

BURRIS, ZABEL NAMED TO 2015 OKLAHOMA SPORTS HOF CLASS

Former Sooner football All-Americans Kurt Burris and Steve Zabel were recently announced as being part of the 2015 Oklahoma Sports Hall of Fame class. Burris was a center and linebacker for the Sooners from 1951-1954 where he earned consensus All-America honors in 1954. During that same year he finished second in the Heisman Trophy voting.

Zabel played tight end for the Sooners during the 1967-1969 seasons. He was named an All-American in 1969 and was a three-time academic all-conference selection. He was the sixth player taken in the 1970 NFL draft by the Philadelphia Eagles.

Burris will be inducted posthumously. The induction ceremony will take place August 3, 2015, at the National Cowboy and Western Heritage Museum.

SOFTBALL SEASON PREVIEW

The three-time Big 12 defending champion Oklahoma Sooners will open the 2015 season ranked first in the Big 12 Coaches' Preseason Poll and fourth in the *USA Today*/NFCA Division I Preseason Top 25.

The Sooners return nine of its players who were starters in at least half of the games from last season, including senior All-Americans Lauren Chamberlain and Shelby Pendley. Senior All-Region Georgia Casey, and juniors Kady Self, Kelsey Stevens, and Whitney Ellis will be returning as well.

Coming from an appearance in the 2014 Women's College World Series, the fourth consecutive trip, and longest active streak in the country, a 51-13 record last season, the Sooners will open the season with a game against No. 25 DePaul on Feb. 5. Others ranked in the top-25 NFCA preseason poll, on the Sooner schedule are, No. 6 Kentucky, No. 11 Washington, No. 12 Georgia, No. 14 Arizona, No. 16 Arizona State, and No. 19 LSU respectively.


