



Ties are possible if, in the juror's opinion, different styles of production merit multiple winners. The statuette is an original interpretation of the Christopher Columbus statue which stands in front of the Columbus City Hall. The statuette, six inches high, is cast in bronze and mounted on a mahogany block and was sculpted by Robert Rohm, formerly of the Columbus Museum of Art.

## EDGAR DALE AWARD

Born Under the Red Flag, a documentary written by Sue Williams for Ambrica Productions, that tells the story of China's remarkable transformation after MaoTse Tung's death,

A Protester signals victory as he leads thousands of demonstrators through the streets in support of the student-led movement in Tiananmen Square.

The **EDGAR DALE AWARD** is given for excellence and creativity in informational screenwriting with distinguished visual and literary qualities.



Kim's Story: The Road from Vietman a documentary written by Shelley Saywell for Bishari Films of Toronto, Canada, won the top documentary screenwriting award. This is the first time two writers have been honored with the Edgar Dale Award.

This documentary tells the story of what happened to the child in the world famous, Pulitzer prize-winning photograph that moved millions to tear and played a major part in the success of the anti-Vietnam War movement.



## ROBERT W. WAGNER AWARD

...................

White Lies, a Canadian Broadcasting Corporation television movie written by Dennis Foon and produced by Phil Savath, is a frightening look into the world of Neo-Nazism. An articulate but alienated teenager (Sarah Polley) becomes attracted to the toxic rhetoric of a white supremacist group and journeys into the beating heart of darkness cranked up on Hate Rock and White Power websites under Canada's multicultural skin. 
The **ROBERT W. WAGNER AWARD** is given for excellence and creativity in writing in a dramatic form.

## THE PRESIDENT'S AWARD







## The Film Council of Greater Columbus

#### A brief history . . . .

In 1985, the Chris Awards Film Collection was established at The Ohio State University's Department of Photography & Cinema. Dr. Edward Jennings, president of the university, gave the dedicatory remarks, citing the value of the collection to students and film historians. The space in which it was located was identified as the Mary A. Rupe Alcove.

Mary Rupe, whose dedication for many years as Secretary-Treasurer of the Film Council of Greater Columbus, helped to make the Columbus International Film & Video Festival one of the most effective and well organized competitions for non-theatrical productions in the country.

The purpose of this collection is to encourage scholarly study of the photographic and electronic media of information, art, and entertainment genres. It contains a wealth of documentary and informational film and video research. The collection has been used as a data base for Master's theses and Ph.D. dissertations as well as general research.

The collection consists of Chris and Bronze Plaque Award-winning productions from the Columbus International Film & Video Festival competitions. Additions to the collection are made annually by our festival winners. We encourage current and previous winners of the Chris Award to donate tapes of their productions for inclusion. We believe that it is very important to enlarge, maintain, and provide greater accessibility to these significant works.

During 1995, the collection was moved to the Film Council's premises at 5701 North High Street. In 1996, a larger suite was acquired to accommodate our growth, and provide a better facility for the collection.

We also preserve the scripts entered in the Screenwriting competition and print materials identified for evaluation in the Media of Print Division. These competitions were unique when initiated by our Festival. We are proud to be able to maintain these materials for examination and research, as they contribute much to the artistic, marketing and distribution success of your productions.

The collection will be available to distributors, enabling them to screen (on site) titles for distribution consideration. You will be contacted regarding interest in your production.

We believe that it is important to provide this opportunity for your productions to continue their influence and possibly find larger audiences. We understand that the average "life-time" of an educational work can be as short as five years. Some topics become obsolete even before they are completed! However, in this one facility, there is a site where your works can be collected, catalogued, and maintained with the respect they deserve.

We will be investigating digital or laser systems with which to assure long term preservation of these priceless and important archives of knowledge.

As we strive to meet the challenges which this ambitious undertaking entails, we will be seeking funds to cover the costs which the additional space and equipment require. Donations to this exciting venture are tax deductible to the full extent allowed by law, and donor's names will be recorded and prominently displayed in the research area.

## Purpose and History of the Festival

The purpose of the Film Council shall be the encouragement of the arts and sciences of film and video making; the support of independent and corporate artists; and the improvement of public education, elevating standards of quality in film and video literacy.

The Columbus Film Council was founded in 1950, by the late Dr. Edgar Dale, Professor Emeritus of The Ohio State University and other professionals interested in promoting the use of 16mm motion pictures. Two years later, the Columbus Film Festival was born. Since its inception, the object of the Film Council has been to encourage and promote the use of 16mm motion pictures and, subsequently, videotape in all forms of education and communication, not only in the local community but throughout the world.

During these many years of continuous operation, the Festival has honored thousands of film and video producers. The Festival has grown in scope, becoming "international" in 1972, in the late 80's adding "video," and in 1997 adding the CD ROM format.

Although the organizational structure of the Film Council, sponsor of the Columbus International Film & Video Festival, The Chris Awards, has remained the same, there has been a continuing effort to keep the Festival current with trends in production and distribution. The Festival also recognizes the written word, incorporating two key elements of the creative process, writing and marketing through its Screenwriting and Media of Print Divisions. Producers who win our awards eagerly promote them through their own marketing media and through national audio-visual and trade publications.

To adapt to changing needs of producers and distributors, we created a website in 1996 (which lists all the current winners) and expanded our screenings of winners this year. While the competition itself has always been our primary emphasis, we hope to screen even more award winning entries in the future.

Many people have labored to build the strong foundation upon which today's Festival stands. We extend our gratitude to all those who have contributed time and expertise through the years and salute this year's participants—both our jurors and our entrants.

Congratulations on your success this year. We hope we will see *you* again in 1999.
