Skill Level: Intermediate 


FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 19"

Depth at center back: 26½"

Length of each side: 35"

MATERIALS

10 skeins of Bernina Le Fibre Nobili by Filatura Cervinia (50% acrylic/45% virgin wool/4% polyamide/1% Lurex; 1¾ oz/50 g; 43 yds/40 m), color 11 (sunshine) 

US 15 (10 mm) needles

GAUGE

10 sts and 12 rows = 4" in lace patt

SHAWL

CO 49 sts very loosely. Knit 3 rows.

Work the foll 2 rows a total of 53 times:

Row 1: K3, *YO, K2tog, rep from * to last 2 sts, K2.

Row 2: K3, purl to last 3 sts, K3.

Work the foll 2 rows a total of 53 times:

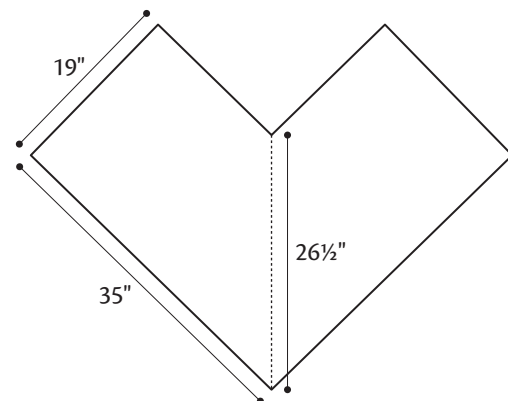
Row 1: K2, *SSK, YO, rep from * to last 3 sts, K3.

Row 2: K3, purl to last 3 sts, K3.

Knit 3 rows. BO very loosely kw from RS.

FINISHING

Block if desired.



FRONT

Cont in patt row 3: BO 5 (7, 9) sts for neck opening, knit to end of row.

Working in patt, BO 1 st at beg of next 6 RS rows.

Work patt row 8 (WS).

Rep the 8-row patt 5 (6, 7) times; work rows 1–6 once more.

Inc 1 st at beg of next 6 RS rows. Work 1 WS row.

CO 5 (7, 9) sts. Break yarn and place sts on a spare needle.

BACK

Attach yarn at neck edge on WS and place sts from holder back on needle.

Work rows 3–8 of patt, then work the 8-row patt rep 5 (6, 7) times.

Work patt rows 1 and 2.

Join back to front on patt row 3, working front sts from spare needle. Then work patt rows 4–8.

Work the 8-row patt rep 6 times. Work patt rows 1–2.

BO 47 (53, 59) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Work even for patt rows 5–7.

RIGHT SLEEVE

Begin on row 8. Work in patt, dec 1 st at each side of sleeve every 8 rows 15 (14, 13) times—48 (52, 56) sts.

Work rows 1–5 of patt.

Change to size 6, 24" circular needle and work the foll 2 rows twice:

Row 1 (WS): Knit.

Row 2: Purl.

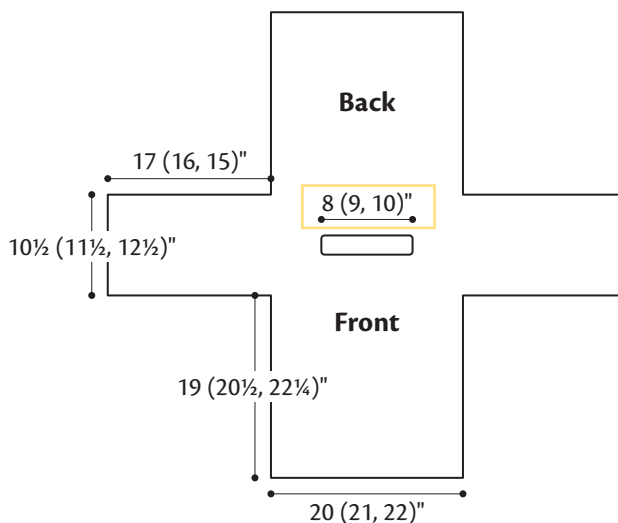
BO loosely.

FINISHING

Neck: With size 6, 16" circ needle, RS facing, and beg at right shoulder, PU approx 70 (74, 76) sts around neck. Pm and join sts. Purl 6 rnds. BO loosely.

Sew side seams and sleeve seams.

Bottom edge: With size 6, 24" circ needle, PU approx 175 (185, 195) sts around bottom. Purl 6 rnds. BO very loosely.



RIGHT BACK

With B, CO 56 (60, 64, 68) sts.

Foundation row (WS): CE, knit.

Work the foll 2 rows 19 times—75 (79, 83, 87) sts:

Row 1: CE, knit to last 2 sts, Kfb, K1.

