Property Description

St George's Tower is one of the coastal towers erected by Grand Master Lascaris in 1638. It was originally similar in design to the Wied iz-Zurrieq Tower. The St George's Tower was heavily altered and rebuilt, largely in its upper floor and roof. Only the scarped lower half of the structure dates back to the original tower, and all other additions and alterations date to the British period.


