20. The areas of the grave spaces in the two sections shall not exceed the following dimensions:—

Section A.—7 feet long by $2\frac{1}{2}$ feet wide with 18 inches interspaces.

Section B.—8 feet long by 3 feet wide with 18 inches interspaces.
