Outline Description	Remains of redoubt
Property Description	<p>This work was one of the pentagonal-shaped redoubts which were constructed as part of the system of coastal fortifications erected by the Knights in 1715/16. Originally the structure consisted of a pentagonal platform with short flanks and low parapet, closed off at the gorge by a rectangular blockhouse. Only the platform survives (minus the parapet) today, the blockhouse replaced by a modern summer house.</p>

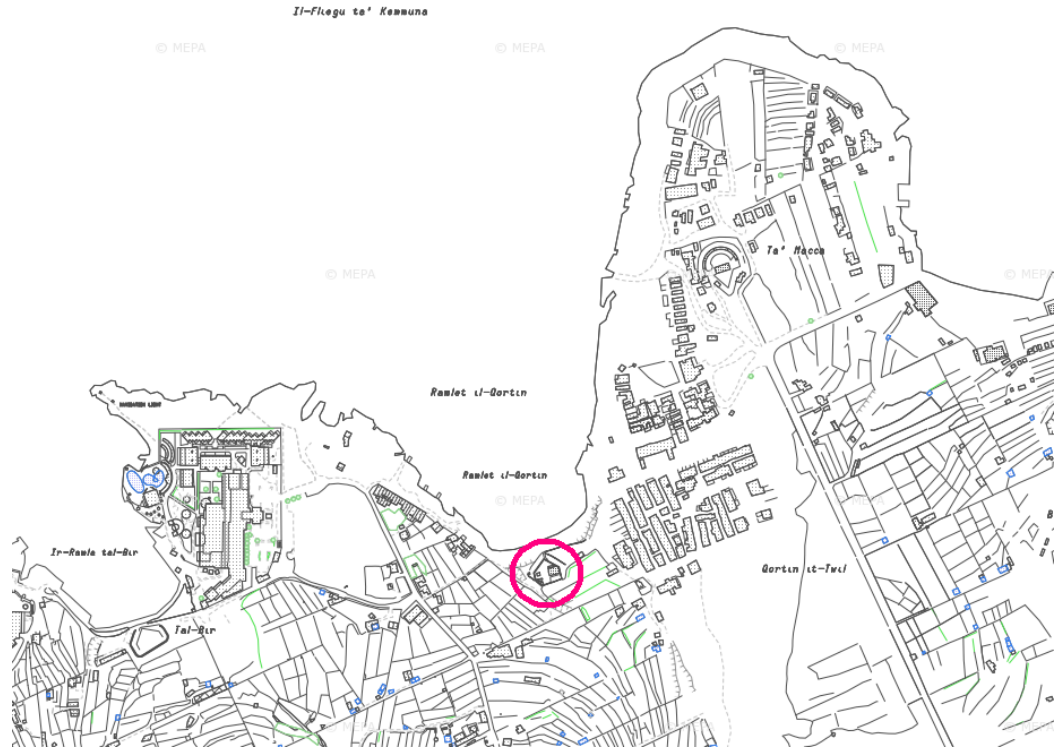
