






SPEICHERSTADT - old warehouse district


The "Speicherstadt" is Hamburg's unique and historical storehouse city within the old harbor area. This area hosts 9 museums and exhibitions, for example: Speicherstadt Museum, Maritime Museum, Miniatur-Wunderland (the world's largest model railway) and the Hamburg Dungeons.

The harbor of traditional ships is located within HafenCity - currently Europe's largest inner-city development project. A lively new inner-city pace is being created to accommodate a mix of offices. residential areas, retail, restaurants and bars, As well as cultural facilities. The development is documented in the HafenCity InfoCenter nearby. To visit the harbor of traditional ships get off at Speicherstadt or Elbphilharmonie.

INTERNATIONAL MARITIME MUSEUM

The exhibits are presented on 9 decks within the historic Kaispeicher B warehouse, in the centre of HafenCity Next door the Prototyp automobile museum shows a rare collection of classic sport cars.

Right on the waterfront of the river Elbe, on the western tip of Hafen-City, Hamburg is currently building a new concert hall - the Elbphilharmonie The glass structure has built the former warehouse known as the Kaispeicher A and rises up to a 110 meters. The heart of the Elbphilharmonie is the Grand Hall, a world class concert hall. With the

ARBOR MUSEUM HAMBURG

The Harbor Museum is located in the historical Warehouse 50 within the free port area. It exhibits a historical storage depot. demonstrating how cargo was handled before containers took over. The museum gives an impression of how hard the work in the harbor used to be. Visitors can admire
