Lockdown 5 August 2014

Yesterday afternoon at around 2:45 pm QPS officers were observed in the school grounds. Officers went down onto the school oval and into the Vince Bull Environmental Park at the rear of the school. I was assured that there was no threat to students.

At around 2:55 pm QPS informed me that they needed a few more minutes in order to ensure the person they were looking for was no longer on the grounds. On advice from QPS the school was placed in Lock Down. At approximately 3:10 pm we were advised by QPS to end the Lock Down and allow students to leave the classrooms.

Like all schools, Regents Park State School has a practiced procedure for lockdown. This entails:

This entails:

- 1 On hearing the signal all students and staff are to remain/enter the closest classroom
 - a. Check for anyone in the immediate vicinity and bring them into the room
 - b. Lock all windows, doors and blinds
 - c. Sit under desks, tables etc out of view of the windows
- 2 Remain silent

Wait for the all clear to be called.

Yesterday our procedures were adhered to and the Lock Down was very successfully carried out so that students were calm and felt safe.

Due to the timing of yesterday's incident there were a number of parents on the school grounds and not all of them were able to enter a classroom. If you arrive at the school and you hear announcements or music playing you are best advised not to enter the grounds; return to your vehicle, move away from entrances. Please be assured that your children, our students are our primary concern and their safety is paramount for us.

A special assembly was held today to re-assure all students and staff that they were safe at all times and congratulate them on exhibiting STAR behaviour in following our Lock Down procedures. It was also an opportunity to give all the facts that we have.
