NEW YORK - WATERBURY MONDAY - FRIDAY DEVON TRANSFER

Train schedule for New York to Waterbury, including routes like Waterbury, Naugatuck, Beacon Falls, Seymour, Ansonia, Derby-Shelton, and Devon Transfer Point.

Train schedule for Waterbury to New Haven, including routes like Grand Central Terminal, Stamford, South Norwalk, Bridgeport, and Devon Transfer Point.

Changes to Waterbury Branch Service Starting April 25: Necessary infrastructure improvements on the Waterbury Branch undertaken by the Connecticut Department of Transportation (CTDOT) and Metro-North will result in service changes beginning Saturday, April 25. To allow for the pick-up of five track miles of rail, flat cars and cranes will be occupying this single-track branch. Buses will substitute for train service on the Waterbury Branch from April 26 through Sunday, May 3. Please refer to Waterbury Branch Busing schedule available at stations and at mta.info.

DEVON TRANSFER POINT: MAY 4 THROUGH OCTOBER, 2015. At Devon Bridge, the final phase of a \$5.8 million priority-repair project gets underway to maintain safe operation of the structure until it can be replaced. A new, temporary transfer point (Devon Transfer) has been built where the branch and the main line meet, with a walkway connecting two four-car length platforms.

TO WATERBURY. Waterbury Branch customers who travel to New Haven will transfer again at Bridgeport for a main line train connection to New Haven. Northbound customers will be dropped off main line at the Devon Transfer and board a waiting train to Waterbury.

DEVON TRANSFER POINT: MAY 4 THROUGH OCTOBER, 2015. Over the past year, CTDOT has worked with Metro-North to ensure that this work would occur with the least customer impact possible. This project also helps ensure the future reliability of the Waterbury Branch as Devon Track 3 is critical to providing the main line connection at Bridgeport.

We appreciate your patience during these necessary infrastructure improvements.
