PURPOSE OF REPORT: To advise the committee of the applications for

the 2012/13 Sports Capital Projects Grant.

KEY ISSUES

Assess applications for the Sport capital grants.

INTRODUCTION

Applications for the capital grants closed on the 17th August 2012. Total funding available in 2012/2013 is \$19,915.

BACKGROUND

Applicants received an invitation to this meeting to make a brief presentation outlining their proposal.

COMMENTS

Selection Criteria

Proposed projects will be evaluated against the following selection criteria:

- Projects must be for capital developments of sporting facilities with the Tumut Shire. Applications for maintenance or noncapital related projects will not be considered.
- 2. Sporting Organisations that regularly attend and participate in Sports Committee meetings.
- 3. Projects that are partly funded by the applicant and/or other grant that maximises value for the community.
- 4. Community benefit as demonstrated through a brief presentation outlining the application to the Sports Committee at a nominated meeting

Application Guidelines

- Applications must be lodged to Council by close of business on the 17th August 2012. Late applications will not be accepted
- 2. The project shall be completed and fully invoiced to Council by 30th June 2013. Funds not expended by this date will be forfeited.
- 3. All sections of the application must be filled out and returned for application to be considered.
- 4. Funds will only be paid upon completion of the project and following evidence of completion.
- 5. It is preferred all monies be handled by Council that is all invoices for works are submitted to Council for payment upon completion of works.
- 6. The applicant must verify that any matching funds are available.

- 7. Any contractor involved in the project must comply with Council's insurances, WH&S and quality requirements.
- 8. Council or the Sports Committee may lodge an application/s on its own behalf.
- 9. Applications will be referred to the Sports Committee to make recommendations to Council on success of applications.
- 10. The Sports Committee members shall evaluate applications by way of ranking. Each voting member shall rank applications on voting sheet provided (assigning a number to each applicant – 1 being most deserving, 2 being second most deserving, etc). Results will be tallied and recommended to Council.
- 11. The Sports Committee in evaluating applications may, at its discretion, reject any or all applications that are deemed unsuitable. Should this result in unallocated funds the Committee may elect to make a recommendation to Council on expenditure of those funds.
- 12. Only those Sports Committee members whom have no conflict of interest (eg member that is not an applicant or member of an organisation whom is an applicant) shall vote. Those with a conflict of interest are not to be present during voting.
- 13. Successful applicants will be notified in writing.
- 14. Tumut Shire Council reserves the right to terminate this funding of successful applications at anytime. Any notice of intention to terminate will be issued in writing and must be responded to within 14 days.
- 15. Tumut Shire Council does not accept responsibility or liability for works carried out and bears no responsibility for projects which do not have all necessary local council and other government department approvals.

RECOMMENDATION

That the Sports Committee recommend a priority order for the capital grant applications to assist Council in allocating the \$19,915 for the financial year 2012/2013.

Policy No: FIN.11 Version No: 1.2

1. PURPOSE

To provide guidelines for the allocation of Athletes Assistance funds.

2. SCOPE

Athletes that reside in Tumut Shire selected to represent at state level or higher in any officially organised sport.

3. **DEFINITIONS**

Athlete Participant in a recognised sport.

Assistance Funding provided to aid participant costs.

4. POLICY STATEMENT

Council allocate a sum of \$886.00 per annum subject to CPI for distribution to local athletes who make appropriate application and who are a resident of Tumut Shire selected to represent at a State, National or International level in any officially organised sporting fixture, and that the maximum amount to be allocated to each individual player or competitor be \$100.00 and that the maximum payable to any team be \$300.00.

5. **RESPONSIBILITIES**

6. PROCESS

- a) Athletes requesting assistance must do so in writing to Tumut Shire Council's Sport Committee.
- b) Written request must include the following details:
 - I. Athletes name and address
 - II. Sport selected to participate in
 - III. Selection and qualification history
 - IV. Representative level and corresponding dates of representation.

c) Upon receipt of the request The Sport Committee shall evaluate in accordance with policy guidelines and at the committees discretion make a recommendation to Council.
