





ENROLMENT BY AGE AND GENDER BALANCE



INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ENROLMENT BY GEOGRAPHIC ORIGIN



INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ENROLMENT BY GEOGRAPHIC ORIGIN (continued)



November 1, 2009 to November 1, 2013








TOTAL ANNUAL GIFTS RECEIVED








NUMBER OF PEOPLE WITH UTMail+, UTORExchange, OR UTORmail
