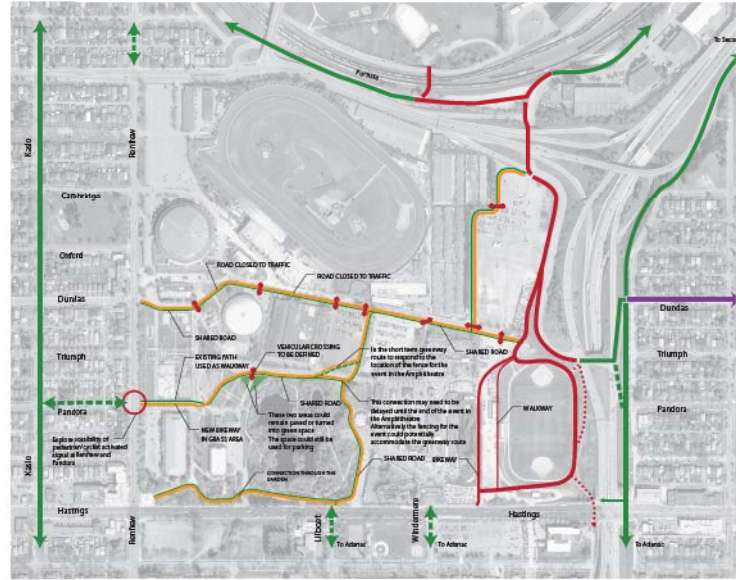


Open House #2 Results

Initial concept plans for Empire Field and Plateau Sports Park, as well the proposed routing of the permanent and temporary greenways, were presented at the second open house in February.

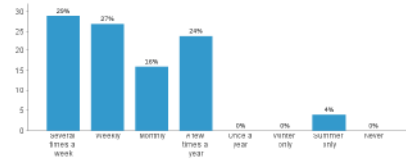
Panels 8, 9 and 10: Active Park Spaces - Plateau Sports Park / Bike Skills / Leaside

Unique sports destinations providing a diversity of activities and catering to all age groups. The following have been included in this initial plan:

- Grass courts
- Multi-sport court
- Resilient surface court
- Children's play areas for 5 & under
- Children's play areas for 5 & over
- Mountain bike dirt jump area
- Leaside Tunnel: expansion outside to north for skateboarding and pedestrian connection through tunnel

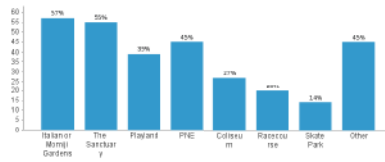
Frequency of visits to Hastings Park

How often do you visit Hastings Park?

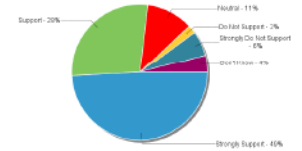


Reason for visit to Hastings Park

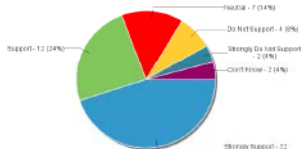
Comments:

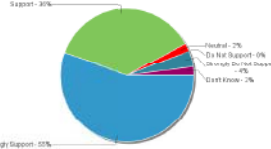
Comments:

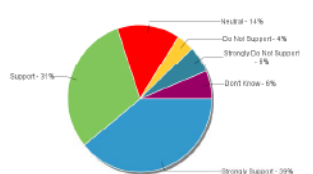
Comments:
