

Niue Government Re-Elected



Alofi, Niue Island, 23rd April 2014: The first Niue Legislative Assembly meeting, after the islands General Election, concluded this morning with Honourable Premier Toke Tufukia Talagi regaining his leadership, and a new Speaker of the House of Assembly Honourable Togiavalu Pihigia has also been sworn in for the next 3 years.

Honourable Premier Toke Talagi says "I am very humble to be re-elected as the leader of the country and grateful to the members of the Assembly and people of Niue, for the honour bestowed on my humble head".

"God willing, we will continue to work hard and Prosper".

The Government Ministers posts will be announced tomorrow morning after the Cabinet meeting.
