

BUCKS PASS TEST

Ohio State 7 10 6 7---30

Wisconsin 0 15 0 6---21

FIRST PERIOD

There was a 10 MPH wind from the south; weather, cloudy, 52 degrees.

Ohio won the toss and elected to defend the south goal; Wisconsin to receive.

WISCONSIN—(15)—Van Raaphorst kicked off to Smith on the 4 and he returned to the Wisconsin 22. Smith slid inside left end for 9. Smith got 4 and first down on the Wisconsin 35. Nettles took a pitchout around left end for 4. Miller's pass to Richter was dropped. Richter dropped Miller's pass at about midfield. Bakken punted to Warfield on the Ohio 21 and he returned to the 37.

OHIO STATE—(12:44)—Mumme rolled out at left end for 1. Klein swept right end for 6. Ferguson shaken up and replaced. Mumme rolled around right end for 3 and first down on the 47. Katterhenrich went up the middle for 8. Katterhenrich tried right guard for 3 and first down on the Wisconsin 42. Klein added 2 around right end. Katterhenrich picked up 6 over left tackle. Katterhenrich cut back over center for 5 and first down on the 29. Mumme swept right end for 3. Katterhenrich blasted for 5 over left tackle. Katterhenrich added 1 at right guard. Katterhenrich sliced off right tackle for 2 and first down on the Wisconsin 18. Mrukowski rolled around right end for 1. Katterhenrich went over the middle and drove for a touchdown. Time: 9:05. Van Raaphorst converted. Score: OHIO STATE 7, WISCONSIN 0.

WISCONSIN—(5:55)—Van Raaphorst

kicked off to Smith in the end zone and he returned to the 17. Nettles sliced inside right tackle for 5. Smith slid through left tackle for 3. Nettles picked up 4 inside right end for first down on the Badger 29. The same play added 2. Richter dropped Miller's pass when hit by Tingley. Miller's pass to Hearn was off his fingers. Bakken punted to Klein on the 30 and he returned to the Wisconsin 44.

OHIO STATE—(2:38)—Ferguson smashed right tackle for 3. Klein swept right end and cut back sharply for 9 and first down on the Badgers' 32. Ferguson cut into the center for 4. Snell cut back inside left end for 4. Ferguson got 1 for first down, but Wisconsin was penalized 15 for unnecessary roughness to its own 10. Snell cut inside left end for 4. The period ended. Score at end of first period: OHIO STATE 7, WISCONSIN 0.

SECOND PERIOD

OHIO STATE—(15)—Klein swept wide around right end for 2. Mrukowski kept inside left end, after fading for an option pass and lost 2. Van Raaphorst kicked a 23-yard field goal. Time: 0:32.

SCORE: OHIO STATE 10, WISCONSIN 0.

WISCONSIN—(14:28)—Van Raaphorst kicked off to Kroner on the 9 and he ran back to the 21. Kroner swept left end for 4. Richter took Miller's quick pass for 12 and first down on the Badger 37. Kroner cut off left tackle for 2. Bangert dropped Miller's pass. Miller passed to Staley for 12 and first down on the Ohio 49. Holland

ran inside right end for 3. Miller passed to Staley for 9 and first down on the Ohio 37. Holland picked up 1 at right tackle. Miller, eluding Tidmore, fired a long pass to Kroner on about the 5 and he did a complete turn and went into the end zone. Time: 5:03. Bakken passed to McKinney for two points. SCORE: OHIO STATE 10, WISCONSIN 8.

OHIO STATE—(9:57)—Bakken kicked off to Warfield on the 7 and he returned to the Ohio 26. Wisconsin was penalized 5 for delay. Snell tried left end and lost 1. Mrukowski cut back inside right end for 9 and first down on the Ohio 39. Ferguson pushed right guard for 3. Snell took a pitchout wide around left end and down the sidelines for 8 and first down at midfield. Ferguson slid off right tackle for 2. Warfield swept right end for 7. Ferguson plunged right tackle for 4 and first down on the Wisconsin 37. Snell picked up 3 on a wide lateral around left end. Ferguson smashed center for 1. Sparma passed to Klein for 8 and first down on the Wisconsin 25. Snell cut back inside left end for 2. Ferguson found a hole at right guard for 7. Ferguson lost 1 at center. Ferguson slanted off right tackle for 3 and first down on the 14. Warfield cut back inside right end wide for 6. Klein cut back inside right end and picked his way to a touchdown. Time: 13:19. Van Raaphorst converted. SCORE: OHIO STATE 17, WISCONSIN 8.

WISCONSIN—(1:41)—Van Raaphorst kicked off to Fleming on the 15 and he returned to the 31. Miller's pass to Staley was no good. Miller's pass to Richter for 48 yards gave Wisconsin first down on the Ohio 21. Miller was rushed badly by Tidmore, but rolled around him and Richter made a spectacular grab as he was falling. Nettles swept right end for no gain. Miller passed to Richter for 15 and first down on the Ohio 6. Smith got 1 over left tackle. Miller's pass to Richter appeared to be intercepted by Houck but was ruled incomplete in the end zone. Miller's pass to Staley was incomplete, but Ohio was called for interference and down on the Wisconsin 30. Ferguson got first down on the 1. Miller failed to get over on a sneak, but made it on the second try. Time: 14:3. Bakken converted. SCORE: OHIO STATE 17, WISCONSIN 15.

