This annual report takes into account the events which occurred throughout 2009.

OBITUARIES

The International Fencing Federation has suffered the loss of several friends:

Mr Vladimirs Aleksejevs (LAT)

Passed away on 25 June 2009. He was the Secretary General of the Latvian Fencing Federation and an international FIE referee.

Mr Joe Eden (GBR)

Passed away on 20 September 2009 at the age of 94.

He was a life-time advocate of junior sport and received the silver medal of the British Fencing Association (BFA) in 1983. In 1995, he became Vice-President of the BFA and, in 2002, he received the gold medal from the FIE for his work.

Mr Boubacar DIOUF (MLI)

Mr Boubacar DIOUF passed away on 17 October 2009 in Bamako. He was the President of the Malian Fencing Federation and an important sport personality in his country. He passed away after a heart attack.

Mrs Maria Paola (Titti) Bresciano (ITA)

Mrs Maria Paola Bresciano passed away on 30 October following a long illness. She was well known in Italian fencing and was the spouse of Lioniero Del Maschio, the President of the Mediterranean Fencing Confederation, and the mother of Paolo Azzi, the Vice-President of the Italian Fencing Federation.

Mrs Ecaterina Stahl (ROU)

Passed away on 25 November 2009 after a long illness.

This important personality in Romanian fencing was born on 31 July 1946 and was a member of the national women's foil team for over twenty years.

She was Junior World Champion in Rotterdam (1965), Individual Senior World Champion in Budapest (1975) and Team World Champion in Havana (1969). She won six other world medals and competed in five editions of the Olympic Games where she won 2 team bronze medals.

Maitre Gérard Rousseau (FRA)

Passed away on 20 December 2009 after a long illness.

Gérard Rousseau was a member of the Refereeing Commission of the FIE and a delegate at many world championships as well as at the Sydney Olympics. He was an international referee at the three weapons.

We express our deepest sympathy to the families and federations of the deceased.

1. ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIVITIES

1.1 MANAGEMENT

The management activities of the FIE continued with intensity.

The Executive Committee met on 25 January 2009 in Paris (FRA), on 25-26 April 2009 in Lausanne (SUI), on 27 June 2009 in Budapest (HUN), on 4 October 2009 in Antalya (TUR) and on 20 November 2009 in Palermo (ITA).

The yearly **General Assembly** of the FIE took place on 4 April 2009 in Belfast (GBR).

The **2009 Congress was held** on 21 and 22 November 2009 in Palermo (ITA).

26 Executive Committee consultations were conducted by fax and email throughout the year, when an urgent decision was needed.

The measures adopted by these decision-making bodies were regularly communicated to the FIE members, via **11 Information Letters** and **17 Urgent Letters**.

The letters and their annexes were sent to the National Federations, the Members of Honour, the Members of the Executive Committee and the Presidents of the Confederations by electronic mail.

The various rankings of the FIE were also sent to the National Federations by electronic mail.

1.2 AD HOC COMMISSION

During the World Championships in Antalya, the Ad Hoc Coaches Commission was created. The National Federations were able to present and elect candidates.

During its first meeting, which was also in Antalya, the commission put together a certain number of technical proposals to be studied by the Executive Committee.

1.3 CALENDAR

171 World Cup tournaments took place during the 2008/2009 season, 69 of these were junior tournaments, 75 senior tournaments (including 27 GP) and 27 team tournaments.

1.5 DOPING

The fight against doping continued throughout the season and there were **2** cases of doping in FIE competitions.

- **546 doping controls were carried out** during the 2008/2009 season during the World Cup competitions (not including the World Championships and Zonal Championships), including:
 - **207** controls during Junior World Cups
 - **225** controls during Senior World Cups
 - **81** controls during Team World Cups (3 athletes per competition instead of 4 in 2008)
 - **33** controls during Satellite Competitions
- The FIE conducted out-of-competition doping controls on **14 athletes in 2009**.

3. AID FROM THE FIE TO THE NATIONAL FEDERATIONS AND CONFEDERATIONS

Within the framework of the Confederations Development Plan, the FIE organised and financed various actions for a total budget of 2,040,000 CHF.

I. Participation

Participation in FIE meetings

The FIE invested the following amounts for the President of each federation to attend the FIE meetings:

- 2009 General Assembly in Belfast: 66 Federations received aid from the FIE for their plane tickets and hotel rooms, total: 76,387 CHF
- 2009 Congress in Palermo: the confederations received 233,700 CHF for the plane tickets and hotel rooms of the Presidents of the 134 Member Federations of the FIE.

Participation in the 2009 World Championships

The FIE invested a total of 386,329 CHF for the participation of 3 athletes per national federation competing in the 2009 World Championships:

- 2 athletes per federation for the 2009 J/C World Championships (75 federations): 178,789 CHF
- One athlete per federation for the 2009 Senior World Championships: 207,540 CHF

II. Material Aid

2009 J/C World Championships

80 National Federations competing in the 2009 J/C World Championships received 5 full fencing outfits. The amount paid by the FIE came to 197,945.98 euros, taking into account that the partnership with Allstar allowed a discount of:

- 50% off the retail price up to 110,000 euros
- 20% off the retail price above 110,000 euros

African Championships

Senegal was granted material aid for the organisation of the African Championships.

Other

The following also received material aid: Paraguay, Jordan, Sri Lanka, Palestine, Afghanistan, Thailand, Syria, Myanmar, Iraq and Lebanon.

III. Actions specific to each Confederation

For 2008-2009, the Development Plan of each confederation defined actions specific to each Confederation and they received subsidies from the FIE on top of the aid and amounts mentioned above.

In July 2009, each confederation received for these specific actions:

Europe: 146,094 CHF

Africa: 20,000 CHF for the participation of the athletes in the African Championships

America: 74,437 CHF

Asia: 69,513 CHF in material aid

Oceania: 23,190 CHF

IV. Prizes given to athletes during the World Championships

2009 J/C World Championships

In partnership with the foundation "For the Future of Fencing", the medallists in each cadet weapon and each junior weapon at the 2009 J/C World Championships received an equipment voucher from FIE's partner Allstar/Uhlmann:

Fencer ranking 1st: 1500 USD voucher

Fencer ranking 2nd: 1000 USD

Fencer ranking 3rd: 500 USD

These prizes amounted to a total of 42,000 USD.

2009 Senior World Championships

In partnership with the foundation "For the Future of Fencing", the athletes and teams with medals in each weapon of the 2009 Senior World Championships received the following prizes:

Individual Events

Fencer ranking 1st: 10,000 USD

Fencer ranking 2nd: 5,000 USD

Fencer ranking 3rd: 3,000 USD

Team Events

Team ranking 1st: 10,000 USD

Team ranking 2nd: 5,000 USD

Team ranking 3rd: 3,000 USD

These prizes amounted to a total of 234,000 USD.

IV. Fencer training camps

Since 2002, the FIE has organised 14 one-week camps before the World Championships, covering all the technical, organisational aspects as well as the costs involved for the participants up until the end of the individual championships.

In 2009, the FIE organised a preparatory camp for the Junior and Cadet World Championships in Belfast: 25 fencers in the three weapons.

In detail, the following objectives were pursued:

- Encourage and facilitate the participation of all the National Federations at the World Championships
- Offer a week of intensive preparation to fencers who do not always have enough training partners to allow them to aim for the international top-level
- Help young talented fencers discover all of that is involved content and structure-wise in a modern training session
- Enable the athletes to benefit from the advice of very experienced fencing masters and for them to set their hearts on putting this advice into practice
- Ensure a first contact with the international fencing elite in the best conditions possible so as to encourage them to increase their efforts and for them to return to their training halls as fencing examples

VI. Training course for coaches

The main goals aimed were: the ability to teach the basics correctly and to consciously use the teaching methodology.

The training course schedule was set at 30 hours a week, spread out over 10 sessions.

Each course ended with an exam and the awarding of diploma.

The same type of training was held on each continent in all weapons.

The FIE covered the teaching and participants' expenses there.

Europe

A foil course took place in Bucharest (ROU) from 1 September to 30 October 2009.

14 individuals from 10 European countries (Bulgaria, Croatia, Finland, Holland, Sweden, Romania, Ukraine, Great Britain, Serbia and Moldova) followed this course.

The experts teaching were: Alek MOVSHOVICI (Russia), a university professor in Moscow, and Petru KUKI (Romania), former coach of the national Romanian team.

Asia

A sabre course took place in Tokyo (JPN) from 15 September to 15 November.

14 individuals from 13 Asian countries (Palestine, Jordan, Malaysia, Qatar, Indonesia, Kazakhstan, Vietnam, India, Iran, Japan, Hong Kong, Thailand and Australia) attended this course.

The experts teaching were: Krzysztof GZEGOREK (Poland), an excellent former sabreur and National Technical Director for 15 years, and Tadeusz PIGULA (Poland), a sports teacher and former coach of the national Polish sabre team.

America

An épée course took place in Mexico City (MEX) from 1 October to 30 November.

21 individuals attended this course from 13 American countries: Honduras, Colombia, Canada, Ecuador, Dominican Republic, Nicaragua, Argentina, Chile, Brazil, Peru, El Salvador, Mexico and Uruguay.

The experts teaching were: Danka Sandor (HUN) and Rozsvari Nandor (HUN).

VII. Training and professional development schools for fencing masters and continental centres

In Dakar, the training school founded in 1999 perfectly fulfils its role. Without this school, the development of African fencing would have remained an impossible task. The school had the following initial aims:

- To train fencing masters to benefit the new African federations
- To retrain the African fencing masters
- To help the new federations set up
- Top-level training for the African fencers

The international school for fencing masters EIMA opened its doors to a new class of students (the 5th) in October 2008. This new class has eight students: Senegal (2), Côte d'Ivoire (2), DR of Congo (2), Niger (1) and Tunisia (1).

The first year of studies focuses entirely on learning about fencing and the knowledge of anatomy and physiology needed to practice the profession of fencing master well.

Furthermore, the first year student familiarises himself/herself with the texts that govern the International federation and the African Fencing Confederation.

During the second semester of the first year, the students start participating in the Senegalese national championships. In 2009, they represented their country at the African Championships held in Dakar. This gave them the experience of an international competition. Later on in the year, the students from Congo who were members of their national fencing team took part in the World Championships in Antalya.

In addition to these students, two of the best fencing masters among those who graduated in 2006 and 2008 are living in Dakar to train with the Senegalese fencers in decent conditions in order to be able to represent their country in the international competitions. This makes it possible to evaluate at the same time the option of opening a top-level training section at EIMA.

The second year of the course started in October 2009.

The teaching will be mostly based around how to teach fencing, research and top-level training, refereeing and additional modules relating to sports psychology, marketing and knowledge of the Olympic movement.

It will end with a final exam, under the supervision of FIE experts, for the diploma of FIE fencing master.

The teaching is ensured by the following fencing masters:

- Pape TOURE (Senegal) and John KAMATE (DR Congo), Sabre
- Julien OUEDRAOGO (Burkina Faso), Foil
- Seydou COLY (Senegal) taught épée during the first year. He then left EIMA and will be replaced by Baytir Sidy DIOP (Senegal)

In Beijing, the Asian Centre

A sabre training camp was held in Beijing from 5 to 25 February 2009, bringing together 29 athletes from 15 Asian countries.

3 Chinese experts were chosen:

- Mr Jiang Yei Fei
- Mr Zhang Shi Yong
- Mr Li Qing Feng

In Melbourne, a centre for Oceania

The Oceania Fencing Confederation and the FIE established an awareness programme for the Olympic Committees of the different countries on the continent to create new national fencing federations.

The programme notably plans to send the fencing masters on technical training courses.

This FIE training school provides a unique opportunity for Oceania to encourage the vocation of fencing master and to perfect the teaching of the already existing fencing masters.

In Australia, these courses are part of the national accreditation system of professional competence.

In 2009, the Oceania Fencing Master Academy (OFMA) coordinated 5 level-1 courses in different States/Territories of Australia: in Perth, Melbourne, Canberra, Sydney and Brisbane.

10 coaches were accredited or re-accredited by OFMA in 2009:
