







Fairfield Lacrosse Story



According to the American Heritage Dictionary of English Language, tradition is defined as "the passing down of elements of a culture from generation to generation, especially by oral communication ... A time-honored practice or set of such practices."

Under the direction of its third varsity head coach, Andy Copelan, the Stags lacrosse program continues to build upon the groundwork laid by those that have come before this season's squad. From the team's formation as a club program to the pioneers of the 1980s to a move to varsity status in 1993 to affiliated league play, Fairfield University has quickly built a successful men's lacrosse tradition.

"There is a strong tradition of winning at Fairfield," says Copelan, "that was begun four decades ago. I accept the challenge of meeting the aspirations of those that have played and coached the Stags before me and continuing to build the framework of a great lacrosse program for those that are to follow."

That success has been much of late, including defeating No. 1 Denver, 10-9, in Colorado on April 20, 2013. In 2012, Fairfield posted a program-best 12-4 record in the 2012 season and advancing, for the second time in as many years, to the ECAC Lacrosse League Championship Game. Though the season did not culminate in an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament, the Stags finished 17th in the polls, the highest-ever year end ranking.

Brent Adams became the first player in program history to be named to an All-America team, earning third-team USILA All-America status. He, along with Charlie Cipriano, became the first Stag classmates to be drafted in the Major League Lacrosse Collegiate draft, being taken with sequential picks in the seventh round. Cipriano made history of his own as he was named the ECAC Goalkeeper of the year for the second time, and was an All-America Honorable Mention.

The Fairfield lacrosse story began in 1972 when the Stags first took the field as a club lacrosse program. One of the program's greatest pioneers, Will Mraz, was a member of that founding team. In the inaugural season, Mraz led the team in most offensive categories, which included 19 goals, four assists and 23 points. In the fall of 1999, Mraz's efforts were rewarded as he was inducted into Fairfield University's Athletic Hall of Fame.

Mraz is one of five Fairfield lacrosse players that have been inducted into the Hall of Fame. The first inductee was Lawrence Puzzo, Class of 1973, who was enshrined in 1984 and was joined by his classmate, Mraz, 15 years later. The Stags Class of 1998 is also represented by two members, with Hugh Coyle being inducted in 2004 and Matthew Callaghan a year later. Spencer Steele, Class of 2000, was enshrined in 2007, and was joined by Sam Peterson, Class of 1997, two years later and most recently by J.T. Groarke, Class of 1999, in the 2012 induction class. As the program grew through the 70s with talented scorers Bob Rupp and John Hughes, and into the 80s, players such as John Callegari, Hugh "Skeets" Coyle and Joe Sargent paved the way, preparing the team for a jump to varsity play. In fact, the teams from 1987-1989 combined to go 33-4, including 11-0 in 1987.

Fairfield made that historic jump to varsity status for the 1993 season and opened up the campaign in grand style, defeating a visiting St. Joseph's squad, 11-6. The fledgling varsity program went through some lean years as they played highly competitive schedules, but the hard work would pay off in the long run. By 1996, the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) had formed a men's lacrosse league and Fairfield once again served as a pioneer, becoming one of the eight founding teams. Under former coach Ted Spencer's first-year guidance, the Stags made a splash by going undefeated in league play, on their way to three consecutive league titles. Those three league crowns, two ECAC tournament championships and all-star performances by players such as Matt Callaghan, Sam Peterson, J.T. Groarke and Spencer Steele established the Stags as one of the premiere programs in the northeast and readied them to burst onto the national scene.

After only seven years as a Division I varsity program, the Stags opened up the 2000 season as an independent program, playing their toughest schedule yet. That status and the caliber of players in the program brought their highest level of national recognition ever, a No. 27 preseason national ranking by Face-Off Men's Lacrosse Yearbook.

Every change brings a growing period and a learning curve and that's what the Stags faced in the 2000 season. Fairfield played a slate that consisted of six teams that finished the season ranked nationally in the top-25. Still, they played valiantly against the lacrosse giants of the country, falling in four games by two goals or less.

In 2001, the program entered a new era as they joined the Great Western Lacrosse League (GWLL). That season, the Stags finished with a most impressive 3-2 conference record, good for second place. Fairfield claimed wins over Air Force, Butler, and Denver, and fell to Ohio State by a mere goal and to Notre Dame which went on to the Final Four of the NCAA Tournament.

A program that had been a club team a mere 10 years prior posted its finest season ever in 2002 as the Stags finished in first-place in the GWLL with a 4-1 mark and snagged the conference's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. Fairfield fell in the first round to UMass, 17-4, but the ground work has been laid for a bright future.

They say history has a way of repeating itself and it did in 2005. The Stags won the GWLL with a 4-1 mark and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second time, taking on eventual national runner-up Duke in the first round. The campaign saw the Stags win a single-season record tying 11 games, with a program-best seven game win streak. The Stags boasted wins over the likes of Harvard, Notre Dame, Penn State, Hobart and Ohio State during the season

The 2006 season marked another momentous step on the evolution of the Stags lacrosse program. Fairfield became a member of one of the nation's elite conferences, the ECAC Lacrosse League. The team went 4-3 in their first year of ECAC competition, including nearly upsetting eventual national runner-up UMass during the regular season.

The Stags have won 53 times in six seasons under the direction of Andrew Copelan and have returned to the national conversation. Fairfield won seven straight games to start the 2012 season and reached as high as 13th in the national polls. In 2010 the Stags earned arguably one of the most noteworthy victories in program history in the team's first-ever game in the State of Texas. Fairfield defeated then #3, and eventual national runner-up Notre Dame 10-8.

Brent Adams, Class of 2012, became the first Stag since Greg Downing, Class of 2007, to earn preseason All-America honors in 2010. He was named an honorable mention by Inside Lacrosse after a freshman campaign that saw him earn All-ECAC Second Team accolades. Sam Snow and Michael Roe earned the honor prior to the 2013 season.

Downing, the program's first-ever three-time All-America honoree, has also gone on to represent the Fairfield lacrosse program with much acclaim at the professional level. He was the first-ever Stag to be taken in the Major League Lacrosse Collegiate draft, being taken in the first round in 2007.

Six Stags have been drafted in the MLL Collegiate Draft since Copelan took the reins, with Jack Murphy being taken in January 2014 and with Snow and Marshall Johnson being selected in January 2013. Add to that Drew Palmer, who was signed as a free agent during the 2012 season, the Stags have had 16 players drafted, or signed contracts with MLL teams. Peter Vlahakis was taken in the fourth round of the 2004 supplemental draft, and finished as the league's all-time face-off wins leader.

Downing continued his Stag firsts in November 2010, when he was selected to United States Indoor Lacrosse National Team. He will be a member of the squad that represents the U.S. at the 2011 World Indoor Lacrosse Championship in Prague, Czech Republic in May.

Fairfield lacrosse has been a springboard into life after college, with the program being well represented in the professional world. Included in that impressive list are two current Fairfield University Board of Trustees; Brian P. Hull '80 and William C. Crager '86.