OHIO STATE—(0:01)—Bakken kicked off to Tingley on the 29 and he returned to the 38 as time ran out. Score at end of second period: OHIO STATE 17, WISCONSIN 15.

THIRD PERIOD

WISCONSIN—(15)—VanRaaphorst kicked off to Smith on the 15 and he returned to the 36. Smith failed to gain at center. Miller passed to Richter for 11, but Wisconsin was penalized 15 for offensive interference to its own 21. Miller passed to Staley for 9. Bakken punted to Houck on the Ohio 16 and he returned to the Ohio 21.

OHIO STATE—(12:50)—Snell spilled over left tackle for 5. Snell ran left end for 6 and first down on the 31. Bichler broke through to throw Snell for a 3-yard loss. Sparma passed to Snell for 8. Sparma's pass to Bryant was incomplete. Hardman punted dead on the Wisconsin 27.

WISCONSIN—(10:07)—Snell tackled Nettles for a 2-yard loss wide right. Miller's pass to Richter was incomplete. Smith swept left end for 9. Bakken punted to Hess on the 25 and he returned to the 33.

OHIO STATE—(8:24)—Ferguson drove over the middle and kept digging for 9. Ferguson broke over left guard and sprinted 19 for first down on the Wisconsin 39. Ferguson went over right guard for 12 and first down on the Badger 27. Ferguson was stacked up at right tackle, but spun ahead for 3. Klein ran a lateral from Mrukowski wide around left end and fought for 3. Ferguson picked up 8 over left tackle and with a half dozen tacklers hanging on, it was first down on the 13. Ferguson added 6 over the same spot. Ferguson was piled up at left tackle after 1. Warfield spilled over center for 2 and it was 4th down and 1 on the 5. Warfield swept right end and went in with plenty to spare. Time: 11:37. Mrukowski's pass to Warfield was incomplete on a two-point attempt. Score: OHIO STATE 23, WISCONSIN 15.

WISCONSIN—(3:23)—VanRaaphorst kicked off to Holland on the 6 and he returned to the 38, where Warfield made a saving tackle. Smith swept left end for 11 and first down on the 49. Miller passed to Richter for 9. Snell tackled Smith for a yard loss. Kroner ran left end for 7 and first down on the Ohio 36. Miller passed to Richter for 16, but Wisconsin was penalized 5 for backfield in motion to the Ohio 41. Kroner failed to gain as Peruse tackled. Miller's short pass to Bangert was off the latter's fingers. Kroner got 3 on the draw play. Bakken punted into the end zone and Ohio took over on its own 20.

OHIO STATE—(27)—Katterhenrich plunged 3 over left tackle. The period ended before another play. Score at the end of third period: Ohio State, 23; Wisconsin, 15.

FOURTH PERIOD

OHIO STATE—(15)—Klein cut back inside left end for 5. Ferguson smashed center for 2 and first down on the 30. Klein swept left end for 4. Ferguson tripped and spilled at center for 3. Mrukowski kept around left end for 2 inches short of first down. Ferguson plunged right tackle for 4 and first down on the Ohio 43. On 4th and 1, Ferguson broke loose over the middle and picked his way 29 yards for first down on the Wisconsin 28. Snell rounded left end for 3. Katterhenrich spilled over left tackle for 4. Katterhenrich got 2 over right tackle. On 4th and 1, Klein swept right end and cut back for 7 and first down on the Badger 12. Snell tried around left end for 1. Katterhenrich drove over left tackle for 6. Katterhenrich spilled over left tackle for 2. On 4th and 2, Katterhenrich blasted over center for 1 and Wisconsin took over on its own 3.

WISCONSIN—(6:15)—Nettles slanted off right tackle for 3. Nettles added 2. Tolford deflected Miller's pass to Richter and the ball fell to the ground. Bakken punted to Warfield on the 39 and he returned to the Ohio 44.

OHIO STATE—(4:04)—Warfield swept right end for 3. Katterhenrich found daylight over center for 14 and first down on the Wisconsin 39. Mrukowski kept around right end for 5. Katterhenrich found running room at center for 12 and first down on the Wisconsin 22. Warfield cut back wide inside right end for 19 and first down on the 3. Katterhenrich blasted for 1. Warfield slanted off right tackle for a touchdown. Time: 13:24. VanRaaphorst converted. Score: OHIO STATE 30; WISCONSIN 15.

WISCONSIN—(1:36)—VanRaaphorst kicked into the end zone. Miller passed to Richter for 14 and first down to the Wisconsin 34. Miller passed to Staley, who made a diving catch for 9. Holland swept right end for 10 and first down on the Ohio 47. Miller passed to Staley, who made a fingertip grab on the Ohio 25, a 25-yard gain first down. (23 seconds) Miller passed to Staley for 18 and first down on the Ohio 7 (10 seconds) Miller ran to his left, was hemmed in, ran to his right and finally found Richter in the end zone. Time: 14:58. Bakken overthrew Smith in the end zone. Score: Ohio State, 30; Wisconsin, 21.

OHIO STATE—(0:02)—Bakken kicked off to Ingram, who grabbed the ball and fell as time lapsed. Final score: OHIO STATE, 30; WISCONSIN, 21.

CONDENSED RULES FOR RECORDING FOOTBALL STATISTICS*

(Originated by the N.C.A.A. Football Rules Committee's Sub-committee on Football Statistics)

(Continued from back of form 347-A)

SECTION 6—PUNTS.

Article 1: Punts are measured from the line of scrimmage to the point of ultimate advance, if the ball remains in the field of play or goes out of bounds. (Note — "Ultimate advance" is the point where ball goes out of bounds, is downed, or is recovered by the defense.

(Note — "Ultimate advance" of the punt shall be construed to include also any distance which a receiver of the punt may retreat toward his own goal before attempting to return up field. This interpretation gives greatest benefit to both the punter and the receiver, since excellence of the punt normally is responsible for retreat by the receiver. Thus "minus yards" should NOT be recorded under "punt returns.")

Article 2: When a punt goes over the goal line (a touchback), distance of the punt is measured from the line of scrimmage to the 20-yard line only, since this is the limit of the punt's value to the kicking team.

Article 3: If a receiver muffs a punt and the ball continues toward his goal line, the punt is measured to the point of recovery or ultimate advance, as defined above. If a receiver muffs a punt and the ball bounds back toward the kicker's goal, the punt is measured to the point of the muff (the point of ultimate advance), and the receiver is credited with a punt return and with the yards from the point of the muff to the point of recovery, regardless of which team recovers.

Article 4: A blocked punt is recorded as a "team" entry, and not charged against the individual kicker. Thus, in the case of a blocked punt which does not pass the line of scrimmage, enter the word "team" in the "Yards" column and "Blocked" in "Kicks" in team totals.

If the ball is blocked in front of the kicker's goal and is recovered by the kicking team, the yardage is treated as a punt return by the player who blocked the kick. If the ball travels toward the kicker's goal and is recovered by the blocking team, the yardage is treated as a punt return by the player who blocked the kick—and the blocking team is charged with a fumble lost, except on fourth down.

SECTION 7 — KICK RETURNS.

Article 1: Only the number of punts and kickoffs which the receiving team actually attempts to return are included under kick returns. (Exception — Blocked kicks which travel toward the kicker's goal. See Article 4 of Section 6.)

Article 2: The return will be measured from the point where the returning player actually gains control of the ball to the point where the ball is declared dead, or is lost by fumble. There are no "minus yards" under kick returns (see note under Article 1 of Section 6).

Article 3: The return of an attempted field goal, which falls short and is returned by the defending team, is treated as a punt return.

SECTION 8 — FREE KICKS.

Free kicks are recorded as kickoffs if made from placement, and as punts if the ball is punted. The receiving player is credited with a kickoff return, or a punt return, respectively.

SECTION 9—GOALS FROM THE FIELD.

For the sake of uniformity in an area where considerable disagreement has existed, it is recommended that all news story and record reference to a successful field goal cite the yard line from which kicked, rather than the distance kicked, i.e., "field goal from 25-yard line," rather than "25-yard field goal."

Field goals are not recorded under punting.

SECTION 10—POINTS AFTER TOUCHDOWN.

Article 1: A player attempting a try-for-point-after-touchdown by kicking is not charged with an attempt when a bad pass from center or a fumble by the ball holder, precludes an opportunity to kick. Such an unsuccessful attempt is charged to the "team," rather than to any individual player. However, if the ball is momentarily fumbled and then kicked, an attempt is charged to the individual kicker, regardless of the success or failure of the effort.

Article 2: The try-for-point-after-touchdown is made while time is out and is not recorded as a play from scrimmage (rush, pass or kick).

When a try-for-point-after-touchdown is by forward passing, the passer is charged (under SCORING) with the attempt. If successful, the receiver is credited under SCORING with the conversion and points scored, and the passer is credited with a conversion under FORWARD PASSING.

SECTION 11 — SAFETIES.

No individual credit is recorded for any player on either team when a safety is scored. The team benefitting from the score is credited.

SECTION 12 — FUMBLES.

On any play terminated by a fumble, the yards involved to the point of recovery are credited or charged to the player who fumbled, regardless of which team recovers the fumble.

(Approved Ruling — On rushing play, ball carrier of Team A fumbles at the line of scrimmage and the ball travels 5 yards toward Team B goal line, before it is recovered by Team B. Player of Team A who fumbled is credited with rushing gain of 5 yards and Team A is charged with a fumble lost.)
