

Please can we have your annual Public Lending Rights (which you may not even be claiming) to conserve wilderness land?

Green Ink is an initiative set up by some of the country's leading authors and artists to help conserve rainforest, coral reef and other wilderness areas under threat.

Members of Green Ink agree to assign the Public Lending Rights from at least one of their books to the World Land Trust for the purchase of endangered land. It is a simple, inexpensive and effective way of supporting valuable environmental work.

If you are a writer, illustrator, editor or translator we hope very much that you will join us.

Please note **We** will handle the paperwork! All you need to do is advise us which title or titles we may have the rights to. On average the Public Lending Rights for a book will be worth in the region of £20 - £50. The amount is directly linked to the number of times a book is requested in public libraries. Public Lending Rights are unconnected to royalties or whether or not the book is still in print.

WHAT IS GREEN INK?

Green Ink is a group of authors and artists who have agreed to assign some or all of their Public Lending Rights to the World Land Trust for the purpose of conserving land.

Under the Public Lending Rights scheme every time a book is taken out of a public library the author and/or illustrator is entitled to a percentage of a cash fund allocated by the government for this purpose. The amount that an author is likely to receive is typically in the region of £20 -£50 a year - with a maximum figure of £6000.

Many authors are unaware that they are entitled to Public Lending Rights. Others, due to the relatively small sums involved, do not bother to claim.

WHY IS THIS WORTH DOING?

The Public Lending Rights (PLRs) for a specific title may not be worth a huge sum of money but collectively PLRs provide a valuable and regular stream of income to the World Land Trust. £25, after all, will save an acre of rainforest, wilderness steppe or coral reef.

WHO HAS SIGNED UP?

Before Green Ink had even been officially launched over 150 authors had agreed to join. Founding members include David Attenborough, Terry Pratchett, Pru Leith, Ken Livingstone, David Gower and Will Self.

WHO QUALIFIES?

The conditions are straightforward:

- You must be a writer, illustrator, photographer, translator or editor.
- You must have a book in the public library lending system.
- Your name must normally be printed on the title page of the book.
- · You must be resident in the EU.

HOW DO YOU JOIN?

All we need to know is which book or books we may have the rights to. We will then complete all the paperwork on your behalf and send it to you with a stamped addressed envelope - for your signature.


Please come to our Annual Reception...

AN APPEAL FROM DR. DAVID BELLAMY, TRUSTEE OF THE WORLD LAND TRUST

What makes the World Land Trust worthy of your support?

Firstly, we fill an important environmental niche. Our expertise is in identifying and conserving vital wilderness areas under threat. Our strategy is to purchase this endangered land and then to work with local non-governmental organisations to manage it in the most environmentally sensitive way.

Secondly, we have an excellent track record. Some recent successes include saving:

- A coral island in the Philippines which would otherwise have been turned into a holiday resort;
- ♦ A 15,000 acre sheep ranch in Patagonia to provide a refuge for guanaco, puma and sea lions;
- ◆ A tropical forest in Belize that was being destroyed to create farmland (which in turn would have been chemically fertilised and sprayed with damaging pesticides); and
- ♦ A corridor of virgin rainforest in Ecuador which was in danger of being logged.

Thirdly, we will make optimum use of every penny you give us. The Trust overheads are kept low because we only employ three full time members of staff (depending instead on volunteers) and our offices are located not in London, but in Suffolk.

I think of the World Land Trust as being the environmentalist's environmental charity. We may not be large, but we have an excellent reputation and our work has been endorsed by household names such as Gerald Durrell, Bill Oddie and David Gower. I hope very much that you, too, will decide to assist us by joining our Green Ink programme.
