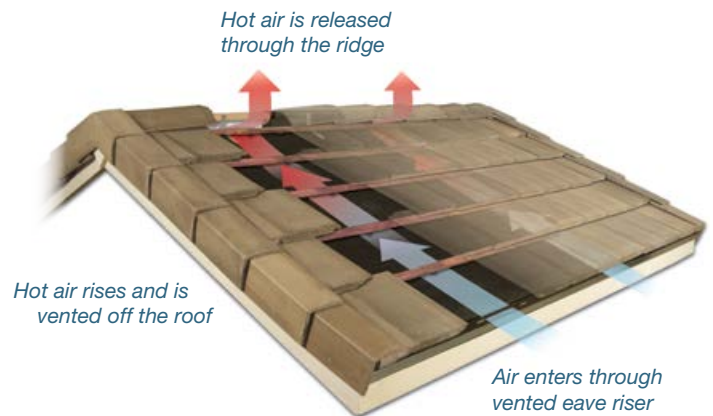
Tile roofs are highly insulating and prevent much of the sun's heat from penetrating the building. Boral offers tiles in a wide range of profiles in highly reflective colors and certain tiles meet Energy Star and U.S. Green Building Council's LEED® (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) rating.

In addition to tile's thermal mass, the air space between the tile and the roof deck provides a layer of insulation. Boral Roofing go a step further by naturally ventilating this air space. Nearly all the heat that penetrates through the tiles is vented through the ridge. This keeps the building cooler, reducing your energy bills every year with no electrical or mechanical parts. Letting your tile roof system breathe will also make it last longer than traditional roof construction.



The most common reason for reroofing is deterioration of the roof system beneath the tiles when tiles or flashings are damaged or installed incorrectly.

The Boral Cool Roof System allows moisture that may get under the tiles or flashings to flow down and off the roof deck and quickly dry out, keeping the roof system in good condition to last longer.

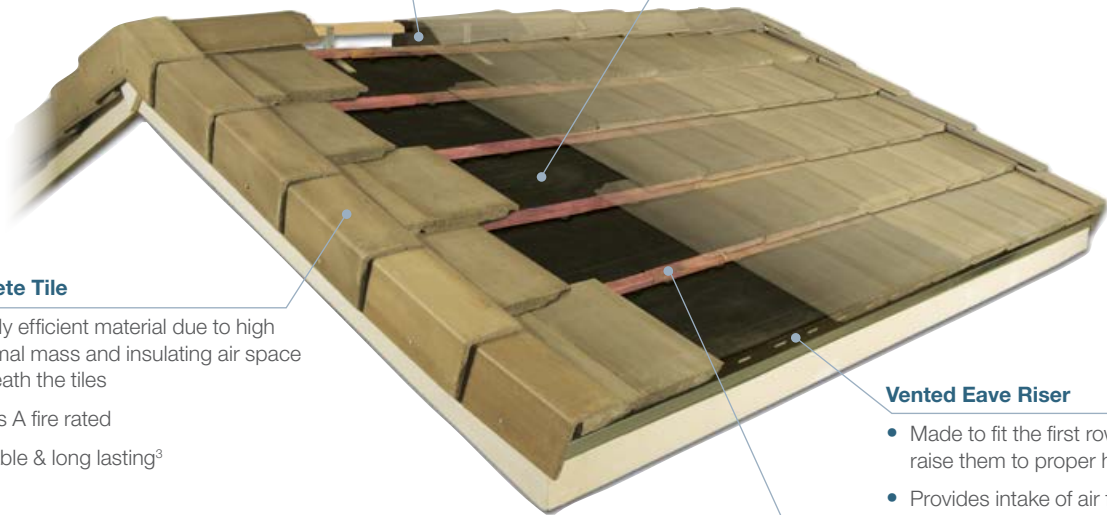
