

What you will need:
RED HEART® Detroit: 2 balls 05682 Pink Freesia

Crochet Hook: 5mm [US H-8] Yarn needle

TENSION/GAUGE: 1 repeat $=9$ cm [3 $3 / 2 "] ; 7.5$ rows $=10 \mathrm{~cm}\left[3^{\prime \prime}\right]$ in pattern stitch. CHECK YOUR TENSION/GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the tension/gauge.

Red Heart ${ }^{\oplus}$ Detroit, Art. 9809651 available in $100 \mathrm{~g}(3.50 \mathrm{oz}), 266$ m (291 yd) balls


## Sabrina's Shawl

This shawl is the perfect combination of pretty pattern stitch and vibrant colour. Crochet it to wear any season of the year!

Shawl measures 108 cm [42"] at shortest width, 207 cm [81"] at widest width $\times 48 \mathrm{~cm}$ [19"] long.

## SHAWL

Ch 134.
Row 1: 2 tr in 4th ch from hook, ${ }^{*}$ ch 5, skip next 5 ch, dc in next ch, ch 5, skip next 5 ch, 3 tr in next ch; repeat from * across to last 12 ch, ch 5 , skip next 5 ch, dc in next ch, ch 5 , skip next 5 ch, 3 tr in last ch - 12 3-tr groups.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as tr now and throughout), turn, 2 tr in same tr, tr in next tr, 3 tr in next tr, ch 3 , tr in next dc, ch 3 , *3 tr in next tr, tr in next tr, 3 tr in next tr, ch 3, tr in next dc, ch 3; repeat from * across to last 3 tr, 3 tr in first tr , tr in next tr, 3 tr in last st.

Row 3: Ch 3, turn, 2 tr in same tr, tr in next 5 tr, 3 tr in next tr, ch 1, *skip next tr, 3 tr in next tr, tr in next $5 \mathrm{tr}, 3 \mathrm{tr}$ in next tr, ch 1 ; repeat from * across to last group of trs, 3 tr in first tr, tr in next $5 \mathrm{tr}, 3 \mathrm{tr}$ in last st.

Row 4: Ch 3, turn, 2 tr in same tr, ch 5, skip next 4 tr, dc in next tr, ch 5, skip next 5 tr, *3 tr in next ch-1 space, ch 5 , skip next 5 tr , dc in next tr, ch 5 ; repeat from * across to last ch-1 space, 3 tr in last ch-1 space, ch 5 , skip next 5 tr , dc in next tr, ch 5, skip next $4 \mathrm{tr}, 3 \mathrm{tr}$ in last st - 13 3-tr groups.

Row 5: Ch 3, turn, 2 tr in same tr, tr in next tr, 3 tr in next tr, ch 3, tr in next dc, ch 3, *3 tr in first tr, tr in next tr, 3 tr in next tr, ch 3 , tr in next dc, ch 3; repeat from * across to last 3 tr, 3 tr in first tr, tr in next tr, 3 tr last st.

Row 6: Ch 3, turn, 2 tr in same tr, tr in next 5 tr, 3 tr in next tr, ch 1, *skip next tr, 3 tr in next tr, tr in next $5 \mathrm{tr}, 3 \mathrm{tr}$ in next tr, ch 1 ; repeat from * across to last $7 \mathrm{tr}, 3 \mathrm{tr}$ in first tr, tr in next $5 \mathrm{tr}, 3 \mathrm{tr}$ in last st.

Repeat Rows 4-6 for 10 times - 23 3-tr groups.

Last Row: Ch 2, turn, htr in each tr and tr in each ch-1 space across.
Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ch = chain; cm = centimeters; dc = double crochet; $\mathbf{h t r}=$ half treble crochet; $\mathbf{m m}=$ millimeters; st(s) = stitch(es); tr = triple or treble crochet; * or ** $=$ repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.


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
