**Property Description** 

Central curtain wall on the main land front which contained the main entrance into the city. The curtain has a lower rockhewn scarp and built up upper held. Contains a thick parapet with six low embrasures, three on each side of the entrance passage way. A succession of gateways, with their guardhouses and drawbridges, approached over an arched bridge, stood on site. The last of these, erected by the Royal Engineers was dismantled in the 1960s. The curtain wall has brisures at both ends to accommodate the adjoining piazza basse. Two sally-ports opened up into the ditch, and a third, is situated in the centre of the curtain wall, originally under the main gate.