Row 2: CE, knit.

Shape back neck:

RS: BO 5 sts, work to last 2 sts, Kfb, K1.

WS: CE, knit—71 (75, 79, 83) sts.

Work the foll 2 rows 9 times—80 (84, 88, 92) sts:

Row 1: CE, knit to last 2 sts, Kfb, K1.

Row 2: CE, knit.

Work the foll 2 rows 5 times—75 (79, 83, 87) sts:

Row 1: CE, knit to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

Row 2: CE, knit.

Place sts on a holder.

LEFT BACK

With A, CO 56 (60, 64, 68) sts.

Foundation row (WS): CE, knit.

Work the foll 2 rows 19 times—75 (79, 83, 87) sts.

Row 1: CE, Kfb, knit to end of row.

Row 2: CE, knit. On last rep of this row, BO 5

sts—71 (75, 79, 83) sts.

Work the foll 2 rows 9 times—80 (84, 88, 92) sts:

Row 1: CE, Kfb, knit to end.

Row 2: CE, knit.

Work the foll 2 rows 5 times—75 (79, 83, 87) sts:

Row 1: CE, K2tog, knit to end.

Row 2: CE, knit.

Leave sts on needle. With RS to RS, join center back seam using 3-needle BO (see page 92). Sew shoulder seams.

RIGHT SLEEVE

Count 12 (16, 20, 24) sts up from bottom side seam of left front. With A, PU 44 sts to shoulder seam, PU another 44 sts—88 sts.

Work in St st for 15¾ (15, 14½, 14)" or until 3" from desired length, ending with a completed WS row.

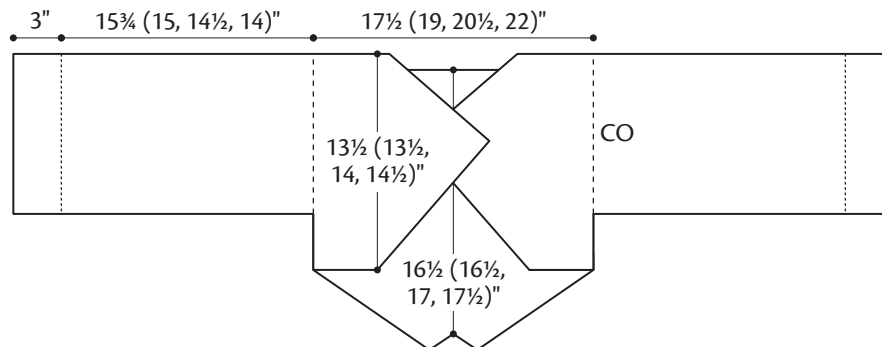
Attach B and work 24 rows in garter st. BO from RS in knit.

LEFT SLEEVE

Work the same as right sleeve, but reverse all colors.

FINISHING

Sew underarm and side seams.



Oh, what a horribly hideous name for a piece so beautiful! This lovely lace pattern is called “Fischgrätlein,” which translates to “fish scales.” It begins with a few stitches at the neck, working down to the ethereal lace pattern that is mostly composed of air. When you receive compliments on this lovely piece, you can make up a better name for it.

Skill Level: Experienced ■■■■

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width from wing to wing along top: 60"

Width from wing to wing along bottom: 80"

Center back length: 18"

MATERIALS

A: 1 skein of Kid Mohair from Louet (70% wool/30% nylon; 1¼ oz/50 g; 490 yds/452 m), color Grey Lavender (1)

B: 1 skein of Graceful from Yarn Place (100% wool; 3½ oz/100 g; 2,400 yds/2,215 m), color 3617, Sherbert (1)

US 8 (5 mm) 40" circular needle

GAUGE (UNBLOCKED)

20 sts and 28 rows = 4" in fish scales patt, holding 1 strand of each yarn tog

SHAWL

Using 1 strand of A and 1 strand of B held tog, CO 3 sts.

Row 1: Kfb each st—6 sts.

Row 2: Knit.

Row 3: Kfb each st—12 sts.

Row 4: Knit.

Row 5: (Kfb) 3 times, (YO, sl 1, K1, pssso, **K1**) twice, (Kfb) 3 times—18 sts.

Row 6: K3, P3, (YO, P2tog, P1) twice, P3, K3.

Row 7: (Kfb) 3 times, *YO, sl 1, K1, pssso, K1, rep from * to last 3 sts, (Kfb) 3 times—6 sts inc; 24 sts.

Row 8: K3, P3, *YO, P2tog, P1, rep from * to last 6 sts, P3, K3.

Work rows 7 and 8 a total of 52 times—336 sts.

Knit 2 rows. BO all sts very loosely.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block or steam.
