Abdirahman is a three-time Olympian, a four-time USA 10 Mile champion, and a two-time winner of the Medtronic TC 10 Mile - the venue for two of his USA 10 Mile titles. The Somali-born American finished $10^{\text {th }}$ in the 2000 Olympic Games $10,000 \mathrm{~m}$, the best of his three Olympic 10,000m races. In 2007, Abdirahman ran away from eventual runner-up Jason Lehmkuhle of Team USA Minnesota to win his first TC 10 Mile. In 2009, he fought off a fierce challenge from Team USA Minnesota's Josh Moen to win in a course record breaking time of $46: 35$, the fourth-fastest 10 Mile ever run by an American.

After a chaotic childhood - his father was in and out of prison and he and his mother survived on welfare - and a tumultuous college career that saw him attend three different schools and quit running for a time, Cabada burst onto the professional running scene in 2006. At the USA 25K Championships that year, he set an American record for the distance in $1: 14: 20$. By the end of the year, he had a marathon PR of 2:12:27, run at the prestigious Fukuoka Marathon in Japan. In 2008, at the Medtronic Twin Cities Marathon he won the USA Marathon title in a rain-soaked 2:16:32.

Her returned to the Twin Cities Marathon last year, finishing in $3^{\text {rd }}$-place.
