

Outline Description Mamo Tower was built as a fortified residence by the Mamo family
Property Description Mamo Tower was not commissioned by any Grandmaster, but was built by family
Mamo as a fortified residence. As such it varies in shape from other towers around
the Maltese Islands. The tower has a unique shape with sixteen sides. The interior is characterized by a
round domical-roofed room leading to four smaller rooms. A 2 metre ditch
surrounds the tower and there was formally a draw-bridge. British Military
Authorities used the tower as a regional headquarters in 1940. and constructed a pill box on the roof.
In 1987 the tower was handed to Din L-Art Helwa and restoartions programmes
commenced.
