Property Description To commemorate the granting of the title of Citta Hompesch in 1797 to the locality of Zabbar the Arch was constructed. The Arch, built in 1801 is said to have been erected


Zabbar the Arch was constructed. The Arch, built in 1801 is said to have been erected in the location where the villagers welcomed the Grandmaster on the titular feast day of the locality. The Arch was designed as a spacious arched opening abutted by two pairs of Doric pilasters. Between a triangular pediment of the same rustic order as the rest of the Arch lies a coloured depiction of The Virgin of Graces.
